

Discussion:

The hot and dry weather will continue across the Complex. The biggest factors dictating exactly what type of weather you will experience are smoke and elevation. The thermal belt is hovering right around 4,500 ft keeping the ridges generally clearer and much drier. In the lower elevations, smoke is much thicker reducing visibilities and keeping instability firmly in check. For the higher elevations, E-SE winds from the overnight hours will persist through the afternoon before shifting to the SW. For lower elevations, winds will generally remain light and slope/diurnally driven. Expect more of the same in terms of hot, dry, and smoky through Tuesday.

DIV G1- Areas above 4500' will be more active today as pockets of clear and unstable air pass through. Spots across the dozer line near Norse Butte have highest potential to emerge and make additional progress. Expect single tree torching and spotting less than 1000'.

Ruth Structure Group- Firing operations from previous shift will continue to smolder throughout the day. Section of unburnt fuels near Ruth remain sheltered from upper level spotting and solid clean black. Area of highest potentials is along Mad River where rolling debris and local downslope winds could deposit spots into the 2015 fire footprint. Heavy fuels in this area have high potential for making rapid uphill surface runs in the recovering brush.

DIV E1- Spots across the dozer line up near DP-108 will continue to chew into the heavy fuel loading, as long as the smoke blanket stays in place. IF the layer starts to lift at all, these heavy fuels will support group torching and movement towards DP-109.

Branch 15- Creeping and smoldering will continue produce single tree torching throughout the day. This branch has consistently seen the lowest RH values during the night (4%) and around the peak burning period (7%). This lower recovery is priming fuels to make short wind/slope runs, especially in Salt Creek. Minimal movement today due to the west winds and heavy smoke.

Div U- Active edge between DP-67 and Pothole Creek will continue to fill in the Henthorne Basin to Leech Mtn. Short uphill runs will test the dozer line west of Pine Ridge. Expect wind/slope alignment in Williams and Buttermilk Cr to test the dozer line in DIV U.

DIV S/N- Pockets of heat near Hell Hole Canyon have potential to re-emerge due to poor humidity recovery and potential for smoke blanket to lift periodically. Remainder of Division is showing no visible heat.

AIR OPERATIONS:

West winds should provide several hours of clear skies. Smoke blanket will return with the East winds in the late evening.

FIRE BEHAVIOR SAFETY

All Divisions are now above the 90th percentile ERC. Fuels are primed for large fire growth. Smoldering roots are resulting in large green tree failures...Stay Alert!

Hazardous Chemical—**Carbofuran**

CARBOFURAN – FURADAN

Trade Name(s): Furadan 4F, Furadan 5G, Furadan 350FS

DISCUSSION: Illegal Marijuana grow sites may contain a wide variety of known and unknown hazardous chemicals. Law Enforcement is reporting more and more sites are containing carbofuran. The chemical is intended to kill squirrels, rabbits, and deer (wildlife) that are eating the marijuana plants. These toxins may be in the leaves, buds, water system, and on the ground around the grow site.

Hazards:

- Potential Health Effects (headache, light-headedness, weakness, abdominal cramps, nausea, excessive salivation, perspiration, blurred vision, tearing, pin-point pupils, blue skin color, convulsions, respiratory distress, tremor, and coma)
- Fire Fighting Procedures: isolate fire area, evacuate downwind, wear full protective clothing and self-contained breathing apparatus, do not breathe smoke, gases or vapors generated.
- Environmental and Wildlife Concerns: Toxic to fish, birds, mammals, and other wildlife.

MITIGATION:

- If you come across a marijuana grow site do not enter the area
- Quietly leave the same way you came in
- Don't look around, touch anything, or explore
- Do not take a sample
- Return to your vehicle and leave as soon as possible
- Report your findings when in a safe location
- If exposure occurs, follow MSDS/SDS first aid measures and exposure reporting procedures




