Ash Pits and Burn Injuries

NARRATIVE:

Ash pits pose a significant risk to fire fighter safety

The amount of heat in an ash pit may not be readily apparent. Its smoke can be faint and dissipate quickly. The top layer of ash can be much higher than the bottom of the pit—concealing how deep the ash pit really is.

Ash pits that are deeper than the height of a firefighter's boots can quickly lead to burns to the leg above the boot line. An ash pit that is deeper than expected can also cause a loss of balance to the firefighter stepping into the pit, making it more difficult to get out and leading to more severe burns.

Ash Pit Mitigation and Guidance:


- Base actions on risk informed decision making using experienced fire fighters.
- Ask questions to clarify hazards and be well informed.
- When setting work priorities, ask yourself if you really need to be there.
- Be aware that the risks with ash pits are often not visible and may extend well beyond the immediate area.
- Scout areas and use probes to test for extent and depth of ash beds.
- Identify and flag ash pits, snags, and hazard trees.
- Maintain a high level of situational awareness at all times.

Ensure all Medical Resources are in place to provide rapid response to medical incidents. Field Operations must determine medical response times for all medical resources before engaging. Average ground transport times from all Divisions to a Level 2 or 3 hospital is 3-4 hrs depending on roadblocks, road conditions, visibility and location of IWI.

Special Medical Emergency Procedures:

Follow the Medical Incident Report (MIR) on the back of the IAP
ALL MEDICAL RESOURCES CHECK IN AND OUT WITH COMMS DAILY. IF YOU CAN NOT CONNECT WITH COMMS, MOVE TO A BETTER LOCATION.

Daily- Establish your PACE (Primary, Alternative, Contingency, Emergency) model for medical emergency extraction.

Fireline/ Spike Camp Medical Transports and Emergencies:

Green - Provide immediate patient care, Notify Branch/Division Medic or EMT on Tac. Medic or EMT will contact MEDL by phone at earliest convenience. Minimize, non-critical, operational radio traffic on Command and maintain situational awareness.

Yellow/Red- Contact Eureka Communications on Command with a Medical Incident Report.

Night Shift

Green- Provide immediate patient care, Notify Night Med Team or Ambulance on Tac. Med Team/ Ambulance will contact MEDL by phone at end of shift. Minimize, non-critical, operational radio traffic on Command and maintain situational awareness.

Yellow/ Red- Contact Eureka Communications on Command with a Medical Incident Report.

ICP/ Helibase Emergencies:

Call 911 and contact MFDI and Comms as soon as possible.

FOR A NON-EMERGENCY INCIDENT, WORK THROUGH CHAIN OF COMMAND TO REPORT AND TRANSPORT INJURED PERSONNEL AS NECESSARY.

FOR A MEDICAL EMERGENCY: IDENTIFY ON SCENE INCIDENT COMMANDER BY NAME AND POSITION AND ANNOUNCE "MEDICAL EMERGENCY" TO INITIATE RESPONSE FROM IMT COMMUNICATIONS/DISPATCH.

Use the following items to communicate situation to communications/dispatch.

1. CONTACT COMMUNICATIONS / DISPATCH (Verify correct frequency prior to starting report)

Ex: "Communications, Div. Alpha. Stand-by for Emergency Traffic."

2. INCIDENT STATUS: Provide incident summary (including number of patients) and command structure.

Ex: "Communications, I have a Red priority patient, unconscious, struck by a falling tree. Requesting air ambulance to Forest Road 1 at (Lat./Long.) This will be the Trout Meadow Medical, IC is TFLD Jones. EMT Smith is providing medical care."
