Discussion:

Warm and dry again today. After another night of poor RH recoveries, RHs will struggle to climb out of the teens. Smoke will be less today than previous days, especially on the west side of the Complex. Temperatures in valleys will rise to the mid 90s, while higher elevations will be in the low to mid 80s. Winds will be terrain driven in valleys/slopes most of the day. West to northwest winds will develop once again in the mid-afternoon, with gusts around 15 mph at ridgetop. Div G1- Short duration crown fire runs will continue throughout the day. Westerly winds should clear off the smoke layer today, so expect to see new heat establishing quickly. Throughout the day shift, west winds will push fire growth upslope and up portions of the Lower Mad River drainage. Along the leading edge, the Horse Ridge dozer-line will be tested.

NIGHT: Going into the evening, an East/Southeast wind will surface. Expect periods of passive crown fire to produce spots up to ¼ mile.

Div E1- Active edge North of the West Fork Van Druzen Creek will continue movement towards DP-109. Potential spots have established across the dozerline in identified bug killed tree zone. 2015 fire footprints on both sides of the current perimeter should assist in slowing spread.

NIGHT: East winds will push any active fire edge into the 2015 fire scars. Potential for heavy fuels and young brush layer to support fire spread throughout the absent humidity recovery period.

Div A1/Div LL/Div KK-Limited perimeter growth until late evening when E/SE are predicted to surface. Areas of current fire activity will support group torching and intense clean up of interior fuels. Potential for spots to establish in the early morning is high since there has been not any humidity recovery for several nights. Any remaining spots outside of the dozer-line between DP-97 and DP-95 will make an assisted downslope run with group torching and short uphill runs as the surface fire continues to pre-heat the drought stress canopy. Fire activity near DP-122 (Ruth Airport) will continue to fill in the unburnt pockets and test the dozer-line near DP-119 all day. Arrival of the East wind in the late evening should push this activity back into the main black.

NIGHT: Heads up for spots on the line to move west.

Div Y/U/S- Firing operations along the Crazy Bear Pass are tied in with the 2012 North Pass fire, and westerly winds will likely allow the unburnt fuels in the Henthorne basin to make extended crown fire runs towards the Middle Fork of Eel Cr/Shrimp Dip.

NIGHT: All active fire edge and spots along the Crazy Bear pass dozerline will be tested as the East winds arrive late in the evening. Spots in the drainage bottoms around Leech Mtn will also test the Leech Lake dozer-line near DP-63.

Div N- Small pockets of interior heat near Barnes Ranch, and Sanhedrin Cr will continue to smolder. Activity should be limited to the understory and occasional single tree torching. Expect any smoldering roots to produce visible smoke today as the smoke blanket clears. **NIGHT:** Any heat along the division will have a dry East wind pushing embers west.

AIR OPERATIONS:

West winds should provide several hours of clear skies. Smoke blanket will return with the East winds in the late evening.

Forest Road Driving

When driving, safety should be your number one priority. Driving accidents have the potential to injure the largest number of people at one time. Here are a few tips for forest road driving.


Buckle up. When driving on forest roads expect the un-expected to happen. The fire environment adds hazards to the list; increased traffic, following vehicles, sudden stops, smoke, dust, wash- boards, animals etc.

Think about the path you intend to take BEFORE you try it. This approach helps you to plan your way through obstacles and minimize damage. Sometimes it is difficult to navigate your line of choice yourself because it can be hard to see everything around your vehicle from the driver seat. This is where the help of a "spotter" can be quite valuable.

A method for controlling speed is to put the vehicle in a low gear, stay off the gas and brake and let the engine do the braking. The benefit of engine braking is you are controlling the wheel spin at a fixed rate of speed. This fixed rate of speed increases traction on a hill descent or during cornering allowing you to maintain control of the vehicle. Brakes can still be applied, to slow the vehicle further. Using brakes applies stopping force which may lock up a wheel causing a loss of traction and consequently a loss of control. This hazard increases on wash-board roads.

When applying a vehicle's brakes hard, the front suspension compresses. When your suspension is compressed, it has very little room to absorb impact. If you cannot stop in time, try releasing the brakes just before impacting the obstacle (pothole, rut, rock, etc). This will allow the front suspension to return to its normal height and give more suspension travel to absorb the impact when you hit the obstacle.

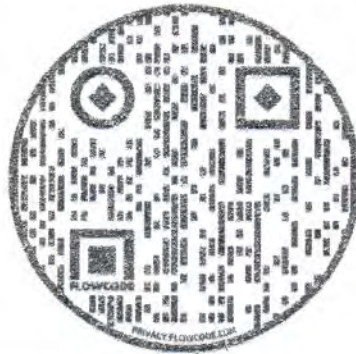

Yellow/ Red- Contact Communications on Command with a Medical Incident Report.



