3. Objective(s):

LEADERS INTENT: Suppress the July Complex Fires using the full range of fire management tactics and strategies to minimize, to the extent feasible, exposure to firefighters, communities and other affected areas to reduce susceptibility to the consequences from the COVID-19.

Management Objectives:

- Ensure safety of emergency responders and the public by utilizing strategies and risk management processes that minimize smoke exposure and align the total number of responders needed to achieve containment and utilizing guidance provided in "California Interagency, Incident Management Team Incident Response Guide in the COVID-19 Environment, 2020.
- Protect natural and cultural resources, high values at risk including, commercial timber, gas and utility lines, sensitive resources, tribal areas utilizing Resource Advisors and Agency Representatives.
- Foster and maintain good relationships with local cooperators, stakeholders and public while providing coordinated, accurate and timely information keeping COVID-19 a factor in virtual or on-site communications.
- Maintain fiscal accountability and keep costs commensurate to values at risk working with local unit and coordinating with Agency Administrator and Incident Business Advisor.
- Suppress all new fires within the TFR as requested and coordinated thru the MICC and Unit Duty Officer.

General Situational Awareness:

- Steep and rugged terrain, critically dry and receptive fuel beds, active area for fire history and drought stressed trees.
- In the COVID-19 environment, high density populations or large groups are particularly at risk. To help protect yourself, your family and to ensure all employees return home safely, make sure to practice social distancing.
- Enhanced hygiene (especially handwashing), PPE & monitoring practices help limit the infection rate of first responders.

GENERAL FIRE BEHAVIOR:

Expect active fire behavior once the smoke clears out, most likely early afternoon. Torching with spotting will continue to challenge containment lines and will add to fire spread. As the fire moves into lighter fuel types expect dramatic increases in rates of spread where wind and slope align. Drought stressed fuels are holding heat for extended periods and the heavy dead and down logs are very receptive to spotting. ERC's are at or above 90th percentile at local stations. Expect the fire to remain active into the night until the winds die down and we get some RH recovery and increased stability.

Probability of Ignition 90-100%

Spotting distance 400' to up to ¼ mile

SPECIFIC:

Caldwell Fire

- Division Y/Z- Where open line remains anticipate FL 4-8'+, ROS 20-40 ch/hr, and spotting up to ¼ mile downwind during the afternoon.
- Divisions X- Afternoon winds will test recent burn operations on the north end of the fire.
- Division E- S-SW winds could pose issues for recent burn operations.
- Division A and C- Potential for extended burn down time in drought stressed heavy fuels. Heads up for fire weakened snags.

Allen and Dalton Fires

- No forward progression expected. Potential for heat sources near containment lines.

Initial Attack New Fires

- Anticipate FL 4-8'+, ROS 20-80 ch/hr, and spotting up to ¼ mile downwind in low country. High country fires will be highly receptive to new starts.

Air Operations: Smoke should clear by noon.

SAFETY:

Sunday and Monday's activity changed the fire footprint substantially. Ensure good SA in your new environment.

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

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

RISKS & HAZARDS

Aviation Operations & Safety: Aviation operations present a unique set of hazards to not only to pilots, but firefighters on the ground. Review the *Aviation Watch Out Situations* found in the *IRPG*. The tempo of aviation operations on the fire has increased the use of helicopters and airtankers. Each aircraft has specific performance capabilities and limitations. Take time to review the *IRPG* guidance on *Directing Retardant and Bucket Drops*. Maintain positive communications with pilots and ground forces. Ensure personnel are advised and cleared of the drop area and advise pilots of hazards such as powerlines or other aircraft in the area.

Power line & Gas line Safety: Multiple strands of powerlines run north & south along the east side of the Caldwell Fire (Branch III). When working around powerlines, avoid parking or working under or near them. Communicate powerline hazards to all resources. Seek out power company advisers for information on specific hazards. ***Treat all powerlines and downed wires as energized!***

Same with the high-pressure gas lines that run north & south along the east side of the fire. Sections of the gas line may be exposed above ground or buried in shallow ground. **DO NOT DRIVE HEAVY EQUIPMENT OVER THE TOP OF BURIED GAS LINES!** Consult with gas company representatives for guidance.

Firefighter Health: Adequate hydration, nutrition, rest, mental & physical fitness contribute to the overall health and well being of our firefighters. Ensure personnel are getting the necessary doses of each of these elements as your fire assignments will allow. Monitor personnel and watch for fatigue-related trends that can impair both mental and physical health.

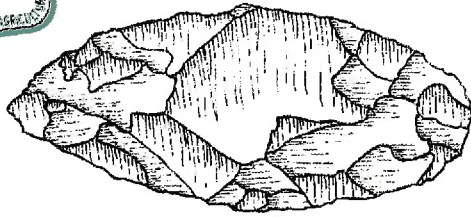
