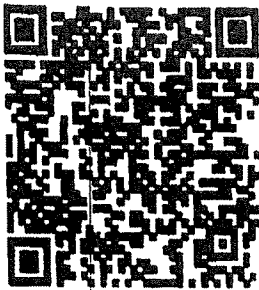

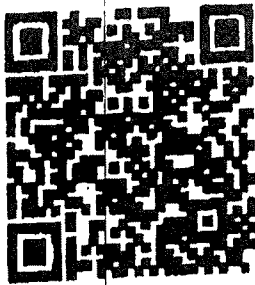

1. Incident Name: August Complex - North Zone	2. Operational Period: Date From: THR 10/01 Date To: FRI 10/02 Time From: 0700 Time To: 0700												
3. Objective(s): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide for firefighter and public safety by assessing and mitigating risk in order to develop and implement sound tactical operations. Ensure all resources have a clear understanding of assignments and associated hazards. • Provide for point protection within the fire area where it is safe to do so. Develop and implement direct and indirect contingency lines to protect communities, utility infrastructure, transportation corridors, county watersheds and timber values from immediate and long-term threats. • Stabilize and expand logistical support in identified spike camps on both the east and west side of the incident. Ensure all assigned resources have adequate sleeping, eating and support needs met to reduce firefighter fatigue. • Maintain and enhance relationships with agency partners, cooperators, stakeholders, and the public through timely and accurate information exchange. Ensure long-term strategies are communicated. • Ensure coordination and communication is taking place between South Zone, West Zone, and Area Command to provide unified strategic direction, efficient resource use, and common public messaging across all three zones. • Follow CDC, local, state, and federal COVID-19 mitigation guidance and protocols to reduce exposure and protect firefighters and the public from virus spread. • Treat all personnel with dignity and respect by providing a harassment free, zero-tolerance work 													
4. Operational Period Command Emphasis: Expanding logistical support to provide for adequate sleeping, meals, and supplies is the priority mission for this shift. All sections will support that mission as a priority operation to ensure a safe and orderly implementation in both Hayfork and Triumphant Life Spike. Due to firefighter fatigue, a calculated approach will be taken before implementing a major strategic shift.													
5. General Situational Awareness Always remain flexible during dynamic situations; carefully observe, calibrate and identify your next target. In order to establish new Tasks, Purpose and End States you must gather situational awareness before acting.

INPUTS

WEATHER SUMMARY: ***Warm and Dry with Thick Smoke***

FUELS & FUEL MOISTURE:

- Fuels vary greatly based on elevation and aspect but are primarily timber with heavy loads of grass and areas of thick brush.
- At all elevations, fuels are **critically dry** in all size classes, both live and dead.
- Fuels driven spread is possible when terrain is favorable even under an inversion.

Fine Fuels: 3-6% based on shading; 1000-hr 10%; ERCg Friend Mountain 75 (81st percentile); PIG 90%

SPECIFIC:

Branch 21 – Green islands in around structures will continue to burn out threaten values. Fire behavior will increase when the inversion lifts and winds surface, especially in areas of new growth. Significant heat around most of the perimeter has potential for spread in all directions.

Branch 31 – Smoky conditions will limit fire spread in the morning. Higher elevations aligned with winds will have the most potential for spread. Expect a significant increase in fire behavior in areas where the inversion lifts, and winds surface. Fire north of the South Fork of the Trinity will continue to easily spread in the 1987 Flume fire footprint. Strong drainage winds in the South Fork of the Trinity can greatly influence fire behavior when they surface.

North Structure Group – The threat to Post Mountain will remain elevated as the winds switch directions and the fire continues to spread on both sides Highway 36. Position of the fire south of 36 and west of Post Mountain needs to be monitored for potential impacts.

Branch 40 - Fire in Dog Gulch and Prospect Creek has potential to spread east into the head of Beegum Creek. Interior fuels will continue to burn out especially in areas that have heavy fuel concentrations to support combustion. The Buck fire scar continues to check fire spread but should be reassessed. Any new spots have significant potential for growth.

AIR OPERATIONS: Sunrise 0706 Sunset 1850. Smoky conditions will persist over the fire into the afternoon when the inversion possibility lifts 1600.

SAFETY: Strong west winds in the evening could affect the east side of the fire. This weather pattern has the potential for significant fire spread into the Sacramento Valley and increases focus on the east side of fire.

Human Factor Watch Outs

Watching out for yourself, coworkers, subordinates and your boss is a primary responsibility for everyone involved in high risk activities. Watch outs are not just for the tactical environment. The Human Factor Watch Outs are designed to create an opportunity for you to take a tactical pause and re-evaluate your situation.

If any of the following occur:

- Your briefing was unclear.
- You don't remember what took place in the last hour.
- You are not getting answers to your questions.
- You are not getting clear acknowledgement of your message.
- You are encountering hazards that are not mentioned in your brief.
- Your team is not debriefing.
- Your tempo is too high to maintain command and control.
- Your leaders intent is vague.
- Your supervisor's expectation is unrealistic.

From the Alaska Safety Team

IMT COVID-19 INTENT for the AUGUST NORTH COMPLEX

All wildland firefighters must take COVID-19 messaging seriously and demonstrate consistent, preventative measures known to be effective in limiting viral spread. The Alaska IMT is reminding firefighters to apply the core values of wildland fire management community of “Duty, Respect, and Integrity” and apply these values to the COVID mitigation requirements:

- **Duty:** To provide a workforce safe from known hazards such as disease transmission, and keep us, our fellow firefighters, and the public safe, on and off the clock.
- **Respect:** To demonstrate respect to oneself and to each other by taking routine precautions as guided, such as wearing a mask and social distancing.
- **Integrity:** To do the right thing when at home, while travelling, or on assignment. Undertake the precautions to keep ourselves and the rest of the workforce healthy and able to respond, then we are not the source of an outbreak within the public we are assigned to protect.

Concept of “Module as One:”

Team members, crews, and other resources should use a “Module as One” approach to insulate as one unit and reduce exposure to the public and other crews. If each member within a unit is monitored, screened, and healthy, then proximity, when necessary, is not an issue.

By insulating as a unit, crews and modules can limit outside viral exposure and may safely complete operational tasks in closer proximity, and ride in vehicles without face coverings when working within their “Module as One” concept:

- As often as practical, the same team members should travel in the same vehicle, work together in the same space, and ensure module members are conscientious regrading mitigations.
- Identify select individuals on a crew or module that will interact with the public, ensuring this person relies on social distancing, wears a cloth face covering, and practices hand hygiene during or after every interaction.
- When the “Module as One” has been established, minimize contact with public and outside community. This is to protect every crew member, their family, and the community we serve.

Essential Mitigations:

- **Pre-Screening and Regular Monitoring:** Individuals should measure temperature and assess symptoms each day prior to starting work. Ideally, temperature checks should happen before the individual enters the facility or interacts with others on staff or the crew.
- **Social/Physical Distance:** The employee should maintain 6 feet and practice social distancing as work duties permit in the workplace.
- **Wearing a Mask:** Employees should always wear a facemask or face covering when social distancing cannot be maintained. When facemasks cannot be worn during arduous work tasks, social distancing practices should be implemented.
- **Disinfect and Clean:** Clean and disinfect all areas, particularly “high touch surfaces” such as engine compartments, bathrooms, common areas and shared electronic equipment routinely.
- **Empower** all individuals to ask co-workers to follow social distancing guidelines.


