*****FIRE WEATHER WATCH WEDNESDAY NIGHT THROUGH FRIDAY MORNING*****

Discussion:

High pressure is bringing a return to warmer and drier conditions. Today will be another day of slow warming and drying with relatively light winds. But overnight tonight into Wednesday, dry air will push back over the ridges and hamper recoveries. This will set the tone going forward with increasing N-NE winds ushering dry air over the fire, especially over the ridges. Wednesday will see the new pattern fully materialize as temperatures approach 90° and RHs drop into the teens.

WEATHER FORECAST FOR TODAY:

SKY/WEATHER: Still warmer and drier.
Max Temperature: 82-88 in valleys. 72-77 higher elevations.
Min RH: 17-23%.

WINDS:

-20 ft Level-WINDS

Lower Valleys/Lower Slopes: Terrain-driven 3-6 mph becoming W-NW 4-7 mph.
Upper Ridges: W-NW winds 8-12 mph.
TRANSPORT WINDS: NW 10-15 mph. **Mixing Height:** 5,000 ft.

TONIGHT:

SKY/WEATHER: Clear.
Min Temperature: Low mid 30s to mid 40s in valleys. 45 to 55 higher elevations.
Max RH: 70 to 80% in valleys. 35 to 45% higher elevations- falling to 25% by early morning.

WINDS:

-20 ft Level-
Valleys/Lower Slopes: NW 3-5 mph becoming terrain-driven/downslope.
Upper Ridges: NW 7-11 mph shifting to N overnight.

WEDNESDAY:

SKY/WEATHER: Warming, much drier, and haze.
Max Temperature: 83-89 in valleys. 75-80 higher elevations.
Min RH: 13-18%.

WINDS:

-20 ft Level-WINDS

Lower Valleys/Lower Slopes: Terrain-driven 3-6 mph becoming N-NE 5-8 mph with gusts to 10 mph in the afternoon.
Upper Ridges: NE winds 8-12 mph increasing to 10-15 mph during the afternoon.
TRANSPORT WINDS: N 15 -20 mph. **Mixing Height:** 6,000 ft.

Outlook Thursday through Saturday:

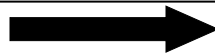

INPUTS

WEATHER SUMMARY: Warning and drying will continue. Winds remain light. Look for RH to drop during night shift towards morning.

See attached Fire Weather Forecast.

OUTPUTS

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL: Fire activity will still be affected by the recent rainfall. Fuels will continue to dry and increase in activity. Generally clear conditions will aid in fuels drying with increased sun and decreasing humidity.

Fuel Conditions: Heavy fuels remain dry.

SPECIFIC:

All Divisions: Expect smoldering, creeping and surface fire to increase with a return to sunny, dry weather without the smoke layer to moderate conditions.

Increased heat will be seen across the fire, potential for more active surface fire and torching as fire moves under available canopy. Light winds will keep any potential spotting to very short range.

Main areas of concern are in Division A1 in the Bradburn Creek area and in Division C1 in the West Fork of Van Duesen River.

Heavy fuels will not have recovered with the short duration rain event. Fine fuels and brush on high energy aspects will become active with drying conditions. Light winds will limit fire spread,

Night Shift: Expect quiet conditions except where unburned islands may flare up. Heavy fuels, stump holes and logs will continue to burn and rollout could cause increased activity.

AIR OPERATIONS:

Aviation operations should continue to experience good flying conditions.

SAFETY

Snags continue to fall without warning. Combined with stump holes, you will need to be looking both up and down for safety.

Give clear instructions and be sure they are understood.

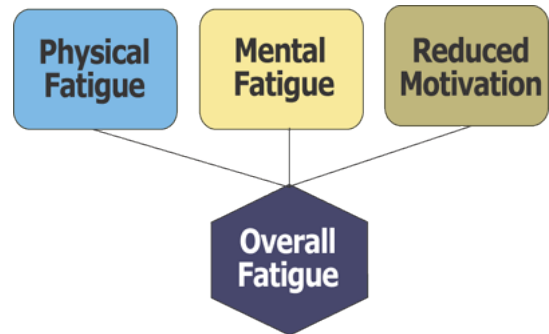
- Today is the first day after transition. Know who you are reporting to.
- Brief others as needed.
- Don't assume they know what you mean.

Hazard Trees

- Follow “Hazard Tree Safety” guidelines **IRPG page 22**
- Post lookouts or spotters in mop-up areas.
- Don't take breaks in high concentrations of hazard trees
- Consider the effect of wind on hazard trees
- Remember the hazard zone is 2 ½ times the tree height
- Use qualified fallers to mitigate snags



Fatigue Management



- Fatigue management goes beyond counting hours on timesheets, it is individualized and overt.
- Cumulative fatigue is dangerous. It prevents sound decision-making, confounds situational awareness, and dulls reaction times. It is as problematic in the office as it is on the fireline.
- Cumulative fatigue is manifest in the explanations used when folks are asked to take a break, or take a day off... “I don't have time.” “There is too much going on.” “As soon as things calm down a bit.”

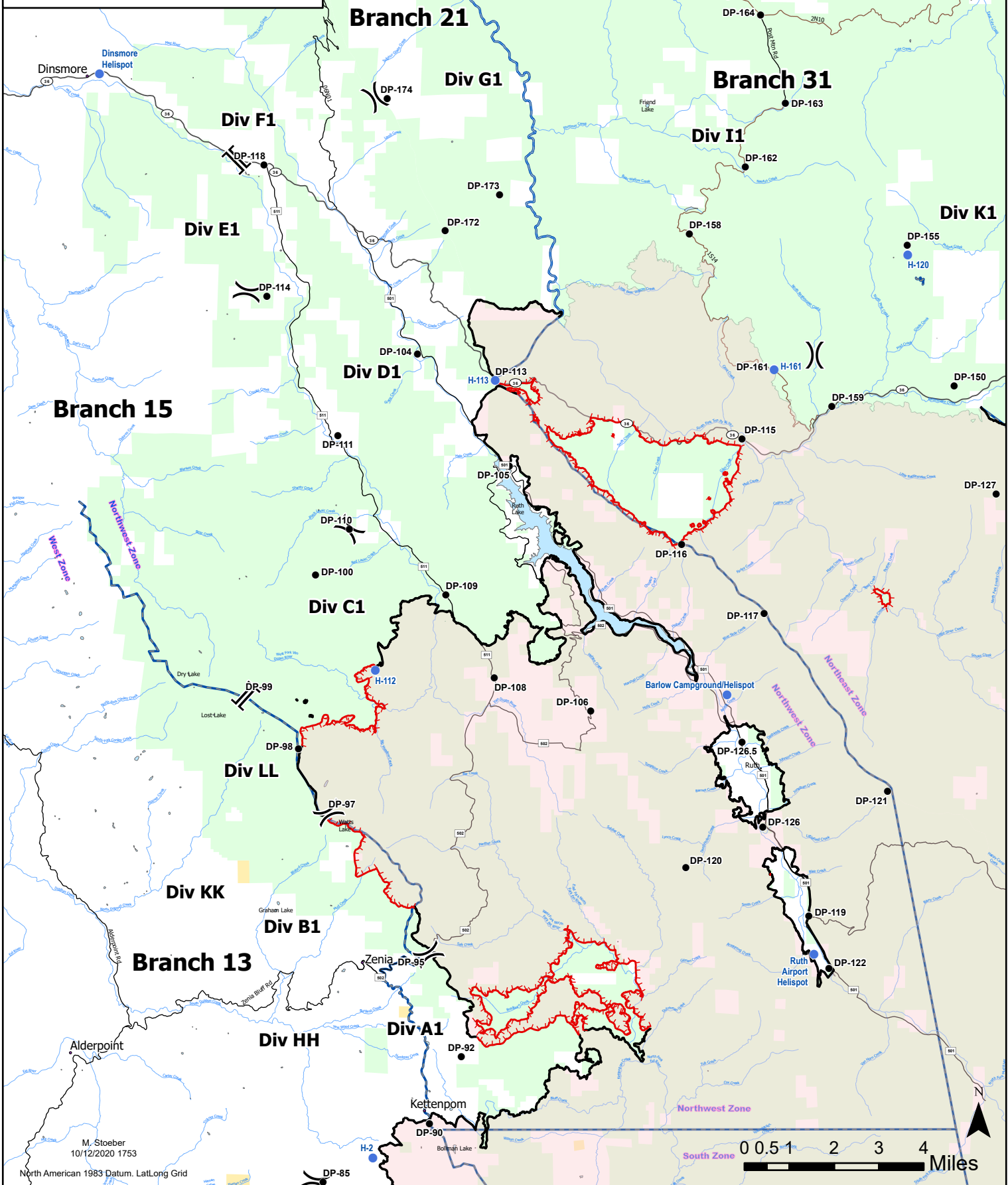
