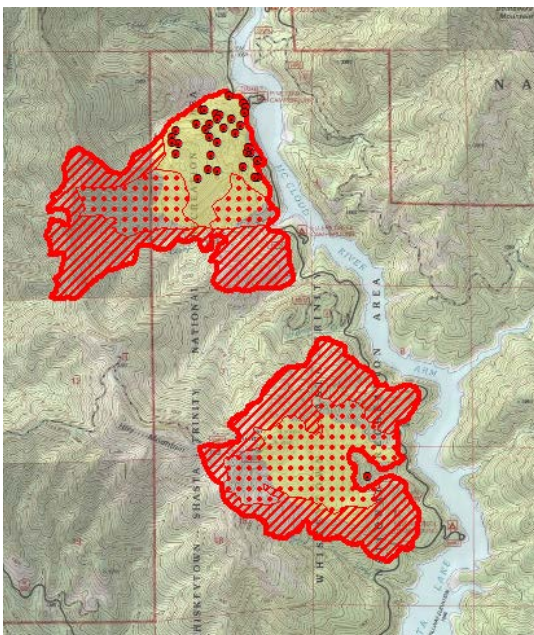

Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:

I started my interpretation with the 08/10/2018 IR fire perimeter. New growth – 920 acres. The fire grew mainly to the west and south.

Yellow is 8/10/2018's IR heat perimeter. Red line is current IR heat perimeter.

Perimeter growth: Fire continues to grow to the West & South. There is intense heat as well as scattered heat in this area and some isolated heat sources.
