WEATHER DISCUSSION:

Very subtle changes in temperatures and relative humidity values are anticipated today, as surface high pressure prevails across northern California. Valley winds will be light and terrain driven, while midslope and ridgetop winds are from the west-northwest with localized gusts up to 12 mph after 1400 in favorable aligned western aspect drainages. A wind shift to the east-southeast occurs after 2400 tonight, which is an offshore flow. This will result in poor midslope and ridgetop recoveries, but wind speeds will remain light.

WEATHER: Sunny with areas of dense smoke in the deeper valleys.

EXTENDED OUTLOOK: Sunday through Thursday: A strong ridge of high pressure both at the surface and aloft will slowly breakdown across Northern California by late this upcoming week. A period of light offshore winds are possible Sunday into Monday, otherwise terrain driven winds are expected through midweek. Strong daily inversion persist, as mixing and transport winds are light, producing areas of thick smoke. Temperatures are mainly in the upper 70s to mid-80s depending upon aspect and elevation with daily minimum relative humidity values in the upper teens to mid 20s.

SPECIFIC:

Branch 21 – Fire behavior will increase when the inversion lifts and winds surface, especially in areas of new growth. Significant heat around most of the perimeter has potential for spread, mainly south, in aligned terrain. Spread in the Picket Peak fire will continue to slowly move in receptive fuels.

Branch 31 – Smoky conditions will limit fire spread through most of the day. Higher elevations aligned with winds will have the most potential for spread. Expect a significant increase in fire behavior in areas where the inversion lifts. Fire north of the Highway 36 will continue to spread based on topography.

North Structure Group – The threat to Post Mountain will remain elevated as the fire continues to spread on both sides Highway 36. The progression of the fire south of 36 and west of Post Mountain needs to be monitored for potential impacts. Along Highway 36 scattered values have potential to be impacted by fire, especially if the smoke clears.

Branch 40 – Fire around DP 125 will continue to be active, especially if afternoon winds surface. Interior fuels will continue to consume. The Buck fire scar continues to check fire spread but should be continually reassessed.

AIR OPERATIONS: Sunrise 0708 Sunset 1847. Smoky conditions will persist over the fire into the afternoon when the inversion possibility lifts in the late afternoon.

SAFETY: Solar radiation and wind are still the main driver of fire growth. Unexpected clearing could result in a significant increase in fire behavior in all branches.

Fireline Leadership

The most essential element of successful wildland firefighting is competent and confident leadership. Leadership means providing purpose, direction and motivation for wildland firefighters working to accomplish difficult tasks under dangerous, stressful circumstances. In confusing and uncertain situations, a good operational leader will:

- TAKE CHARGE of assigned resources
- MOTIVATE firefighters with a "can do safely" attitude
- DEMONSTRATE INITIATIVE by taking action in the absence of orders
- COMMUNICATE by giving specific instructions and asking for feedback
- SUPERVISE at the scene of action

Steps to Effective Fireline Leadership:

- Determine tasks to be assigned, establish procedures to monitor and assess the crew, and inform the crew members of fire assignment progress.
- Establish and reaffirm norms of conduct for behavior in the group, and insist that people keep each other informed on what they were doing and the reasons for their actions, and the situational model that gave rise to those reasons and actions. This would include:
 - 1. Here's what I think we face:
 - 2. Here's what I think we should do:
 - 3. Here's why;
 - 4. Here's what we should keep our eye on;
 - 5. Now talk to me.
- Discuss ways to improve performance, ask for input; discuss problems.
- Tell crew members what to do, reallocate work in a dynamic situation, focus crew attention to task, provide feedback to crew on performance.

From the Alaska Safety Team

IMT COVID-19 INTENT for the AUGUST NORTH COMPLEX

All wildland firefighters must take COVID-19 messaging seriously and demonstrate consistent, preventative measures known to be effective in limiting viral spread. The Alaska IMT is reminding firefighters to apply the core values of wildland fire management community of "Duty, Respect, and Integrity" and apply these values to the COVID mitigation requirements:

- **Duty**: To provide a workforce safe from known hazards such as disease transmission, and keep us, our fellow firefighters, and the public safe, on and off the clock.
- **Respect**: To demonstrate respect to oneself and to each other by taking routine precautions as guided, such as wearing a mask and social distancing.
- Integrity: To do the right thing when at home, while travelling, or on assignment. Undertake the precautions to keep ourselves and the rest of the workforce healthy and able to respond, then we are not the source of an outbreak within the public we are assigned to protect.

Concept of "Module as One:"

Team members, crews, and other resources should use a "Module as One" approach to insulate as one unit and reduce exposure to the public and other crews. If each member within a unit is monitored, screened, and healthy, then proximity, when necessary, is not an issue.

By insulating as a unit, crews and modules can limit outside viral exposure and may safely complete operational tasks in closer proximity, and ride in vehicles without face coverings when working within their "Module as One" concept:

- As often as practical, the same team members should travel in the same vehicle, work together in the same space, and ensure module members are conscientious regrading mitigations.
- Identify select individuals on a crew or module that will interact with the public, ensuring this person relies on social distancing, wears a cloth face covering, and practices hand hygiene during or after every interaction.
- When the "Module as One" has been established, minimize contact with public and outside community. This is to protect every crew member, their family, and the community we serve.

Essential Mitigations:

- Pre-Screening and Regular Monitoring: Individuals should measure temperature and assess symptoms each day prior to starting work. Ideally, temperature checks should happen before the individual enters the facility or interacts with others on staff or the crew.
- **Social/Physical Distance:** The employee should maintain 6 feet and practice social distancing as work duties permit in the workplace.
- Wearing a Mask: Employees should always wear a facemask or face covering when social distancing cannot be maintained. When facemasks cannot be worn during arduous work tasks, social distancing practices should be implemented.
- Disinfect and Clean: Clean and disinfect all areas, particularly "high touch surfaces" such as engine compartments, bathrooms, common areas and shared electronic equipment routinely.
- Empower all individuals to ask co-workers to follow social distancing guidelines.

COVID-19 REPORTING, TRANSPORT AND TESTING

People with COVID-19 have had a wide range of symptoms reported ranging from mild symptoms to severe illness.

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- · Congestion or runny nose
- · Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

This list does not include all possible symptoms. The CDC will continue to update this list as we learn more about COVID-19.

All personnel should be encouraged to self-monitor for symptoms before they come to work. Fire personnel who have symptoms of COVID-19 should immediately notify their supervisor, safety officer and self-isolate. If symptoms are severe contact medical personnel. Personnel in the symptomatic patient's group or module should be monitored for signs and symptoms. Contact the the COVID Coordinator for testing arrangements.

- A "New Collection" folder will be created. You can tap the to rename the folder.

Add New Maps to a Collection Folder

- When you are in the Collection Folder, tap
- Choose the route to get your map.

Move Existing Maps to the Collection Folder

- From main screen tap EDIT
- Select all the maps you would like added to the new folder.
- Tap move icon .
- Select the new collection folder you created.

**Unless you delete out old maps, make a new collection folder for each operational period. Do not add the same map extent from different days into the same folder.

When you access a single map from a collection folder, you will easily be able to pan between map and tap the extent window to switch between all maps in the folder without having to back out of the map view.

Green- Provide immediate patient care, Notify Night Med Team or Ambulance on Tac. Med Team/ Ambulance will contact MEDL by phone at end of shift. Minimize, noncritical, operational radio traffic on Command and maintain situational awareness. **Yellow/ Red-** Contact Communications on Command with a Medical Incident Report.

ICP/ Helibase Emergencies:

Call 911 and contact MEDL as soon as possible.
