### Warm and Dry today. Thunderstorms possible Saturday

WEATHER DISCUSSION: Low pressure exiting the region today. Conditions will be slightly warmer, but also more stable as high pressure approaches late this afternoon. Expect fire smoke will not clear the area as has been the case for the last several days. A warming trend returns Friday and Saturday with increasing mixing heights again. Moisture from Hurricane Elida off Baja California will bring a thunderstorm threat Saturday afternoon and evening. Sunday will be slightly cooler but bring southerly winds. This will be a new direction not yet experienced by these fires.

Today (0600-1800):

Weather: Sunny. Smoke hanging over the fire.

High Temperatures: Red Fire: 76-87°; Salmon Fire: 73-78°.

Humidity: Red Fire 16-25%, lowest around 1500 hrs, rising through 1800 hrs.

Salmon 23-28%; lowest near 1100 hrs, then slowly rising through 1800 hrs.

20 Foot Winds:

Lower/Mid Slopes: Variable 0-3 mph until 1000, then terrain driven 4-8 mph.

**Upper Slopes:** Variable 0-3 until 1200, becoming Northwest 5-7 mph.

LAL: 1

Chance of Wetting Rain (0.10"): 0%

Stability: Low valley inversions lift around 1100 hrs. Mid-level inversion slightly lifts around 1300 hrs.

Afternoon Mixing Height: Valleys: 5,000 feet AGL. Ridges: 6,000 feet AGL.

Tonight (1800-0600):

Weather: Clear. Smoke settling in area drainages.

Low Temperatures: Red Fire: 61-67°; Salmon Fire: 57-61°.

Humidity: Red Fire: Hovering around 35-40% from 1900 hrs to 0200 hrs, then falling to 25-30% by 0600 hrs.

Salmon Fire: Slowly rising to 40-45% near 0300 hrs, then falling to 30-35% by 0600 hrs.

20 Foot Winds:

Lower/Mid Slopes: Variable 3-5 mph until 2300 hrs, then drainage 4-6 mph.

Ridges: Northwest 5-7 mph until 2200 hrs, then Variable 0-4 mph.

LAL: 1

Chance of Wetting Rain (0.10"): 0%

Inversion: Strong inversion/thermal belt centered around 4,500 ft MSL.

<u>Friday:</u> Mostly sunny and Hot. Areas of smoke. Max Temps: 81-92°. Afternoon RH: Red Fire 19-27%, Salmon Fire 25-30%. Afternoon Winds - Lower Slopes: Variable/Terrain Driven. Upper slopes: Northwest 5-7 mph.

<u>Saturday and Sunday Outlook:</u> Hot, dry and unstable Saturday with a 35% chance of a thunderstorm. Slightly cooler Sunday. Temperatures in the upper 80s to lower 90s. Afternoon humidity 22-32%. Continued moderate humidity recovery largely staying 40% and below overnight.

### **WEATHER SUMMARY:**

DISCUSSION...The low pressure will be moving out of the area today which will usher in warmer dryer weather. We will also experience more stability in the afternoon with the associated high pressure and an increase in mixing height. A thunderstorm is forecasted for Saturday due to Hurricane Elida off the coast of Baja. A South wind is projected to materialize Sunday and Monday. The incident has not been tested by a South wind, expect a potential change in fire behavior.

#### **FIRE BEHAVIOR**

#### **GENERAL**

Fire behavior will intensify with the increase in temperature and lower humilities. The fire will remain terrain driven and topography influenced. Expect active surface fire and occasional torching. Short terrain driven runs should be expected as the fire aligns with terrain and wind. As the fire moves towards lower elevations, more fuel will be available to burn as live fuel moistures are near 100% around 2000 feet.

Spotting distance: up to .1-.2 of a mile.

Probability of ignition: 59-80% shaded and unshaded

Predicted ERC: 77
Predicted BI: 81

Timber ROS: 5-11 ch/hr. Timber FL: 4-6 feet (Head Fire) Brush ROS: 1-3 ch/hr. Brush FL: 2-4 feet (Head Fire)

#### SPECIFIC

### SPECIFIC FIRE BEHAVIOR:

**Branch I (Div. A, D, K):** Surface fire spread and occasional torching when ladder fuels are present can be anticipated. In divisions A and D heavy fuels along the line within the burnout operation will continue to consume and have potential to spot over the line.

**Branch V (Salmon, M, N, O, P):** Heavy fuels continue to consume along with interior pockets of unburned fuels. Fire behavior will be limited to creeping and smoldering. Increased spotting potential from firing operations due to predicted NW winds (5-7 mph).

**Branch VII (Div. R, U, W, Y):** As the fire moves laterally to the South East in Red Cap drainage there is potential for slope alignment and upslope runs. Rapid rates of spread with torching and spotting will occur as the fire moves up the steep slopes towards Packsaddle ridge.

**Night Shift (All Branches):** Fire activity will moderate through the night with creeping and smoldering expected. More active burning will take place within the thermal belt between 4500-5500 ft. Your best opportunity to conduct burning operations will be approx.0200-0300 with RHs between 25-30%.

New IA: Expect backing and upslope runs.

#### **AIR OPERATIONS**

Air operations will be limited until the low and mid-level inversion will lift at approx.1100-1300

#### SAFETY

Be mindful of your position on the fire line. Watch out for wind and slope alignment.

- Discuss the effects of fatigue and how to mitigate the effects of fatigue.
- While in the fire zone, wear your hardhat when you leave the vehicle.
- Have a purpose in what you do.







#### Red Salmon Complex COVID-19 Mitigations

It is the expectation that all incident personnel will follow the CDC and Agency guidance related to COVID-19.



- <u>Maintain physical distance of 6'+.</u> There is currently no vaccine to prevent the novel coronavirus (COVID-19).
- The best way to prevent illness is to avoid being exposed to this virus.
- The virus is thought to spread mainly from person-to-person.
  - o Between people who are in close contact with one another (within about 6 feet).
  - o Through respiratory droplets produced from an infected person.



- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing.
- If soap and water are not readily available, use a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol. Cover all surfaces of your hands and rub them together until they feel dry.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.



• Wear a face covering. Outside of fireline activity, it is expected that all incident personnel will wear a face covering when social distancing is not possible with those outside your "module as one". Face coverings are to be worn, in the appropriate manner, within the ICP, Base, and Spike Camps.

To protect the local communities along Highway 96, under no circumstances will you make any stops. Be prepared to travel non-stop in the areas from Willow Creek to Happy Camp. Expect to see hard closures.

• Conduct personnel health screenings daily and report illnesses to supervisor. COVID-19 symptoms include cough, shortness of breath, trouble breathing or any two of fever, chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle or body aches, headache, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, or diarrhea.

#### FIRE REPLACEMENT PROCEDURES

#### START THIS PROCESS AT LEAST 48 HOURS PRIOR TO DEMOB

#### Submit requests for all incident replacements on a 213, General Message:

- Separate cache from non-cache items on separate 213's!
- Include explanation for lost or damaged items.
- Include DIVS signature on the 213 to verify the item(s) has/have been lost or damaged and support the circumstances surrounding it.
- For stolen items, contact your supervisor and Security Manager as soon as practical.

#### **FOR CACHE ITEMS**

#### Requesting Resource is **NOT Being Demobed** and Requested Items **ARE Available** in Supply:

R&D shall fill request and note on the 213.

#### Requesting Resource is **NOT** Being Demobed and Requested Items are **NOT** Available in Supply.

• The Supply Unit will place an order for the requested items through the regular cache order process on the incident. The order will be shipped to the incident and replacement will take place at the Supply Unit and noted on the 213.

#### Requesting Resource IS Being Demobed and Requested CACHE Items are NOT in Stock in Supply:

- Along with the 213, complete an OF-315, Incident Replacement Requisition for cache items only and take to SPUL for review and approval. Include the requesting resources' email on the form so the Resource Order can be emailed to the Requesting Resource.
- The SPUL will issue S#'s pending receipt and verification of proper documentation for cache items.

#### NON-CACHE Items - This is the Important Part!!!

#### Non-Cache items include any item not available through the National Cache System.

Lost, damage, or destroyed government non-cache property shall be reported to the appropriate DIVS or higher-level overhead within 24 hours of occurrence. The requesting resource shall complete an ICS-213 and OF-289, Property Loss and Damage Report – Fire Suppression, available at Orleans Base Camp Supply Unit. Include the following:

- All witnesses shall document the facts and circumstances of the loss or damage on the OF-289. Explanations shall be detailed and indicate how the incident caused the damage.
- The requesting resource will email the completed ICS-213 and OF-289 to the Comp/Claims Unit Leader at scott\_parsons@firenet.gov. The COMP will make a determination based upon the documentation presented.
- Approval for replacement is the responsibility of the incident agency and may be delegated to the Incident Management Team for IC and FSC.
- If the replacement request is approved, the replacement cost will be limited to cache equivalent value. The
  requesting resource will complete OF-315 for the Supply Unit.
- Items that do not have a like-item in the cache will be reviewed and approved at the discretion of the FSC or Incident Business Advisor, as delegated by the Agency Administrator.

#### **CONDUCT AND BEHAVIOR**

This team is committed to "ZERO TOLERANCE" of careless, illegal, inappropriate and unsafe actions.

Alcohol and/or illegal drugs are NOT allowed within the incident environment or while actively assigned to the incident. Local Law Enforcement Officials will be called to deal with any suspected illegal activities. Each employee has the responsibility to be ready, willing, and able to perform the duties for which they are qualified.

#### Sexual Harassment

Inappropriate actions or comments will not be tolerated. Everyone is expected to act in a professional manner. It is your responsibility to stop inappropriate actions or comments immediately upon becoming aware of such. Sexual Harassment must be reported to the Human Resource Specialist or Incident Commander. When outside of your designated sleeping area, you are required to wear at least a shirt, appropriate shorts, and shoes or sandals. If you need clarification of these expectations contact the Human Resource Specialist or IC. What we PERMIT we PROMOTE!!!!

#### **SAFETY**

The commitment to and accountability for safety is a joint responsibility of firefighters, managers and administrators. Individuals must personally be committed and responsible for their own performance and accountability. Everyone assigned to this incident can expect an assignment that follows all safety rules & regulations. Every person is expected to perform his or her duties in compliance with all known safety practices at all times. Anything less is unacceptable.

#### **EMPHASIS AREAS**

#### Training

All trainees and trainers are expected to follow the procedures outlined in the California Interagency Incident Management Team 4 Training Expectations – See back page.

#### **Evaluations**

All supervisory personnel assigned will complete an ICS 225 Incident Personnel Performance Rating form for their assigned resources according to agency policy or contractual agreement.

#### Injuries/Claims

Ensure all injuries and potential claims are reported to the Comp/Claims Unit for completion of appropriate paperwork. Contract claims will be reported to the Procurement Unit Leader.

#### Work Rest Cycles

The 2: 1 work/rest ratio is mandatory. For every two hours on shift you will be required to rest for one hour. Every effort shall be used to limit work hours to a maximum of 16. If circumstances require you to exceed 16 hours, this needs to be coordinated in advance with your supervisor and the Justification/Mitigation form completed to support the excessive hours prior to submitting for approval by the IC. It is your responsibility to comply with this direction and provide the appropriate documentation to your Supervisor and Finance.

#### **Position Qualifications**

Personnel shall only be assigned to positions for which they are qualified. Proof of qualifications shall be approved prior to being assigned to any fire line position. Non-fireline positions may be filled based on the word of the employee pending home unit confirmation, which must be requested immediately. Contract dozer operators, tactical water tender operators and contract fallers must provide proof that they have received the annual fire refresher training.

#### Engagement/Disengagement

The 10 Standard Orders & 18 Watchout Situations will be followed at all times and mitigated as needed. Staying aware of your situation is critical. This includes Geographic Area and incident briefings. Follow the Risk Management Process outlined in the Incident Response Pocket Guide.

#### **Debriefing**

All Branch Directors/Division/Group Supervisors will report to their Supervisor and Situation Unit at the end of the operational period for debriefing with emphasis on the accomplishment of objectives. All unit logs (ICS 214) will be turned in after the debriefing to Documentation reflecting accomplishment and/or special incidents that occurred during the operational period.

#### **Crew Time Reports/Shift Tickets**

It is your responsibility to ensure all time is properly accounted for and recorded each shift. The records are to be <u>reviewed and signed</u> by the next level supervisor. A finance "Rules of Engagement" document will be provided in the IAP explaining further requirements.

#### Social Media

It is your responsibility to know and understand guidelines for firefighter photography, video and social media use. California Interagency Incident Management Team 4 goal is simple: to participate online in a respectful, relevant way that protects our incident's professional reputation, does not confuse the public about the incident and follows the letter and spirit of the law. Be mindful that social media postings can be viewed as unprofessional, damage careers and lead to disciplinary actions. For further information, contact the Public Information Officer.

#### TRAINING EXPECTATIONS

- 1. Upon arrival at the incident and after check-in, the trainee will bring the following documents to the initial meeting with the training specialist:
  - a. A properly initiated Position Task Book.
  - b. Your Request Number and your Agency (3) letter identifier.
  - c. Your agencies Fire Chief or Training Officers name, address, and phone number to insure that a copy of the training documents will be mailed back to your home unit.
  - d. Your current Incident Qualification Card (red card) that identifies you as a Trainee in the position you are seeking to be trained.
- 2. Have you identified or has a Trainer been assigned to you and if so, have the Trainer present when you meet with the training specialist.
- 3. At closeout and prior to entering the demobilization process, you should complete, sign, and review with the trainer the Final exit interview form. Once the form is complete, bring the following documents to the Training Specialist for closeout;
  - a. Position Taskbook (Evaluation Record dated and signed by the Trainer).
  - b. Completed ICS 225 (Personal Evaluation Record) dated and signed by both the trainee and trainer.
  - c. Completed Final Exit Interview Form dated and signed by both the trainer and the trainer.

#### **Trainer Expectations**

- 1. Arrive with the Trainee at the initial meeting with the Training Specialist.
- 2. Be ready to provide your Contact information and your Incident Request number.
- 3. Have a Current Incident Qualifications Card (Red Card) in a position of equal or greater qualifications that the Trainee is trying to achieve.
- 4. Be willing to educate, support, and provide professional and consistent feed back to the trainee during the assignment.
- 5. Throughout the incident the trainer shall continue to monitor and review with the trainee their tasks and goals within the taskbook.
- 6. The trainer, where appropriate is expected to sign off task's that are achieved by the trainee and to complete and sign the following documents.
  - a. ICS 225 (Personal Evaluation Form)
  - b. Evaluation Record at the back of the taskbook.
- 7. The trainer shall portray a positive and professional attitude that lets the trainee know that it is desirable to ask for direction and feedback.
- 8. When accepting the role as a trainer, you are expected to act in a professional manner that represents the California Interagency Incident Management Team 4 and your home agency.
