Northwest Zone Continue to evaluate and provide structure protection along the Highway 36 corridor and in the Ruth Lake area. Keep the fire south of Miller Place Road from the south fork of the Trinity River to Maynard Road to Hwy 36. Keep the fire south of Hwy 36 from DP118 to the Little Van Duzen River at the DPA. Keep the fire east of the DPA boundary from Hwy 36 and the Little Van Duzen River to DP 90 at Kettenpom. 6. ### Discussion:

Today will be very similar to Monday with continued warm and very dry conditions. Smoke will once again be the driving factor for fire weather. If higher elevations get some clearer air, this would allow for instability to increase. In the lower elevations, expect another day of thick smoke lending to high stability. Winds will be generally light and terrain/diurnally driven through the period. The ridge begins to break down on Wednesday making for a transition day with very dry RHs and increasing SW winds. Moisture will continue to increase as we head into the end of the week.

### WEATHER FORECAST FOR TODAY:

SKY/WEATHER: Smoke. Warm and very dry.

Max Temperature: 88-93 in valleys. 75 to 80 higher elevations.

Min RH: 10-15%

WINDS:

-20 ft Level-WINDS

DIV G1- Light terrain driven winds will align with the forecasted SW winds today. This will likely slow the backing fire spread on the west face below DP-113, but it will allow for short duration group torching as the understory preheats fuels upslope. Any clear pockets of air movement will support limited distance spotting to the NE along the new dozer line.

Ruth Structure Group- Firing operations above the Mad River and northern reaches of Ruth Lake will loosen rocks and fires snags. Heavy fuels in this area have high potential for making rapid uphill surface runs in the recovering brush and oak leaf litter.

DIV E1- Smoldering fuels along the line near the Van Duzen will begin to re-kindle in the late afternoon. Limited potential for large fire growth, winds are not likely to surface in this location until Wednesday.

Branch 15/13- Continued active fire in A1 and C1 where spots and falling snags have established near DP-97 and west of DP-109 (Doughnut Hole). Fire behavior should be on the edge of direct suppression with hand crews until late afternoon when terrain driven winds begin to support isolated and group torching.

Div U- Defensive firing operations in DIV Y from DP-67 to DP-63 will continue to secure the administrative boundary. SW winds will be light throughout the day, with terrain driven upslope winds pushing the heat and spots back into the black. Expect this fire to back into Williams Cr over the next few shifts, with occasional short duration runs when debris rolls down into new fuels.

DIV S/N- Pockets of heat near Hell Hole Canyon will continue to creep around in the duff and leaf litter above the Eel Scenic River. Remainder of Division is showing no visible heat.

Average ground transport times from all Divisions to a Level 2 or 3 hospital is 3-4 hrs depending on roadblocks, road conditions, visibility and location of IWI.

Daily- Establish your PACE (Primary, Alternative, Contingency, Emergency) model for medical emergency extraction.

# Fireline/ Spike Camp Medical Transports and Emergencies:

Green - Provide immediate patient care, Notify Branch/Division Medic or EMT on Tac. Medic or EMT will contact MEDL by phone at earliest convenience. Minimize, non-critical, operational radio traffic on Command and maintain situational awareness.

Yellow/Red- Contact Eureka Communications on Command with a Medical Incident Report.

### **Night Shift**
