ALL NW DIVISIONS- The range in rainfall amounts across the NW zone has provided the needed relief to critically dry fuels <3" in size. Heavy fuels are still very dry due to extended drought and heat stress. It will take several days of dry winds and radiant heat (the sun) to dry out the fine fuels again and allow for continuous surface fire. Smoldering stumps and large logs will continue to consume, especially beneath the soil surface. As winds shift to the NE (Wednesday) expect a drop in fuel moisture allowing small diameter fuels to resume activity.

Night Shift- Large diameter fuels and stumps will continue to burn throughout the evening. Fine fuels and 10 hr fuels will need several more days of drying to carry any surface fire. Roots are still smoldering beneath the surface.

AIR OPERATIONS:

Smoke layer has been scoured out at all levels. Clear visibility should provide opportunities throughout the day. NE winds will be moving into the area late Wednesday.

FIRE BEHAVIOR SAFETY

Most of the NW zone is now in a state of smoldering and creeping surface fire. Due to the extended drought and limited precipitation with this incoming front, heavy fuels will remain active and have potential to re-kindle right into the black with the forecasted winds.

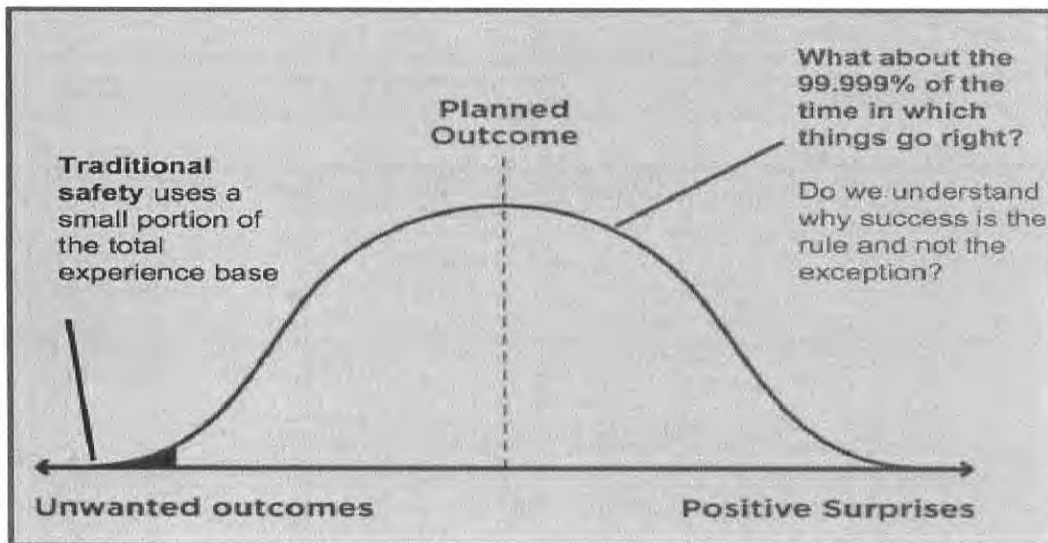

Why Do Things Go Right? (Short Summary of a Blog Post by Sidney Dekker)

In his 2014 *Safety I and Safety II: The past and future of safety management*, Erik Hollnagel makes the argument that we should not (just) try to stop things from going wrong. Instead, we need to understand why most things go right, and then ensure that as much as possible indeed goes right.



The way to make the red part (unwanted outcomes) on the left smaller is not by making it impossible for things to go wrong (as we've done almost everything in that regard already). We make the red part smaller by making the white part bigger, focusing on why things go right and enhancing the capacities that make it so. Figure by Kelvin Gern

Is it possible that we have reduced the number of unwanted outcomes as much as possible given our current system of safety? Will another checklist or standard reduce them further? **What if we analyzed good outcomes and focused energy on what went right?** Consider building capacity in the following categories:

- Diversity of opinion and the possibility to voice dissent.
- Keeping a discussion on risk alive and not taking past success as a guarantee for safety.
- Deference to expertise.
- Ability to say stop.
- Broken down barriers between hierarchies and departments.
- Don't wait for audits or inspections to improve.
- Pride of workmanship.

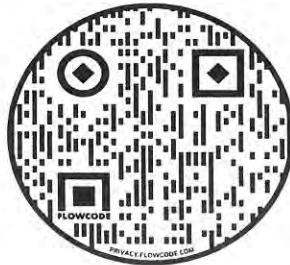

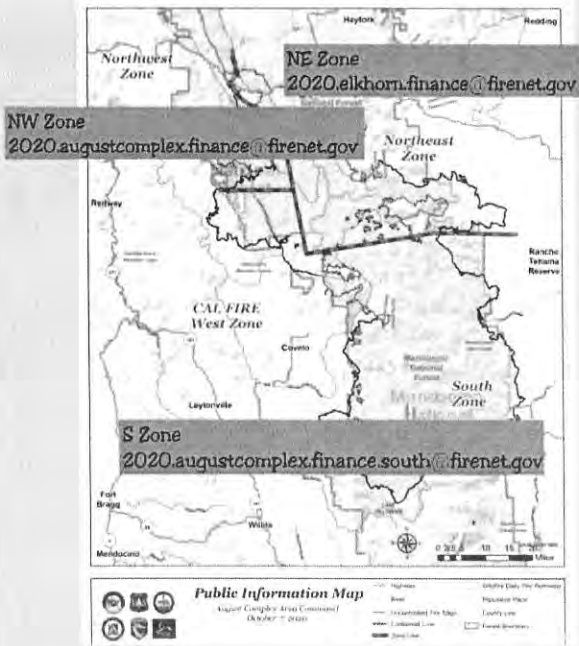


