Discussion:

Moisture will continue to increase and temperatures continue to fall ahead of the approaching cold front on Saturday. Winds will be very similar to Thursday with generally light terrain-driven winds in the morning giving way to SW-W winds in the afternoon. Expect gusts to 20 mph along the ridges to develop during the afternoon. Saturday will bring our best chance for any rainfall with potentially up to 0.10" for parts of the Complex. Saturday will also bring moderate SW winds which will shift from SW to NW overnight into Sunday as the front passes through Northern CA.

Branch 21- Continued backing fire into the S. Trinity. Late afternoon will see an acceleration of downslope winds and any active edges will produce short range spotting.

Ruth Structure Group- Smoldering black and stumps will continue to weaken trees and meander in leaf litter. Expect to see terrain driven winds pushing remaining fire edges into the black during the morning, with a shift in spread potential to the NE by late afternoon.

Branch 15/13- Firing operations can expect a short window of opportunity between 1100-1600. Downslope winds will accelerate backing fire edges into the drainage bottoms, with potential for short uphill runs towards Mule Ridge. Heavy timber litter will support group torching and short duration runs to the North and Northeast. Active fire in the Bradbury Cr drainage will continue to push toward Mossy dip. Firing operations moving from Mossy Dip dozer line towards DP-92 will have accelerated rates of spread in the late afternoon, followed by an increase in RH.

Div T- Firing operations will be supported by the W-SW winds today, however any pockets of heavy fuels can produce downslope spots due to swirling winds around terrain feature in this area. Expect to see periods of extended fire growth in the unburnt between Pothole Cr and the dozerline. Edge activity will make short pulses of wind/slope runs.

NIGHT SHIFT- Rinse and repeat with more moisture. Continued SW winds into the early morning hours, followed by potential for hit and miss showers.

AIR OPERATIONS:

Clearly skies will emerge before noon, over most of the fire area. Drainages will hold smoke layer into the late afternoon. Locations in the NE zones and along HWY36 will have short clearing periods, but sock in the late afternoon.

FIRE BEHAVIOR SAFETY

Arrival of higher winds for the next few days will also bring unstable air pressure. The next few days will see increasing West-Southwest winds before any chance of precipitation shows up Friday night/Saturday morning.

Creating a "Margin" For Safety

What is Margin?

Developing ways to increase the system's capacity to weather error/surprise and uncertainty without consequence.

Margin attempts to describe the influence that collective working conditions have on decisions and actions. The focus centers on understanding the capacity to cope with uncertainty, error and surprise. Margin is designed to help users describe the potential for the system to do harm before an accident occurs.

How do I build margin into my mission?

- Build practical time frames for implementation (account for rapid fire spread, human error, and mechanical breakdowns).
- Discuss with your team how the plan might fail and adapt prior to engagement (Pre-Mortem).
- Pick the "Right Ridge" rather than the "Next Ridge".
- Reduce as much uncertainty as possible (Scouting, Ground-Truthing, Spot Weather Forecasts, Solid Anchors/Egress).
- Close communication gaps as soon as possible.
- Consider "The Five Right's". Place, Time, Resource, Reason, and Duration.

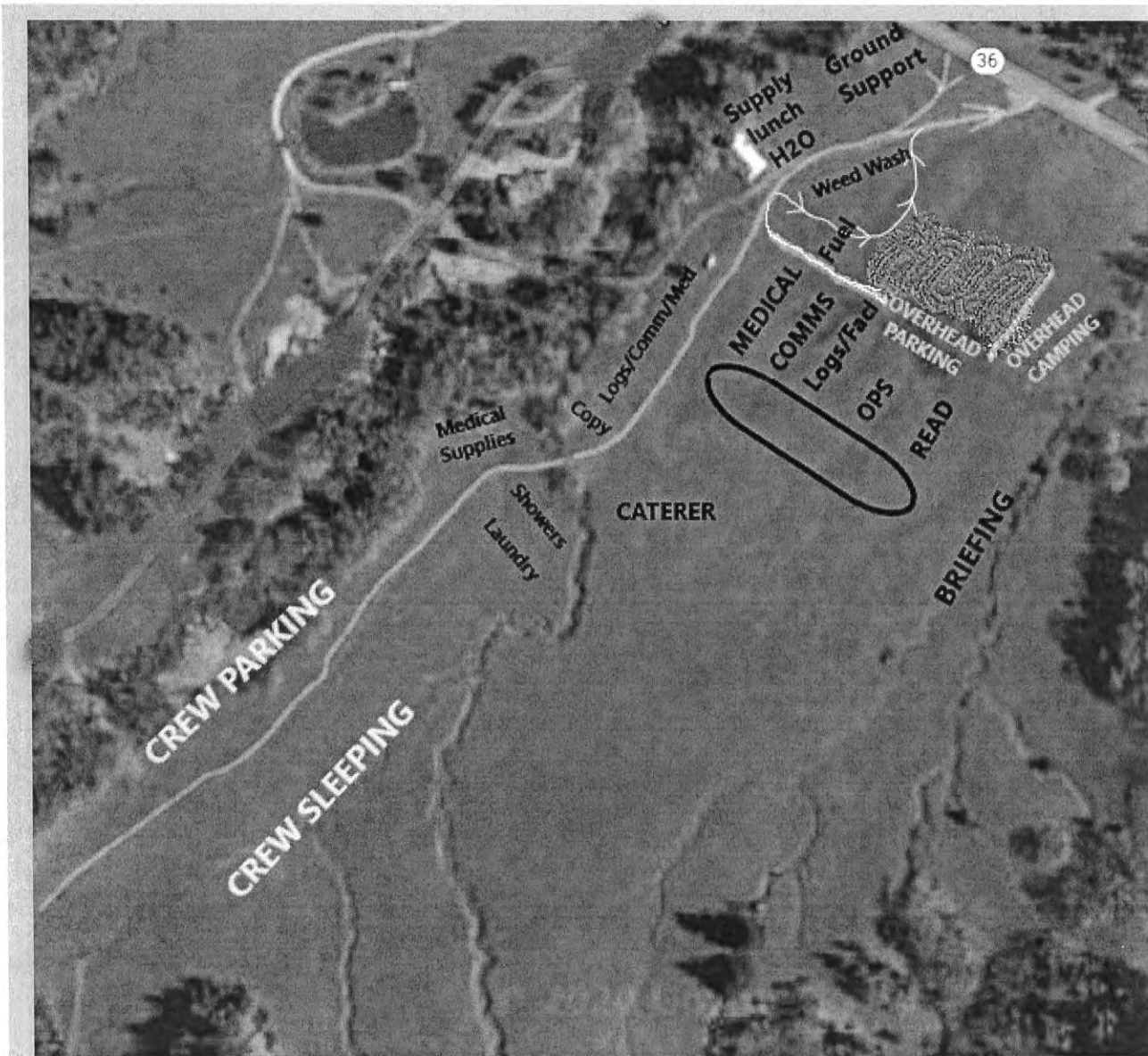

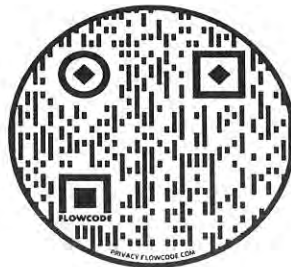

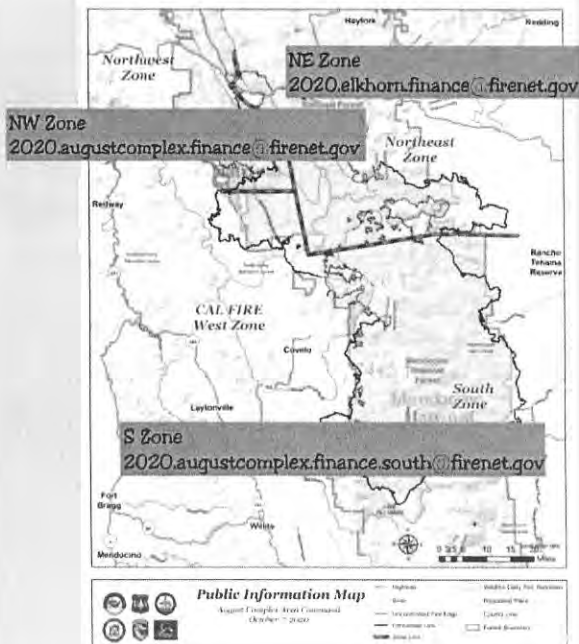
