Leaders Intent: Suppress the North Complex and Sheep Fires using a full range of management tactics & strategies that minimize exposure to firefighters, communities and reduce the susceptibility to COVID19.

Management Objectives

- Ensure safety of emergency responders & public utilizing strategies & risk management processes.
- Protect natural and cultural resources, commercial timber and critical infrastructure while utilizing resource and agency advisors.
- Foster and maintain good relationships with local cooperators, stakeholders and public while providing coordinated, accurate and timely information.
- Effectively manage cost by implementing strategies and tactics that have a high probability of success.

Control Objectives

- Suppress all new fires in the complex on the Mt Hough RD
- Keep all fires within existing perimeters

Sheep Fire - keep the fire within the existing perimeter

Claremont Fire – keep the fire:

- South and West of Pine Creek Valley
- East of the Minerva Trail and 1999 Pidgeon Fire burn scar
- North of Cleghorn Bar Road and Trail

Bear Fire – keep the fire:

- West of the Minerva Trail and 1999 Pidgeon Fire burn scar
- North of the Middle Fork Feather River
- East of Road 23N60 and Hartman Bar Trail
- South of Roads 24N28, 23N14, and 23N16
