Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: I started my interpretation with the 08/13/2018 fire perimeter provided by incident. New growth – 1,285 acres. The fire grew mainly to the Northwest and south. Yellow is 8/13/2018's IR heat perimeter. Red line is current IR heat perimeter. Perimeter growth: Fire continues to grow to the Northwest, west & south. There is intense heat as well as scattered heat in this area and some isolated heat sources. Patch of intense heat at center of perimeter.			

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
