EATHER DISCUSSION: Daily afternoon southwest breezes will prevail this afternoon with warm and dry conditions continuing into Saturday. An incoming low pressure system may increase SW wind gusts on Sunday and into early next week with critical fire weather conditions possible. No precipitation is expected into early next week.

FIRE BEHAVIOR

Similar conditions as yesterday, moderate to high risk burn environment due to high temperatures, low RH and critically low fuel moistures, live and dead. Limited overnight recovery on ridge tops. Local Thresholds will be exceeded again today, 20' wind over 6mph, RH less than 20%, Temperature over 80 degrees and 10hr FM less than 5% (see forecasted above). Where fuel, topography and wind align, expect a significant increase in fire activity. A Haines of 5 will bring moderate potential for instability and dry air over the fire area, which can increase overall fire behavior.

SPECIFIC FIRE BEHAVIOR:

Branch VII South Zone:

Division BB: Fuel/topography driven fire consisting of flanking, upslope movement and slope reversals.

Division DD: Expect fuel/topography driven fire with potential for active fire behavior with SW/NE drainage alignment.

Division JJ: SW/NE drainage alignment will increase fire behavior. Anticipate fire activity from the West Zone (CALFire).

Division GG: Expect fuel/topography driven fire with potential for active fire behavior from SW/NE drainage alignment.

Branch X North Zone:

Division AA/TT: Minimal fire activity expected in DIV AA. In DIV TT, firing operations will be challenged with the predicted SW wind. Potential for rollout and upslope runs.

Division P: Creeping and smoldering

Division MM/QQ: Expect significant fire activity as the fire continues to advance to the North with SW/NE drainage alignment and receptive fuel beds.

Division P/S/V/X/Z: These divisions are in mop-up/patrol status. Interior islands will continue to smolder and creep.

Night Division: Forecasted cooler temperatures. Low RH on the ridge tops but much higher in the valleys. Winds will be SW 5-10 mph. Firing operations will be challenged with the PIG at 28% and adverse winds.

AIR OPERATIONS

Air operations over the entire incident will be limited due to smokey conditions.

Use available time for briefings on roads, terrain, and potential rolling material, especially if the resources are new to the area. Increase SA by trying to see the work area during daylight hours. Use glow sticks to mark hazards, and ensure personnel have headlamps.

Firing Operations

Have a firing operations plan in place. Brief all resources in firing operations, identify firing teams and holding teams.

- Post adequate Lookouts.
- Have a good starting and ending point for firing.
- Hazards: Drip Torch Fuel, Firing Devices and Projectiles.
- Wear and use all PPE.
- Know what your fire is doing at all times.

Carbon Monoxide, Particulate Matter, and Smoke Exposure

General signs and symptoms and associated levels of CO exposure:

- <u>Low</u> No appreciable effect, except shortness of breath on vigorous exertion; possible tightness across the forehead; dilation of cutaneous (along skin) blood vessels.
- <u>Moderate</u> Shortness of breath on moderate exertion; occasional headache with throbbing in the temples, Headache; irritable; easily fatigued; judgment disturbed; possible dizziness; dimness of vision.
- <u>High</u>: Headache, confusion; collapse; fainting on exertion Unconsciousness; intermittent convulsion; respiratory failure, death if exposure is long continued.

Identify hazards and mitigations prior to operational shifts. As fire increases, anticipate an increase of Carbon Monoxide, Particulate Matter, and Smoke in areas that previously were clear of smoke and reducing firefighter smoke exposure.

Back to the Basics

- Size-Up; when does it start and when does it end?
- You can size up the weather, fuels, topography and the condition of crews enroute to a fire.
- Once on the incident, size-up should be occurring constantly to keep up situational awareness.
- Size-up doesn't end at demob. It ends when you're back at home, after your gear is repacked and reset for the next assignment.

North Complex COVID-19 Expectations

- All incident personnel will follow all local, State and CDC guidelines for COVID-19.
- As you travel through the local communities proximal to the fire, be mindful that in the State of California, face coverings are required inside local businesses.
- Being a Federal fire, incident personnel are expected to comply with the following Region 5 and incident guidance.
- Use the COVID-19 Daily Screening Tool, provided in the IAP, to monitor self and module.
- Utilize Module-as-one concepts to reduce the risk of transmitting the novel Coronavirus.
 This limits "close contacts" to those within the module. A "close contact" is defined as less than 6 feet, for at least 15 minutes with or without face coverings/masks.
- <u>Social Distancing.</u> Maintain a minimum of 6' physical distancing, especially from those outside of your module-as-one.
- <u>Face Coverings.</u> Face coverings are required to be worn, in the appropriate manner covering nose and mouth, when at ICP and camps. Outside of camp, all incident personnel will wear a face covering when social distancing is not possible, especially with those outside your module-as-one.
- Wash your hands. Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after blowing you nose, coughing or sneezing. If soap and water are not readily available, use a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol. Do not use hand sanitizers containing methanol or 1-propanol. Cover all surfaces of your hands and rub them together until they feel dry. Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Clean and disinfect vehicles and equipment. Disinfect all high-touch surfaces frequently, such as radios, phones, door handles, etc.

Finance message

Due to lack of resources nationwide and the inability to obtain new resources to replace those that are reaching their maximum length of assignment, the following guidelines apply.

HEALTH, READINESS, AND CAPABILITY MUST BE CONSIDERED PRIOR TO ASSIGNING INCIDENT PERSONNEL BACK TO BACK ASSIGNMENTS. THE HEALTH AND SAFETY OF INCIDENT PERSONNEL AND RESOURCES WILL NOT BE COMPROMISED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.

Federal employees, Local and out of state cooperating agencies

- 1. Obtain written approval from home unit supervisor
- 2. Obtain written approval from DIVS for extension or crew swap
- 3. See Resources Unit at ICP 4-5 days prior to 14th working day
- 4. If approved to extend, obtain extension form from DMOB
 - Extension options:
 - i. Extend to 21 days (exclusive of travel to and from incident. Time spent in staging and preposition status count towards the 21 day assignment.)
 - ii. Extend to 30 days. Inclusive of mandatory days off and exclusive of travel. (must have 2 days R&R between day 15-21)
- 5. Extension form needs to be signed by approvers listed.
- 6. For crew swap, bring 213 (Equipment Operator/Crew Change) to Check-in with Operations signature, method of travel, names of <u>all personnel</u> replacing existing crew, and home dispatch unit contact information.
 - Note crew swap on time documents and provide to finance
 - Replacement crew must arrive on 14th day of the existing crews work assignment and be available to work the following day
 - Bring fireline safety cards and ID.

Private contractors

- 1. Obtain written approval from Operations on 213 (general message) and bring to Resources Unit.
 - After working 14 days you must take at least 2 days R&R unpaid and can return to incident for an additional 14 day assignment.
 - At any time between day 1-14 you can swap personnel and provide information of new crew members to Check-In and Finance.
 - After a 30-day assignment, an extra 14 days can be considered.

HUMAN RESOURCE MESSAGEReporting Harassment

Many employees who are facing workplace harassment formally report it. Perhaps they don't want to cause trouble, they don't trust their company to act, or they fear reprisals from the harasser or coworkers.

While these concerns are understandable, it's very important to report workplace harassment to your HR department or other decision makers. If you don't report harassment, there won't be a chance to deal with it and make it stop.

This incident has a policy on harassment to include reporting misconduct to the HRSP. The incident HRSP has the capability of addressing misconduct on the incident as well as reaching out to your home agency to ensure harassment stops when you get back to your home unit.

There will be zero tolerance of harassment, bullying, intimidation or any resemblance of such on this incident period.

Maidu Requests for Visiting Homeland

1. "Be good to the land and the land will be good to you." Maidu quote

Thank you fire fighters for helping us keep our homes and cultural sites safe.

2. Enjoy your visit in the Mountain Maidu and Valley Maidu homelands.

Archeological sites and the resources they contain are not public property. A place, site or resource may have significance to a family or local tribe, which often carries with it a special level of protection.

3. Take care to avoid injuries.

Cultural sites are very old and fragile. Archeological resources are anything over 50 years old and can therefore erode easily. Also, historic dump sites can be hazardous, with sharp glass, rusty metal, and compounds and chemicals that can harm you.

4. Enjoy with care.

Oils from skin damage pictographs (rock paintings) and petroglyphs (rock carvings). It ruins irreplaceable historic resources, and it is illegal.

5. Don't touch the knickknacks.

ALWAYS LEAVE ARTIFACTS RIGHT WHERE YOU FIND THEM. Out of context, artifacts mean little to archeologists. Often the most important aspect of archeological resources is their relationship to the place and other adjacent resources. Archeological sites and artifacts are our direct link to stories that otherwise might not be told. How can these stories be complete or accurate if the setting is altered or lost? For this and other reasons, it is illegal to move or remove artifacts.

6. Feel free to discover.

Some of the sites are identified, and some sites are not recorded. If you happen to come across a cultural site we ask you to treat it like you would any cultural artifact. And note the location and report it to a Resource Advisor.

Speak with resource advisors about the potential for archaeological sites being located adjacent to roads or proposed fire lines. It's easy to destroy features and artifacts in the dark.

Over approximately 160 years, many changes have reshaped tribal relationships with
these vast landscapes as well as with each other, and yet our knowledge of and
responsibilities to these incredibly rich and vast landscapes remains strong. We
appreciate your dedication to care for and building your own relationships with our
natural environment while protecting these fragile and irreplaceable resources!
