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Started interpretation with previous night's IR perimeter. No updated perimeter was found on the incident's ftp site.

Fire continues to be most active on appendage heading north along the McCloud River and the northwest flank. Fire has reached over the ridgeline to east of Tombstone Mtn.

West flank still exhibits scattered heat but has cooled since yesterday. East flank and interior shows only isolated heat. Fire operation from previous days continues to burn inward filling unburned island.

No heat detected east of McCloud River.
