GENERAL FIRE BEHAVIOR:

Expect active fire behavior once the smoke clears out, most likely early afternoon. Torching with spotting will continue to challenge containment lines and with add to fire spread. As the fire moves into lighter fuel types expect dramatic increases in rates of spread where wind and slope align. Drought stressed fuels are holding heat for extended periods and the heavy dead and down logs are very receptive to spotting. ERC's are at or above 90th percentile at local stations. Expect the fire to remain active into the night until the winds die down and we get some RH recovery and increased stability.

RISKS & HAZARDS

Aviation Operations & Safety: Aviation operations present a unique set of hazards to not only to pilots, but firefighters on the ground. Review the Aviation Watch Out Situations found in the IRPG. The tempo of aviation operations on the fire has increased the use of helicopters and airtankers. Each aircraft has specific performance capabilities and limitations. Take time to review the IRPG guidance on Directing Retardant and Bucket Drops. Maintain positive communications with pilots and ground forces. Ensure personnel are advised and cleared of the drop area and advise pilots of hazards such as powerlines or other aircraft in the area.

Power line & Gas line Safety: Multiple strands of powerlines run north & south along the east side of the Caldwell Fire (Branch III). When working around powerlines, avoid parking or working under or near them. Communicate powerline hazards to all resources. Seek out power company advisers for information on specific hazards. **Treat all powerlines and downed wires as energized!**

Same with the high-pressure gas lines that run north & south along the east side of the fire. Sections of the gas line may be exposed above ground or buried in shallow ground. **DO NOT DRIVE HEAVY EQUIPMENT OVER THE TOP OF BURIED GAS LINES!** Consult with gas company representatives for guidance.

Firefighter Health: Adequate hydration, nutrition, rest, mental & physical fitness contribute to the overall health and well being of our firefighters. Ensure personnel are getting the necessary doses of each of these elements as your fire assignments will allow. Monitor personnel and watch for fatigue-related trends that can impair both mental and physical health.


