WEATHER DISCUSSION: A weak boundary along with increasing northwest onshore flow will produce additional clouds and maybe a few sprinkles possible in the morning west of South Fork Ridge. As drier air moves into the region by afternoon, expect increasing sunshine with temperatures warming back into the 70s and minimum afternoon relative humidity values in the mid 20s to mid 30 range. This drying will continue overnight with developing breezy offshore flow and poorer relative humidity recoveries expected. This will be the beginning period of critical fire weather conditions for Sunday into Monday.

WEATHER: Morning clouds with a few sprinkles possible and areas of smoke, becoming partly sunny after 1400.

EXTENDED OUTLOOK: Saturday through Tuesday: ***A Red Flag Warning from 5 AM Sunday to 1200 Monday*** Critical fire weather conditions are expected to occur early Sunday morning into Monday across the August Complex as strong ridge of high pressure builds into northern California. This will produce gusty east to northeast winds of 15 to 20 mph with localized ridgetop gusts up to 35 mph, minimum afternoon humidity in the low teens and very poor overnight recoveries. Lighter winds, but very warm and dry conditions prevail most of next week.

INPUTS

FUELS & FUEL MOISTURE:

- Fuels vary greatly based on elevation and aspect but are primarily timber with patches of open grass and areas of brush.
- At all elevations, fuels are **critically dry** in all size classes, both live and dead.
- Heavy fuels are supporting fire spread even when weather conditions are not conducive for large fire growth.
- Significant grass load can support rapid rates of spread under favorable weather conditions.

SPECIFIC:

Branch 21 – Heavy fuel concentrations will result in single and group tree torching. Fire spread will continue to actively back down the slope. Flanking fire is possible when afternoon wind surfaces. Upper slopes will become active earlier than lower in the drainage.

Branch 31 – Winds will be favorable for continuing firing operations. Fine Dead Fuel Moistures between 5-10% will be the most conducive for firing. Fire will continue to back down Rattlesnake Ridge to the north. Areas around Red Mountain and below the 73 road will continue to be active in the afternoon especially on aligned ridges.

North Structure Group – The threat to Post Mountain will decrease slightly as the winds turn more NW. Fire progression below Highway 36 as well as firing will need to be monitored throughout the day.

Branch 40 - Minimal threats to the line are expected. Interior fuels will continue to burn out especially in areas that have heavy fuel concentrations to support combustion. The Buck fire scar will continue to check fire spread.

AIR OPERATIONS: Sunrise 0701 Sunset 1858. Lower elevations will have poor visibility in the morning but clearing through the day. At higher elevations there is a chance for better air in the afternoon.

SAFETY: Approaching weather systems can be viewed as a transition period for fire behavior. What you have experienced in the past may not be what you get during today's shift. Current and expected are important adjectives.

Look Up, Look Down, Look Around

- *Fuel Characteristics Assess prior to beginning operations.
- *Fuel Moisture Read daily shift plan and assess on site
- *Fuel Temperature Varies with exposure to direct sunlight.
- *Terrain & Fuel Accumulations Scout prior to beginning operations and continuously during operations.
- *Wind Measure, observe, feel and notice changes.
- *Atmospheric Stability Observe.
- *Fire Behavior Monitor constantly prior to and during operations.
- *Safety Ask questions in unfamiliar situations. The only dumb question is the one you did not ask.

Common Denominators of Fire Behavior On Tragedy Fires

- *Most incidents happen on the smaller fires or on Isolated portions of larger fires.
- *Most fires are innocent in appearance before the "Flare-ups" or "Blow-ups". In some cases, tragedies occur in the mop-up stage.
- *Flare-ups generally occur in deceptively light fuels.
- *Fires run uphill surprisingly fast in chimneys, gullies, chutes and on steep slopes.
- *Some suppression tools, such as helicopters or air tankers, can adversely affect fire behavior. The blasts of air from low flying helicopters and air tankers have been known to cause flare-ups.

From the Alaska Safety Team

IMT COVID-19 INTENT for the AUGUST NORTH COMPLEX

All wildland firefighters must take COVID-19 messaging seriously and demonstrate consistent, preventative measures known to be effective in limiting viral spread. The Alaska IMT is reminding firefighters to apply the core values of wildland fire management community of "Duty, Respect, and Integrity" and apply these values to the COVID mitigation requirements:

- **Duty**: To provide a workforce safe from known hazards such as disease transmission, and keep us, our fellow firefighters, and the public safe, on and off the clock.
- **Respect**: To demonstrate respect to oneself and to each other by taking routine precautions as guided, such as wearing a mask and social distancing.
- Integrity: To do the right thing when at home, while travelling, or on assignment. Undertake the precautions to keep ourselves and the rest of the workforce healthy and able to respond, then we are not the source of an outbreak within the public we are assigned to protect.

Concept of "Module as One:"

Team members, crews, and other resources should use a "Module as One" approach to insulate as one unit and reduce exposure to the public and other crews. If each member within a unit is monitored, screened, and healthy, then proximity, when necessary, is not an issue.

By insulating as a unit, crews and modules can limit outside viral exposure and may safely complete operational tasks in closer proximity, and ride in vehicles without face coverings when working within their "Module as One" concept:

- As often as practical, the same team members should travel in the same vehicle, work together in the same space, and ensure module members are conscientious regrading mitigations.
- Identify select individuals on a crew or module that will interact with the public, ensuring this person relies on social distancing, wears a cloth face covering, and practices hand hygiene during or after every interaction.
- When the "Module as One" has been established, minimize contact with public and outside community. This is to protect every crew member, their family, and the community we serve.


Essential Mitigations:

- Pre-Screening and Regular Monitoring: Individuals should measure temperature and assess symptoms each day prior to starting work. Ideally, temperature checks should happen before the individual enters the facility or interacts with others on staff or the crew.
- **Social/Physical Distance:** The employee should maintain 6 feet and practice social distancing as work duties permit in the workplace.
- Wearing a Mask: Employees should always wear a facemask or face covering when social distancing cannot be maintained. When facemasks cannot be worn during arduous work tasks, social distancing practices should be implemented.
- **Disinfect and Clean**: Clean and disinfect all areas, particularly "high touch surfaces" such as engine compartments, bathrooms, common areas and shared electronic equipment routinely.
- Empower all individuals to ask co-workers to follow social distancing guidelines.

Green- Provide immediate patient care, Notify Night Med Team or Ambulance on Tac. Med Team/ Ambulance will contact MEDL by phone at end of shift. Minimize, noncritical, operational radio traffic on Command and maintain situational awareness.

Yellow/ Red- Contact Communications on Command with a Medical Incident Report.

ICP/ Helibase Emergencies:

Call 911 and contact MEDL as soon as possible.
