## \*\*\*RED FLAG WARNING TODAY (Gusty SW Winds and Low RH) \*\*\*

**WEATHER DISCUSSION:** An approaching low pressure system will continue to increase SW winds through the afternoon with a combination of gusty winds and low humidity expected. A Red Flag Warning is in effect for the incident from 11am-8pm. Breezy southerly winds will remain overnight along ridgetop and upper slopes locations with poor humidity recovery expected.

Today (0600-1800):

Weather: Gusty southwest winds, dry. Smoke decreasing aloft through the afternoon.

**High Temperatures:** (24hr Trend: +3°F Ridges)

Upper Slopes & Ridges: 75-80°F (24-26°C) Mid Slopes & Valleys: 81-86°F (27-30°C)

Afternoon Min RH: 13-18% (24hr Trend: Little Change)

**20 Foot Winds:** (24hr Trend: +5mph)

Ridges/Above 6,000': Slopes winds becoming SSW 13-18 mph after 1300. Gusts up to 35 mph (16-21G35kph) Valleys/Below 6,000': Slopes winds becoming SW 8-14 mph after 1300. Gusts up to 30 mph (9-15G35kph)

2-5 Day Outlook, Tuesday-Friday: Gusty SW Winds continue through Thursday. Cooler, higher RH Thu-Fri.

An extend period of gusty SW winds will continue through at least Thursday as an area of low pressure slow moves onshore through the week. Periods of near critical fire weather conditions will be possible Tuesday before humidity increases after mid-week as the low moves onshore. Cooler conditions and lighter winds will prevail by Thu-Fri.

WEATHER: Gusty SW winds, dry. Smoke/Sunny.

**FUELS:** The major fuel types, found in and around the fire area are timber litter and shrubs.

**Ignition Receptiveness:** ERC levels just below the 90<sup>th</sup> percentile. Probability of Ignition Day 90% Night 40%.

**Dryness:** Dead and down fuel moistures: 1 hour – 3% day, 10 hour – 5%, 100 hour – 6%, and 1000 hour – 6%.

#### **FIRE BEHAVIOR**

## \*\*\* Local Thresholds exceeded\*\*\*

Expect SW gusty winds and low RH. The fuels remain dry and drought stressed, both live and dead. Be aware of fire behavior in and around SW/NE oriented drainages. Winds (gust 30 mph) can intensify and become erratic. In smoke shaded areas the fire remains very active (upslope runs, group torching and short-range spotting). Fire can get into the crowns relatively easy with slope and wind alignment.

### SPECIFIC FIRE BEHAVIOR:

#### **Branch X North Zone:**

Division AA/TT: Minimal fire activity expected in Div AA. In Div TT, expect interior smoldering.

**Division MM:** Expect active fire behavior as the fire continues to advance to the North uninterrupted with the smoke inversion. The fire continues to move across the ridges and will start to back and slope reverse. Potential for upslope running and spotting.

Division QQ: Backing from firing operation. Potential for rollout and spotting.

**Division P/S/V/X/Z:** These divisions are in mop-up/patrol status. Interior islands will continue to smolder and creep.

### **Branch VII South Zone:**

**Division BB:** Fuel/topography driven fire consisting of flanking, upslope movement and slope reversals especially in the Minervia and Onion Valley area. Be mindful of SW/NE oriented drainages.

Division DD: Backing from firing operations. Smoldering and creeping near the containment line.

Division GG: Smoldering and creeping near containment line.

**Division JJ:** Smoldering and creeping near containment line. Potential for fire activity from the West Zone (CALFire).

**Night Division:** Moderate temperatures tonight. Low RH on the ridge tops but much higher in the valleys. Winds will be SW 8-12 mph then down drainage 4-7 after 2300. Firing and holding operations should be successful after 2300. A PIG of 40 will keep spot fires manageable. Fuels continue to remain receptive and burn readily at night.

#### AIR OPERATIONS

Air operations over the entire incident will be extremely limited due to smokey conditions.

#### **OPERATIONAL TEMPO**

Maintaining operational tempo is not solely about speeding up to match or exceed the pace of the environment. It's also about knowing when operations should slow down and why.

We are most vulnerable to accidents and errors when operational tempo changes, especially when it changes quickly.

Maintaining good situation awareness in spite of change in operational tempo represents a considerable challenge.

The key to managing operational tempo successfully is monitoring the changing environment and capabilities of the team, and then applying good judgment to determine whether to push forward or pull back while making necessary adjustments.

#### PREPARE FOR A MEDICAL EMERGENCY

Practice reporting the 8-Line Medical Protocol with all crew members. An emergency shouldn't be the first time that the process is reviewed. Know where the closest medical staff is located. Pre plan travel routes and utilize drop points as rendezvous locations if needed. Have a plan in case aircraft are unavailable. Know who else is medically trained within assigned resources.

# Safety is No Accident!

- Situational Awareness: gathering information about your surroundings.
- Hazard Assessment: identify the tactical hazard.
- Hazard Control: develop mitigations to reduce or eliminate risk.
- Decision Point: are mitigations in place and timely?
- Evaluate: What is changing? Are strategy and tactics working? Is fatigue becoming a bigger factor?
- Be deliberate in your actions and have a purpose for performing a task.
- You are the last line of defense in safety.
   It comes down to you!

#### **End of Assignment Watch-Outs**

- Not mentally engaged in the task at hand
- Your driver is driving faster than when you got here
- Not giving good, thorough briefings
- Your hardhat and web gear are still on the truck
- Assuming all is good because you worked this piece of ground yesterday
- All the conversations are around what you're going to do when you get home
- You and your folks are tripping and stumbling more than usual
- It's taking you longer to get out of camp
- No AAR after each shift

## North Complex COVID-19 Expectations

- All incident personnel will follow all local, State and CDC guidelines for COVID-19.
- As you travel through the local communities proximal to the fire, be mindful that in the State of California, face coverings are required inside local businesses.
- Being a Federal fire, incident personnel are expected to comply with the following Region 5 and incident guidance.
- Use the COVID-19 Daily Screening Tool, provided in the IAP, to monitor self and module.
- Utilize Module-as-one concepts to reduce the risk of transmitting the novel Coronavirus. This limits "close contacts" to those within the module. A "close contact" is defined as less than 6 feet, for at least 15 minutes with or without face coverings/masks.
- <u>Social Distancing.</u> Maintain a minimum of 6' physical distancing, especially from those outside of your module-as-one.
- Face Coverings. Face coverings are required to be worn, in the appropriate manner covering nose and mouth, when at ICP and camps. Outside of camp, all incident personnel will wear a face covering when social distancing is not possible, especially with those outside your module-as-one.
- Wash your hands. Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after blowing you nose, coughing or sneezing. If soap and water are not readily available, use a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol. Do not use hand sanitizers containing methanol or 1-propanol. Cover all surfaces of your hands and rub them together until they feel dry. Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Clean and disinfect vehicles and equipment. Disinfect all high-touch surfaces frequently, such as radios, phones, door handles, etc.

#### **EXTENSION PROCESS**

Due to lack of resources nationwide and the inability to obtain new resources to replace those that are reaching their maximum length of assignment, the following guidelines apply.

HEALTH, READINESS, AND CAPABILITY MUST BE CONSIDERED PRIOR TO ASSIGNING INCIDENT PERSONNEL BACK TO BACK ASSIGNMENTS. THE HEALTH AND SAFETY OF INCIDENT PERSONNEL AND RESOURCES WILL NOT BE COMPROMISED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.

#### Federal employees, Local and out of state cooperating agencies

- 1. Obtain written approval from home unit supervisor
- 2. Obtain written approval from DIVS for extension or crew swap
- 3. See Resources Unit at ICP 4-5 days prior to 14<sup>th</sup> working day
- 4. If approved to extend, obtain extension form from DMOB
  - Extension options:
    - i. Extend to 21 days (exclusive of travel to and from incident. Time spent in staging and preposition status count towards the 21 day assignment.)
    - ii. Extend to 30 days. Inclusive of mandatory days off and exclusive of travel. (must have 2 days R&R between day 15-21)
- 5. Extension form needs to be signed by approvers listed.
- For crew swap, bring 213 (Equipment Operator/Crew Change) to Check-in with
  Operations signature, method of travel, names of <u>all personnel</u> replacing existing crew,
  and home dispatch unit contact information.
  - Note crew swap on time documents and provide to finance
  - Replacement crew must arrive on 14<sup>th</sup> day of the existing crews work assignment and be available to work the following day
  - Bring fireline safety cards and ID.

#### **Private contractors**

- 1. Obtain written approval from Operations on 213 (general message) and bring to Resources Unit.
  - After working 14 days you must take at least 2 days R&R unpaid and can return to incident for an additional 14 day assignment.
  - At any time between day 1-14 you can swap personnel and provide information of new crew members to Check-In and Finance.
  - After a 30-day assignment, an extra 14 days can be considered.

As teammates we must maintain this readiness throughout the incident by making sure we're supporting and checking in with each other. This must be done often so we may effectively keep our focus on the objectives and together overcome all challenges we face.

# **Maidu Requests for Visiting Homeland**

#### 1. "Be good to the land and the land will be good to you." Maidu quote

Thank you fire fighters for helping us keep our homes and cultural sites safe.

#### Enjoy your visit in the Mountain Maidu and Valley Maidu homelands.

Archeological sites and the resources they contain are not public property. A place, site or resource may have significance to a family or local tribe, which often carries with it a special level of protection.

#### 3. Take care to avoid injuries.

Cultural sites are very old and fragile. Archeological resources are anything over 50 years old and can therefore erode easily. Also, historic dump sites can be hazardous, with sharp glass, rusty metal, and compounds and chemicals that can harm you.

#### 4. Enjoy with care.

Oils from skin damage pictographs (rock paintings) and petroglyphs (rock carvings). It ruins irreplaceable historic resources, and it is illegal.

#### 5. Don't touch the knickknacks.

ALWAYS LEAVE ARTIFACTS RIGHT WHERE YOU FIND THEM. Out of context, artifacts mean little to archeologists. Often the most important aspect of archeological resources is their relationship to the place and other adjacent resources. Archeological sites and artifacts are our direct link to stories that otherwise might not be told. How can these stories be complete or accurate if the setting is altered or lost? For this and other reasons, it is illegal to move or remove artifacts.

#### 6. Feel free to discover.

Some of the sites are identified, and some sites are not recorded. If you happen to come across a cultural site we ask you to treat it like you would any cultural artifact. And note the location and report it to a Resource Advisor.

Speak with resource advisors about the potential for archaeological sites being located adjacent to roads or proposed fire lines. It's easy to destroy features and artifacts in the dark.


