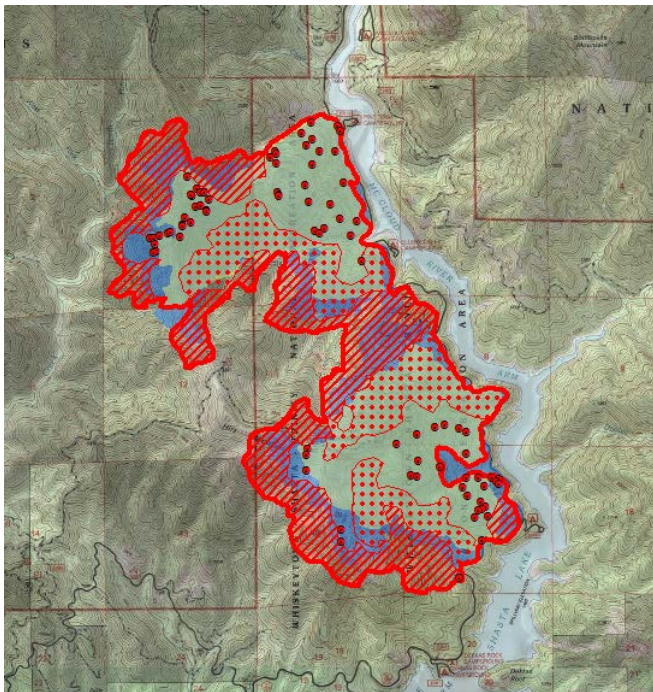

Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:

I started my interpretation with the 08/11/2018 IR fire perimeter. New growth – 1,150 acres. The fire grew mainly to the west and south. Two polys have burned together now.

Yellow is 8/11/2018's IR heat perimeter. Red line is current IR heat perimeter. Blue is Drone perimeter from 8/11.

Perimeter growth: Fire continues to grow to the West & South. There is intense heat as well as scattered heat in this area and some isolated heat sources.



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There is scattered and isolated heat throughout the interior of the fire.

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
