




WEATHER DISCUSSION: Another smoky start with a strong inversion and light winds through midday. However things are looking more promising that drier westerly winds will develop by afternoon and allow the inversion to mix out...at least on the west side of the fire. Best estimate for this occurring is between 2 and 4 pm this afternoon. No big changes in temperature or humidity but the overall trend looks slightly warmer and drier. For the first time in a while thunderstorms remain out of the forecast. Winds will become light and northerly overnight with good humidity recovery lower drainages and moderate recovery higher slopes.

WEATHER FORECAST Saturday:

WEATHER: Heavy smoke through midday...then slowly lifting by 1400 hours.

HIGH TEMPERATURES: Upper 70s 5000 feet and heavy smoke areas. 82-88 in Branch 2.

HUMIDITY: 19-29% areas that are smoke free...28-38% smoke and shaded areas.

20 FT WINDS:

RIDGETOP - Light South through 1100...then Westerly 5-10 mph gusts 12 mph by afternoon.

SLOPE/VALLEY - Light most of the day under the inversion then upslope 2-5 mph gusts 8 mph.

HAINES INDEX: 4 during the afternoon

STABILITY/INVERSION: Moderate to strong inversion mixing by 1400 hours.

WEATHER FORECAST For Saturday Night:

WEATHER: Smoke settling over the fire.

TEMPERATURES: 58-63.

HUMIDITY: Moderate to good recovery. 80% lower slopes and 50-60% upper slopes.

20 FT WINDS:

RIDGETOP - West 3-6 mph becoming North 2-5 mph overnight.

SLOPE/VALLEY - Downcanyon 1-3 mph.

EXTENDED FORECAST: No big changes for Sunday with seasonable weather over the fire area. By Monday and Tuesday an unseasonably strong low will approach from the West. This may produce some gusty southwesterly ridge winds to 25 mph with continued warm and dry weather through Tuesday...followed by a noted cooling trend.

FIRE BEHAVIOR FORECAST

GENERAL FIRE BEHAVIOR:

Expect smoky conditions early then possible clearing by 1500. With skies clear the fire will become more active. Group tree torching will occur with the potential for short crown runs on aligned slopes and drainages. The fires remain fuels & topography driven. The primary fire spread is from heavier fuels burning log to log and rolling material. Falling snags will challenge containment lines and will increase the potential for fire spread over barriers that would normally hold the fire. Rates of spread will be from 1 to 8 chains per hour with flame lengths 1-7 feet in the timber.

Primary spotting will be from rolling material. Fire backing into the narrow drainages has the potential to hook and make intense uphill runs.

Expect the fires to remain active until 0200hrs.

Specific:

Branch I: The fire will remain as surface fire burning in the heavier fuels. Spotting will be from rollout. Fire progression will continue to the Northeast. Expect mainly backing fire. Short intense runs probable in aligned drainages. Roll out and falling snags will challenge established line.

Winds will be favorable for any burnout operations parallel to the 7N26 road.

Branch II: Expect mainly backing and flanking fire in heavy fuels and surface litter. Single and group tree torching will continue. Spot fires will continue from rolling material. Minimal fire activity expected where the line construction is occurring above Five Waters.

Fire to the SE around Big Mt. will continue to spread laterally along the drainages.

The fire is not expected to impact crews working on structure prep along the 299 corridor or in Denny.

Air Operations: There is a potential that skies will clear enough for air ops around 1600.

Steep country means rolling material, watch for spot fires below you!


Know what's going on around you:

- Your visibility will diminish due to smoke dust and night fall, so recognition time is reduced and reaction time is increased which increases your stopping distance.
- Maintain your safety cushion by reducing your speed.
- The fire is experiencing large burned out trees and snags falling after the fire moves through an area. Look for indicators of weak trees.
- Eliminate the hazard by falling the hazard tree or flag the area with hazard flagging and use a different route.
- We are getting more firefighters in every day. Continue to brief the firefighters of the current hazards and make sure they know what's going on around them.
- Remember your safety and your crew safety is Priority.


