Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: Started interpretation with IR perimeter from previous night. Fire most active on northern flank. Scattered heat throughout most of western flank and to lesser extent the southern portion of the fire. The interior and northeast has mostly isolated heats. Fire remains west of Hwy139 and north of Hwy 299/139
