WEATHER DISCUSSION:

Smoke and winds will be the big factors influencing today's weather. Expect smoke over the fire area this morning, much of which was from yesterday's activity that became trapped under the inversion last night. Deeper valleys will continue to experience thick smoke and will reduce visibilities under a mile for much of the day. Smoke along the midslopes and ridges will likely thin during the morning, but south to southwest winds of 5 to 9 mph will develop along the midslopes and ridges. This will likely push smoke from the northwest and west zones back over to the northeast zone in the afternoon and affect air operations. Winds at the lower elevations will be terrain driven and upslope/upvalley in the afternoon. Otherwise expect temperatures and humidities to once again be similar to yesterday. Highs will be 5 to 10 degrees above normal and with fair to poor humidity recoveries along the midslopes and ridges, afternoon relative humidities will lower into the 15 to 25 percent range. Lowest values will once again be along the midslopes and ridges. Winds will become light and terrain driven at night with south to southwest winds remaining along the midslopes and ridges. Smoke will continue to persist over the fire tonight and remain thick in the lower valleys.

TODAY:

WEATHER: Sunny with areas of dense smoke, especially in the deeper valleys.

MAX TEMP: 3000 feet: 79-83°

WINDS: (20 FEET) **3000** feet: Downvalley/downslope 2 to 4 mph, becoming upslope/upvalley 3 to 5 mph after 1300. **5000** feet: Variable 3 to 5 miles in the morning, then south-southwest 5 to 9 mph in the afternoon.

MIXING HEIGHT: Rising to 6000 feet by 1500. TRANSPORT WIND: Southwest at 3 to 5 mph.

VISIBILITY: 2 to 4 miles, but below 1 mile in the deeper valleys.

WEATHER: Clear with areas of thick smoke resulting in very low visibility.

EXTENDED OUTLOOK: Wednesday through Sunday: Wednesday will see similar conditions to Tuesday with smoke being the main factor once again. Cooler temperatures and higher humidities move in Thursday and especially Friday into Saturday as an upper level trough of low pressure approaches. This feature should bring some precipitation to northern California.

Warm and dry weather will continue through Wednesday followed by increasing onshore flow accompanied by cooler and more humid conditions during the second half of the week.

FUELS & FUEL MOISTURE:

Fuels and Fire Behavior Advisory in effect for Northern California Geographic Area

- Fuels vary greatly based on elevation and aspect but are primarily timber with heavy loads of grass and areas of thick brush.
- At all elevations, fuels are **critically dry** in all size classes, both live and dead.
- Fuels driven spread is possible when terrain is favorable even under an inversion.

Fine Fuels: 3%-exposed and 6%-shaded; 1000-hr 9%; ERC-G Aug. SIG 68 (90th percentile); PIG 60-90%

OUTPUTS - FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL:

With poor overnight RH recovery, lower RH's, and increased temperatures, fire behavior for Tuesday should be similar to Monday. Fuels are at critical levels and if smoke clears, resulting in greater solar radiation, the fuels become more available and expect active fire behavior. This is compounded with winds typically involved with the clearing of the smoke, also contributing to increased fire behavior. As seen on Saturday, when slope and fuels are in alignment, major advances in fire movement can occur anywhere on the Northeast Zone of the August Complex. Any spots outside of control lines could be problematic based upon location of spots and resources available to respond.

Fire behavior predictions are for surface fire during the hottest and driest period of the day.

SPECIFIC:

Branch 31 – Smoky conditions will limit fire spread. Higher elevations aligned with winds will have the most potential for spread. Fire north of the Highway 36 will continue to spread, if unchecked, based on topography with influences from the Trinity River. On the south side of Highway 36, fire will continue to back down slope. The threat to Trinity Pines/Post Mountain will remain as the fire continues to back down to Highway 36.

Branch 40 – Smoky conditions will limit fire spread, unless clearing occurs resulting in increased fire behavior. Fire in the upper reaches of the North Fork of Beegum Creek will continue to be active with backing and increased fire behavior if smoke clears. Interior fuels will continue to consume.

Night Operations – Be aware of potential down canyon/down drainage influences on fire behavior. Poor RH recovery will allow fire to burn into the evening. Thick smoke can develop in low lying areas reducing visibility.

AIR OPERATIONS: Sunrise 0711 Sunset 1842. Smoky conditions will persist in the valley/canyon bottoms with limited chances for clear on the ridges for air operations.

SAFETY: Contingency operations continue away from the fire perimeter –

Remember Watch Out Situation #10 – Cannot see main fire, not in contact with anyone who can.

Minimize, noncritical, operational radio traffic on Command and maintain situational awareness. Yellow/ Red- Contact Communications on Command with a Medical Incident Report.

ICP/ Helibase Emergencies:

Call 911 and contact MEDL and Comms as soon as possible.

NARRATIVE:

Many of us are demobing in the next couple of days and please remember that your assignment is not over until you are home safe and sound. That means additional time on the road, Driving is one of the most hazardous things we do because we literally perform the task hundreds of times in the course of our daily lives – we tend to take it for granted. Based on recent accident trends, vehicle accidents are the source of more deaths and serious injuries to wildland firefighters than any other single cause.

- To be a safe driver you have to want to be one. Take a good hard look at your driving habits. Are you training yourself to do the right things the right way, like fastening your seat belt, checking your mirrors, and maintaining safe following distances?
- Inattentiveness is a major contributing factor in motor vehicle accidents within the wildland firefighting community. Since the average adult attention span is 15-20 minutes we must develop techniques that allow us to refocus our attention on our driving.
- Many things can lure our attention away from our driving such as fatigue, eating and drinking, reading directions and maps, writing, cell phone and radio use, conversation within the vehicle, and music.
 - Drive only when you are well-rested and alert and avoid driving during the hours of 10:00 PM and 6:00 AM. Take a 10- to 15-minute break after every 2 hours.
 - Practice situational awareness; be aware of what is happening in front, behind, and on both sides of your vehicle.
 - Never drive when taking medications that make you drowsy.
 - Delegate navigation and communication to a passenger or pull over.
 - By constantly moving your vision, checking mirrors, and distant road conditions, you can avoid highway hypnosis and daydreaming.
 - Avoid eating or drinking while driving.
 - When talking with passengers, keep your eyes on the road and both hands on the steering wheel. Avoid serious or argumentative conversations.
 - Switch off driving with others if multiple people are in the vehicle.
 - Do not be in a hurry, be patient.

From the Alaska Safety Team

IMT COVID-19 INTENT for the AUGUST NORTH COMPLEX

All wildland firefighters must take COVID-19 messaging seriously and demonstrate consistent, preventative measures known to be effective in limiting viral spread. The Alaska IMT is reminding firefighters to apply the core values of wildland fire management community of "Duty, Respect, and Integrity" and apply these values to the COVID mitigation requirements:

- **Duty**: To provide a workforce safe from known hazards such as disease transmission, and keep us, our fellow firefighters, and the public safe, on and off the clock.
- Respect: To demonstrate respect to oneself and to each other by taking routine precautions as guided, such as wearing a mask and social distancing.
- Integrity: To do the right thing when at home, while travelling, or on assignment. Undertake the precautions to keep ourselves and the rest of the workforce healthy and able to respond, then we are not the source of an outbreak within the public we are assigned to protect.

Concept of "Module as One:"

Team members, crews, and other resources should use a "Module as One" approach to insulate as one unit and reduce exposure to the public and other crews. If each member within a unit is monitored, screened, and healthy, then proximity, when necessary, is not an issue.

By insulating as a unit, crews and modules can limit outside viral exposure and may safely complete operational tasks in closer proximity, and ride in vehicles without face coverings when working within their "Module as One" concept:

- As often as practical, the same team members should travel in the same vehicle, work together in the same space, and ensure module members are conscientious regrading mitigations.
- Identify select individuals on a crew or module that will interact with the public, ensuring this person relies on social distancing, wears a cloth face covering, and practices hand hygiene during or after every interaction.
- When the "Module as One" has been established, minimize contact with public and outside community. This is to protect every crew member, their family, and the community we serve.

Essential Mitigations:

- **Pre-Screening and Regular Monitoring**: Individuals should measure temperature and assess symptoms each day prior to starting work. Ideally, temperature checks should happen before the individual enters the facility or interacts with others on staff or the crew.
- **Social/Physical Distance:** The employee should maintain 6 feet and practice social distancing as work duties permit in the workplace.
- Wearing a Mask: Employees should always wear a facemask or face covering when social
 distancing cannot be maintained. When facemasks cannot be worn during arduous work tasks,
 social distancing practices should be implemented.
- **Disinfect and Clean:** Clean and disinfect all areas, particularly "high touch surfaces" such as engine compartments, bathrooms, common areas and shared electronic equipment routinely.
- Empower all individuals to ask co-workers to follow social distancing guidelines.

COVID-19 REPORTING, TRANSPORT AND TESTING

People with COVID-19 have had a wide range of symptoms reported ranging from mild symptoms to severe illness.

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea


This list does not include all possible symptoms. The CDC will continue to update this list as we learn more about COVID-19.

All personnel should be encouraged to self-monitor for symptoms before they come to work. Fire personnel who have symptoms of COVID-19 should immediately notify their supervisor, safety officer and self-isolate. If symptoms are severe contact medical personnel.
