GENERAL FIRE BEHAVIOR

Fuel moisture will remain very low. Fire behavior will be fuel and terrain driven, with an increase of activity if sufficient mixing allows smoke to clear. Live fuel moisture remains very low and will easily support transition into the canopy. Single and group tree torching should be expected. Short duration crown runs could be possible in dense timber on steep slopes.

Grass – Surface rates of spread 45-60 chains per hour with flame lengths 5-10 feet

Shrub – Surface rates of spread 30-50 chains per hour with flame lengths 6-15 feet

Timber – Surface rates of spread 6-12 chains per hour with flame lengths 4-9 feet

Maximum spotting distance 0.2 mile – PIG 70-80%

SPECIFIC FIRE BEHAVIOR

Branch 41 – Infrared has shown no heat near the perimeter for more than a week. Reburn or isolated pockets of heat cannot be completely ruled out, but no fire behavior issues are expected.

Branches 43, 3 and 5 – Some heat remains close enough to the perimeter to continue providing cause for concern, particularly in the area from Fuller Creek to Big Signal Peak. While potential for active fuel and terrain driven fire behavior still exists, each day without escape or spread in this area brings higher confidence.

AIR OPERATIONS

Smoke will continue to be the most limiting factor with clear air unlikely before 13:00.

SAFETY

Fire damaged hazard trees will continue to be a significant threat.

Over the last 5 years driving has continued to be the leading cause of reportable incidents within wildland fire

Distracted Driving

Distracted Driving occurs when the vehicle operator becomes involved in any activity that diverts his/her attention from driving defensively. This is <u>not</u> limited to the operation of a vehicle on the highway. There are many activities that we as wildland firefighters engage in that causes us to lose our situational awareness when behind the wheel:

- <u>Cell Phones</u>: looking for names/numbers, receiving or making phone calls, texting, checking emails, etc.
- Navigation devices: GPS, Avenza Maps, incident maps, etc.
- Radios: searching for channels, reaching for microphone, changing batteries, etc.
- Eating and Drinking
- <u>Awestruck</u>: fire activity, smoke column, historic landmarks, areas of interest, wildlife, etc.


