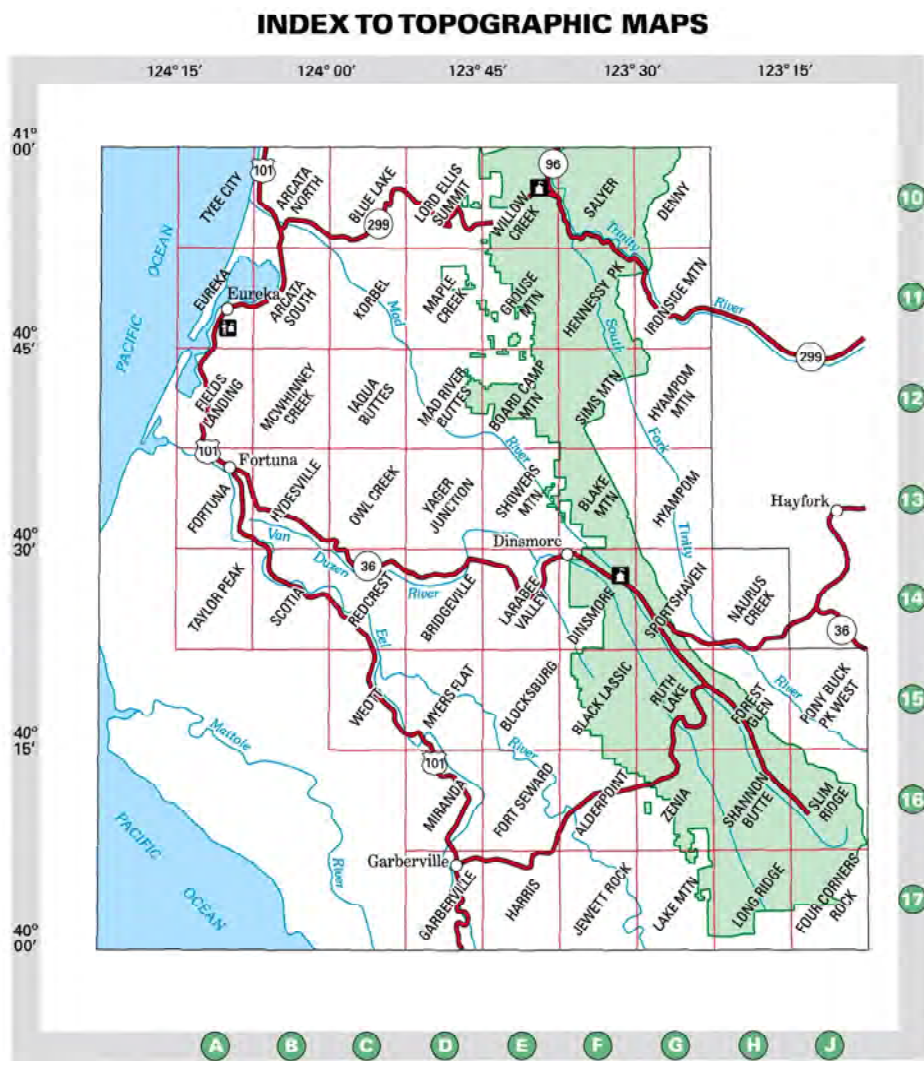




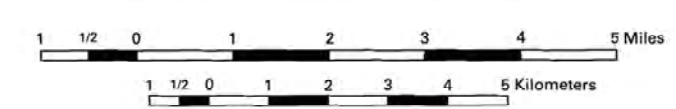
SOUTH HALF
