Discussion:

The change to the new pattern continues to settle in. Temperatures will cool and minimum RH values will climb each day. Winds will generally be out of the W-SW during the day. These winds could become gusty, especially in aligned drainages during peak heating. These winds will help to drive smoke off the N and E, allowing for increasing instability over the Complex. Where the air does clear and instability develops, expect fire behavior to follow suit. This pattern becomes more entrenched on Friday before the front actually slides through on Saturday.

SKY/WEATHER: Cooler and still dry. Smoke continues clearing, mainly for the S and W side of the Complex/higher elevations.

Max Temperature: 73-78 in valleys. 65-70 higher elevations.

Branch 21- West winds will push fire edge activity along Mad River uphill with occasional group torching. Oak woodlands in Pickett fire scar will establish easily and spread quickly where tall grass understory is still present. Drainages with mixed conifer and manzanita will be slow to establish, but will send short duration crown fire uphill as gusting winds continue to pass through.

Ruth Structure Group- Wind/slope aligned winds will continue to send convective heat and spots uphill from secured firing operations. Minimal potential for local downslope winds to outpace the frontal west winds.

Branch 15/13- Spots that established on the backside of Coffee Pot will continue to support surface fire until higher west winds arrive. Expect upslope spread and emergence of these spots in the next 24-48 hrs. Additional spots on the east side of Coffee Pot will continue to grow towards Gold Mtn and potentially push Div C/DivD dozer line in the next 48hrs. Short duration wind/slope runs will gather momentum in the drainage below Cricket and Gold Meadow. If this edge surges to the NE, and crosses the West Fork Van Duzen river it would be a short spotting run uphill to challenge the dozer line.

Div U- Firing operations will be supported by the W-SW winds today. Expect to see periods of extended fire growth in the unburnt between Pothole Cr and the dozerline. Edge activity will make short pulses of wind/slope runs. Gusty winds will likely make this activity very visible.

DIV S/N- Pockets of heat near Hell Hole Canyon will continue to creep around in the duff and leaf litter above the Eel Scenic River. Arrival of forecasted winds should push the edges back to into the black. Remainder of Division is showing no visible heat.

NIGHT SHIFT- RH recovery will continue to shorten the night ops burning window. Highest winds will begin to arrive around shift change. All NW zone active edges should be pushing into the black. Any new ignitions along Van Duzen and Mad River will have high potential for rapid fire spread as wind/slope alignment pairs with instability.

AIR OPERATIONS:

Clearly skies will emerge before noon, over most of the fire area. Drainages will hold smoke layer into the late afternoon. Locations in the NE zones and along HWY36 will have short clearing periods, but sock in the late afternoon.

FIRE BEHAVIOR SAFETY

Arrival of higher winds for the next few days will also bring unstable air pressure. The next few days will see increasing West-Southwest winds before any chance of precipitation shows up Friday night/Saturday morning.

Tree related hazards

If a tree falls in the forest and nobody is around to hear it, does it make a sound?

This age-old question keeps some people guessing, but for those of us who work in the woods the answer is clear. It does when it hits the ground! The scary part is you don't always hear it until then.

Working in timber, especially post burn, is a very dangerous place, we know that. A lot of emphasis is placed on hazard tree falling. Although this is very appropriate, we need to also remember that the hazard does not end there. Below are a few things to remember when working in a timber stand.

- Enter timbered areas cautiously, look for dangerous trees prior to engaging in suppression activities.
- Clear the area of hazard trees at **least** a 2 ½ times the average tree height (when possible) , prior to engaging groups of people in the area.
- Inspect the entire circumference of suspect trees. Cat faces tend to be on the up hill side.
- If there are signs of fallen trees look in adjacent canopies for hanging limbs.
- Develop a habit of continually looking up.
- Tree species matters. Different trees burn in different ways. Ask locals if you are not familiar with local tree species.

...***even though this tree went exactly where it was intended to go***, it was surprising how little resistance it took to snap the tree in half. The firefighter was struck by the treetop which came back toward the stump.

...upon ***driving wedges*** to commit the tree to a falling direction, he looked up and noticed the top broke out. The firefighter was struck by treetop while leaving the stump.

While ***monitoring the helicopter water drops***, the TFLD(T) heard a pop and groan, heard firefighters yell "snag," then turned around and saw a tree uphill beginning to fall towards him. The firefighter was struck in the back and head by what was believed to be tree branches.

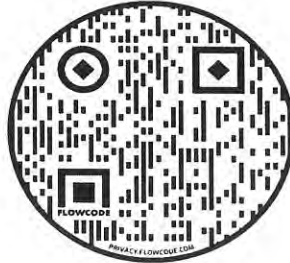

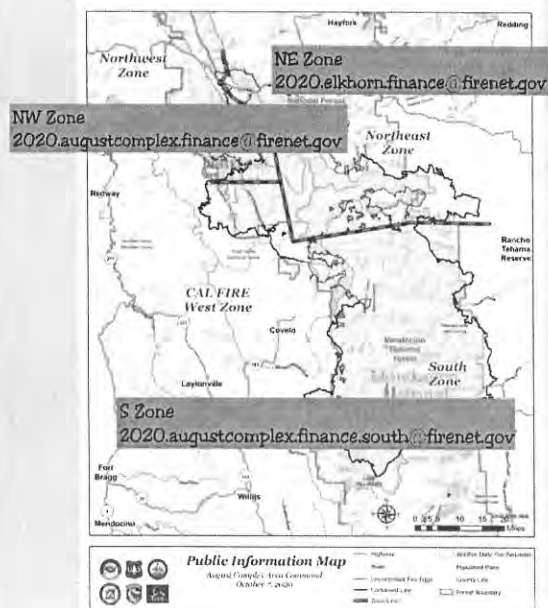

FOR A NON-EMERGENCY INCIDENT, WORK THROUGH CHAIN OF COMMAND TO REPORT AND TRANSPORT INJURED PERSONNEL AS NECESSARY.

FOR A MEDICAL EMERGENCY: IDENTIFY ON SCENE INCIDENT COMMANDER BY NAME AND POSITION AND ANNOUNCE "MEDICAL EMERGENCY" TO INITIATE RESPONSE FROM IMT COMMUNICATIONS/DISPATCH.

Use the following items to communicate situation to communications/dispatch.

1. CONTACT COMMUNICATIONS / DISPATCH (Verify correct frequency prior to starting report)

Ex: "Communications, Div. Alpha. Stand-by for Emergency Traffic."

2. INCIDENT STATUS: Provide incident summary (including number of patients) and command structure.
