WEATHER DISCUSSION:

An area of high pressure aloft continues across Northern California, which is resulting in very warm and dry conditions. Little change is anticipated today with regards to relative humidity and temperatures, while thick areas of smoke persist across the August Complex. This smoke will limit surface heating a little and produce areas of slightly higher relative humidity values. Valley winds will becoming upslope/upvalley after 1300, while exposed aligned midslope and ridgetop winds are from the northwest at 6 to 12 mph with localized gusts up to 15 mph possible. A strong inversion will prevail most of the day, partially lifting after 1400.

EXTENDED OUTLOOK: Saturday through Tuesday: A strong ridge of high pressure both at the surface and aloft will prevail across Northern California into early next week. This will produce generally light terrain and thermally driven winds, with continued poor nighttime relative humidity recoveries on the midslope and ridgetops. Strong daily inversion persist, as mixing and transport winds are light, producing areas of thick smoke. Temperatures are mainly in the upper 70s to mid-80s depending upon aspect and elevation with daily minimum relative humidity values in the upper teens to mid 20s.

SPECIFIC:

Branch 21 – Green islands in around structures will continue to burn out. Fire behavior will increase when the inversion lifts and winds surface, especially in areas of new growth. Significant heat around most of the perimeter has potential for spread, mainly south, in aligned terrain.

Branch 31 – Smoky conditions will limit fire spread in the morning. Higher elevations aligned with winds will have the most potential for spread. Expect a significant increase in fire behavior in areas where the inversion lifts. Fire north of the Highway 36 will continue to spread based on topography. Strong drainage winds in the South Fork of the Trinity can greatly influence fire behavior when they surface.

North Structure Group – The threat to Post Mountain will remain elevated as the fire continues to spread on both sides Highway 36. Position of the fire south of 36 and west of Post Mountain needs to be monitored for potential impacts. Along Highway 36 scattered values have potential to be impacted by fire, especially if smoke clears.

Branch 40 – Fire around DP 125 will continue to be active, especially as afternoon winds surface. Interior fuels will continue to burn and poses moderate spotting potential. The Buck fire scar continues to check fire spread but should be continually reassessed. Any new spots have significant potential for growth.

AIR OPERATIONS: Sunrise 0707 Sunset 1848. Smoky conditions will persist over the fire into the afternoon when the inversion possibility lifts 1600.

SAFETY: Local alignment with any topographical features has potential to increase winds and also increase rates of spread and flame lengths significantly.

- Fatigue is cumulative without good rest and proper diet. Know your limits and watch out for one another.
- -Risk Management is a continuous process. Stay focused on your surroundings and the strategy and tactics of the day.

Hazard Tree Safety

Hazard trees, both dead snags and live green trees, are one of the most common risks encountered on the fireline. All firefighters should frequently survey their work area for potential hazard trees.

Hazard tree indicators:

- Trees burning for any period of time
- High risk tree species (rot and shallow roots)
- Numerous downed trees
- Dead, broken, or burning tops and limbs overhead
- · Accumulation of downed limbs
- · Absence of needles, bark or limbs
- Leaning or hung-up

In addition to suppression and mop up operations, assess, control, and monitor hazard trees along roads and when selecting break areas or campsites.

Wildland/Urban Interface Watchouts

- 1. Wooden construction and wood shake roofs.
- 2. Poor access and narrow one-way roads.
- 3. Inadequate water supply.
- 4. Combustible fuels 30 feet or closer to structures
- 5. Extreme fire behavior, and/or strong winds.
- 6. Poor access and egress.
- 7. Evacuation of public.
- 8. Structure located in chimneys, box canyons, or on steep slopes in flashy fuels.
- 9. Bridge load limits.

IMT COVID-19 INTENT for the AUGUST NORTH COMPLEX

All wildland firefighters must take COVID-19 messaging seriously and demonstrate consistent, preventative measures known to be effective in limiting viral spread. The Alaska IMT is reminding firefighters to apply the core values of wildland fire management community of "Duty, Respect, and Integrity" and apply these values to the COVID mitigation requirements:

- **Duty**: To provide a workforce safe from known hazards such as disease transmission, and keep us, our fellow firefighters, and the public safe, on and off the clock.
- Respect: To demonstrate respect to oneself and to each other by taking routine precautions as
 guided, such as wearing a mask and social distancing.
- Integrity: To do the right thing when at home, while travelling, or on assignment. Undertake the precautions to keep ourselves and the rest of the workforce healthy and able to respond, then we are not the source of an outbreak within the public we are assigned to protect.

Concept of "Module as One:"

Team members, crews, and other resources should use a "Module as One" approach to insulate as one unit and reduce exposure to the public and other crews. If each member within a unit is monitored, screened, and healthy, then proximity, when necessary, is not an issue.

By insulating as a unit, crews and modules can limit outside viral exposure and may safely complete operational tasks in closer proximity, and ride in vehicles without face coverings when working within their "Module as One" concept:

- As often as practical, the same team members should travel in the same vehicle, work together in the same space, and ensure module members are conscientious regrading mitigations.
- Identify select individuals on a crew or module that will interact with the public, ensuring this person relies on social distancing, wears a cloth face covering, and practices hand hygiene during or after every interaction.
- When the "Module as One" has been established, minimize contact with public and outside community. This is to protect every crew member, their family, and the community we serve.

Essential Mitigations:

- Pre-Screening and Regular Monitoring: Individuals should measure temperature and assess symptoms each day prior to starting work. Ideally, temperature checks should happen before the individual enters the facility or interacts with others on staff or the crew.
- **Social/Physical Distance:** The employee should maintain 6 feet and practice social distancing as work duties permit in the workplace.
- Wearing a Mask: Employees should always wear a facemask or face covering when social
 distancing cannot be maintained. When facemasks cannot be worn during arduous work tasks,
 social distancing practices should be implemented.
- **Disinfect and Clean**: Clean and disinfect all areas, particularly "high touch surfaces" such as engine compartments, bathrooms, common areas and shared electronic equipment routinely.
- Empower all individuals to ask co-workers to follow social distancing guidelines.

COVID-19 REPORTING, TRANSPORT AND TESTING

People with COVID-19 have had a wide range of symptoms reported – ranging from mild symptoms to severe illness.

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- · Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- · Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell.
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

This list does not include all possible symptoms. CDC will continue to update this list as we learn more about COVID-19

All personnel should be encouraged to self-monitor for symptoms before they come to work. Fire personnel who have symptoms of COVID-19 should immediately notify their supervisor and safety officer and self-isolate. If symptoms are severe contact medical personnel. Personnel in the symptomatic patient's group or module should be monitored for signs and symptoms. Contact the the COVID Coordinator for testing arrangements.
