WEATHER DISCUSSION: Southwest winds will increase slightly ahead of an approaching trough of low pressure today. These winds will result in cooler temperatures, with increasing high clouds during the afternoon. In addition, areas of smoke will continue to impact the complex, which will produce localized cooler and higher RH values, especially in divisions Indigo, Kilo, Mic and Quebec. Localized gusts 10 to 14 mph are possible across the exposed midslopes western aspect areas during the afternoon hours. Overnight southwest winds will continue at ridgetops with slight better RH recoveries across the midslope and ridgetops.

EXTENDED OUTLOOK: Wednesday through Saturday: A trough of low pressure will approach the Pacific Northwest on Wednesday. This will result in breezy southwest winds of 10 to 15 mph with gusts up to 20 mph possible on exposed ridgetops on Wednesday afternoon into Thursday, along with a chance of scattered showers. This onshore flow will produce more clouds, cooler temperatures and higher RH values. Much warmer and drier weather returns by the weekend, along with north to northeast offshore flow as a strong ridge of high pressure builds across northern California.

WEATHER SUMMARY: ***Increasing Southwest Winds***

Temp: Max. 3,000': 74-79°, 5,000': 68-73°; Min. 3,000': 47-52°, 5,000': 56-62°. RH: Min. 3,000': 18-23%, 5,000': 22-27%; Max. 3,000': 70-80%, 5,000': 22-27%. Wind: 3,000' down slope in the morning becoming upslope 4-8 in the afternoon. 5,000' SW 5-9 mph with localized gusts 10-14 mph in the afternoon.

FUELS & FUEL MOISTURE:

- Fuels vary greatly based on elevation and aspect but are primarily timber with patches of open grass and areas of brush.
- At all elevations, fuels are critically dry and in all size classes, both live and dead.
- Heavy fuels are supporting fire spread even when weather conditions are not conducive for large fire growth.
- Significant grass load may lead to rapid rates of spread.

SPECIFIC:

Branch 21 – Slope and fuel alignment will result in increased fire behavior especially when caused by rollout. Heavy fuel concentrations will result in single and group tree torching. Burning should be active again in the afternoon with direct sun on the slope above Ruth. Overnight thermal belts will support burning in the mid to upper slopes.

West Structure Group – Heating of the slope above Ruth could cause the fire to become active again. Winds in the drainage bottom may be different than on slopes and affect firing operations differently than expected.

Branch 31 – Fire will continue to back down Rattlesnake Ridge to the north. Single and group tree torching will continue with heavy concentrations of fuels. Heat in fingers of fire across the South Fork of the Trinity will continue to have the ability to torch trees and throw spots over control lines.

North Structure Group – Fire is not expected to impact structures in Post Mountain. Southwest winds will make for smoky conditions and minimize the ability for fire to spread rapidly toward identified values.

Branch 40 - Minimal threats to the line are expected. Interior fuels will continue to burn out especially in areas that have heavy fuel concentrations to support combustion. The Buck fire scare will continue to check fire spread.

AIR OPERATIONS: Sunrise 0657 Sunset 1905. Continued southwest winds should allow for clearing in the Ruth area early afternoon, but keep Branch 31 smoky for most of the day.

SAFETY: Prefrontal winds have been a growth trigger on this fire in the past. Assess your work area for expected strong southwest winds will materialize on your division.

Safety Zone(s) are locations where the threatened firefighter may find refuge from the danger. Unfortunately, shelter deployment sites have been incorrectly called safety zones. Safety zones should be conceptualized and planned as a location where no shelter is needed. This does not intend for the firefighter to hesitate to deploy their shelter if needed, if a shelter is deployed the location is not a true safety zone. Fireline intensity and safety zone topographic location determine safety zone effectiveness.

How have you determined the distinction between a safety zone and a deployment zone?

- Is refuge in a vehicle or house an acceptable tactic?
- Consider access to the incident. You are often confronted with considerable distances of unburned fuel to cross.
- How do you manage Lookouts, Communications, Escape Routes, and Safety Zones (LCES)?

ATV/UTV Driving


- Must have helmet meeting motorcycle requirements/ at least ¾ face shield and flame-resistant material
- Must have Driver's License and have UTV/ATV operator on Red Card or Certificate
- Seat belts/shoulder harness must be fastened while in motion
- Speed limit in camp is 10 M.P.H.
- Pedestrians have the right of way

IMT COVID-19 INTENT for the AUGUST NORTH COMPLEX

All wildland firefighters must take COVID-19 messaging seriously and demonstrate consistent, preventative measures known to be effective in limiting viral spread. The Alaska IMT is reminding firefighters to apply the core values of wildland fire management community of "Duty, Respect, and Integrity" and apply these values to the COVID mitigation requirements:

- Duty: To provide a workforce safe from known hazards such as disease transmission, and keep us, our fellow firefighters, and the public safe, on and off the clock.
- Respect: To demonstrate respect to oneself and to each other by taking routine precautions as guided, such as wearing a mask and social distancing.
- Integrity: To do the right thing when at home, while travelling, or on assignment. Undertake the precautions to keep ourselves and the rest of the workforce healthy and able to respond, then we are not the source of an outbreak within the public we are assigned to protect.

Concept of "Module as One:"

Team members, crews, and other resources should use a "Module as One" approach to insulate as one unit and reduce exposure to the public and other crews. If each member within a unit is monitored, screened, and healthy, then proximity, when necessary, is not an issue.

By insulating as a unit, crews and modules can limit outside viral exposure and may safely complete operational tasks in closer proximity, and ride in vehicles without face coverings when working within their "Module as One" concept:

- As often as practical, the same team members should travel in the same vehicle, work together in the same space, and ensure module members are conscientious regrading mitigations.
- Identify select individuals on a crew or module that will interact with the public, ensuring this
 person relies on social distancing, wears a cloth face covering, and practices hand hygiene
 during or after every interaction.
- When the "Module as One" has been established, minimize contact with public and outside community. This is to protect every crew member, their family, and the community we serve.

Essential Mitigations:

- Pre-Screening and Regular Monitoring: Individuals should measure temperature and assess symptoms each day prior to starting work. Ideally, temperature checks should happen before the individual enters the facility or interacts with others on staff or the crew.
- **Social/Physical Distance:** The employee should maintain 6 feet and practice social distancing as work duties permit in the workplace.
- Wearing a Mask: Employees should always wear a facemask or face covering when social
 distancing cannot be maintained. When facemasks cannot be worn during arduous work tasks,
 social distancing practices should be implemented.
- Disinfect and Clean: Clean and disinfect all areas, particularly "high touch surfaces" such as
 engine compartments, bathrooms, common areas and shared electronic equipment routinely.
- Empower all individuals to ask co-workers to follow social distancing guidelines.
