Strong northeasterly winds will continue through today and into tomorrow morning. Winds will decrease tomorrow morning, but extremely hot and dry conditions will remain in place for several days. A Red Flag Warning through tomorrow morning has been issued for these conditions.

# GENERAL FIRE BEHAVIOR

Fuel moisture will be very low in response to hot and dry conditions with fine dead fuels as low as 3%. Winds will be sufficient to drive very active to extreme fire behavior. Crown runs in dense stands of timber are possible. Significant downslope/down drainage runs could be possible where topography aligns with northeast winds.

Grass - Surface rates of spread 80-100 chains per hour with flame lengths 8-12 feet

Shrub - Surface rates of spread 80-100 chains per hour with flame lengths 12-22 feet

Timber - Surface rates of spread 10-16 chains per hour with flame lengths 5-10 feet

Probability of Ignition 80-90%

Maximum spotting distance 0.8 to 1.0 mile

# SPECIFIC FIRE BEHAVIOR

**Branch 41** – Infrared has shown no heat near the perimeter for the past week. Reburn or isolated pockets of heat cannot be completely ruled out, but no fire behavior issues are expected in Branch 41.

**Branch 43** – Potential for very active to extreme fire behavior exhists if fire gets established outside of control lines. With strong and gusty winds out of the NE today, control lines could be tested in areas near the South Zone/West Zone break.


