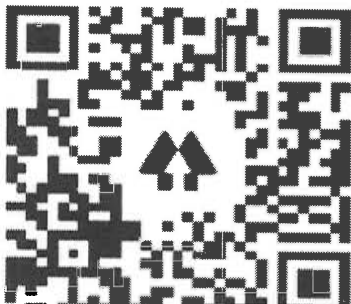



...Near Critical Fire Weather Threat Today (Tuesday)...

WEATHER DISCUSSION: A near critical fire weather threat will exist through the day today as increased SW winds between 15 and 20 mph are forecast. Gusts as high as 30 mph (possibly greater) are anticipated. While conditions will be slightly cooler today thanks to an uptick in clouds, afternoon humidity will still fall near or just below 20%.

TODAY: Near critical fire weather threat. Windy and slightly cooler. Smoke/haze lingering with increasing cloud/shade cover..

High Temperatures: Valley/Drainages: 74-79° Mid-Slope (4500-5500 FT): 71-76° Ridges (> 5500 FT): 68-73°
 Minimum Relative Humidity: Valley/Drainages: 17-23% Mid-Slope (4500-5500 FT): 20-30 % Ridges (> 5500 FT): 20-30%

Interior heat islands (near DP-301): Downslope/down-valley flow quickly transitioning to a S to SW wind by noon. Sustained winds will range between 17 to 20 mph with gusts to near 30 mph, especially after 1300-1400 PDT. The higher winds are most probable on west and southwest aspects.

DIV J/K/L: Downslope/down/canyon flow will become upslope/up-valley (generally SW) by 1300 PDT with sustained wind speeds between 10 and 13 mph. Gusts as great as 27 mph are possible, especially along aligned drainages/higher elevation.

DIV W/Z: Downslope/down-valley flow will increase through noon today with speeds between 9 and 12 mph. Winds could gusts as great as 25 mph, especially along the higher terrain.

Stability: Inversion lifting around 1200 PDT. Mixing heights around 7,000 feet AGL. Unstable mixed layer with a few cumulus buildups.
Chance of Rain: 0% **LAL:** 1 **Transport Winds:** SW at between 25 and 35 mph..

TONIGHT: Active thermal belt above 5000 feet, but increasing cloud cover and humidity. Low risk for a shower or two.

Low Temperatures: Valley/Drainages: 43-48° Mid-Slope (4500-5500 FT): 39-44° Ridges (>5500 FT): 38-43°
 Relative Humidity Recovery: Valley/Drainages: 60-70 % Mid-Slope (4500-5500 FT): 50-55% Ridges (> 5500 FT): 50-55%

Interior heat islands (near DP-301): Elevated SW winds near 15 mph with gusts to 25 mph.

DIV J/K/L: SW winds near 10 mph with gusts to 20 mph. Downslope/down-valley flow commencing around 0200 PDT Tuesday morning with speeds diminishing to under 5 mph.

DIV A: Elevated SW winds near 10 mph with gusts to 20 mph. Winds diminishing down to the 3 to 8 mph range with gusts near 12 mph after 0400 PDT.

Stability: Very weak Inversion developing between 0200-0400 PDT (Wednesday Morning).
Chance of Rain: 10% **LAL:** 1 **Transport Winds:** S to SE to around 10-15 mph.

Extended Outlook (Wednesday through Friday): Increased shading due to additional cloud cover will serve to keep daytime high temperatures in the 50s and 60s. Afternoon humidity levels will in turn elevate, initially around 30% on Wednesday with values likely not falling far below 40% on Thursday and Friday. Overnight humidity recovery during this time period will also be excellent with values above 70% during the extended outlook. There will be a potential for rainfall, though at this juncture, amounts will likely remain below 0.10 inches.

FUEL ASSUMPTIONS: The fuels involved on the Dixie fire consist primarily of conifer timber litter with a shrub or grass understory. Fuel model TU 5 (timber/shrub) best represents these conditions. There are also areas of fuel model GS 2 (shrub/grass) especially on the eastern side and lower elevation areas.

Consider all fuels available to contribute to fire spread. Grass fuels are completely cured, and live fuel moistures in shrubs and canopy are at levels that will easily carry fire. **Fuel moistures remain low today!**

WEATHER SUMMARY: Reference fire weather forecast for specifics. Increasing winds with cooler temperatures and higher relative humidity.

General Fire Behavior Forecast: Fire danger remains high but begins to moderate early in the burn period today! - Inside the fire perimeter fire behavior should remain minimal with isolated stumps, berms, and heavy fuels smoldering and producing light white smoke. Reburn potential decreases today as moisture levels rise. Outside the fire footprint, fuels remain extremely dry. Probability of Ignition decreases today but remains high. Be extra careful with equipment and dozer berms. Rates of spread will be moderate, but spotting will likely be a major challenge. Fires will display moderate resistance to control. Burn period likely to be moderated with the arrival of clouds and moist air early in the afternoon.

Specific:

Areas of heat near Lassen and Prospect Peaks will continue to be active. Expect smoldering and creeping to continue with visible smoke production in these areas. Heat appears to be in a fire scar, so intensity is likely to remain low, but if heat finds a continuous stringer of fuel, open, spreading flame is likely. It is doubtful that intensity would be great enough to spot out of the containment lines.

Initial Attack – IA could easily occur today. Dry fuels, and high wind speeds will be moderated by higher RH and clouds later in the day. Terrain and wind could align for increased ROS and flame lengths. Spotting will remain a problem. Fire growth in an uphill run could be substantial.

Fine fuel moisture today is – 3 to 4%	Rates of Spread in Timber- 11 to 17 chains per hour
Probability of Ignition today - 80%	Rates of Spread in Grass- 22 to 50 chains per hour
Spotting Distance Today- ½ - mile or >	Flame Lengths- 5 to 9 feet on the surface

AIR OPERATIONS: Morning haze should clear by mid-day for good afternoon visibility, Gusty winds in the afternoon could impact aviation operations.

FIRE BEHAVIOR SAFETY: Effective communication is a critical element of safe and successful firefighting operations. Make sure you have good communications in place prior to engaging the fire.

Fitness for Duty:

High performing teams are always prepared and ready to go at a moment's notice. Changing conditions and transitions have become the norm this season sometimes with little to no predictability. It is imperative that you and your crew are fit for duty in the event of a sudden change. As your crews time out and return, remind everyone of the importance of their behavior when off assignment as well that every person on this assignment is required to follow the zero tolerance for drugs and alcohol use policy. Consider explaining the following guidelines using the techniques of servant leadership, shared vision accountability and building on differences:

Non-prescription, unlawful drugs and alcohol are not permitted at the incident:
Possession or use of these substances will result in disciplinary action.

During off-incident rest periods, personnel are responsible for proper conduct and maintenance of fitness for duty. Drug or alcohol abuse resulting in unfitness for duty will result in disciplinary action.

Take Home Message:

Be sober, be alert, and be aware for your safety...and the safety of everyone else.


