WEATHER DISCUSSION:

... Strong Inversion Once Again...

High pressure will persist over the region keeping the strong inversion over the South Complex. Visibility may be very poor at times depending in part on the influence from smoke produced from nearby fires. It is possible for a few brief breaks in the inversion at higher elevations increasing instability. Otherwise expect continued hot and dry conditions. Winds will be light and terrain driven.

Weather Forecast for Tuesday:

Weather: Smoke and haze. Smoke dense at times.

High Temperature... 89-95° **Min RH.....** 19-25%

20-FOOT WINDS:

Ridgetop..... Light Northeast in the morning becoming north-northwest 3-6 mph in the afternoon.

Slope...... Upslope 1-4 mph.

Valley..... Upvalley 3-6 mph after 1400.

Weather Forecast for Tuesday Night:

Weather: Smoke and haze. Low Temperature... 51°-56°

Max RH (Ridges)...... Poor Recovery: 23-33% above 3000 feet

Max RH (Valleys)..... 58-68%

20-FOOT WINDS:

Ridgetop...... Northeast 2-5 mph.

Slope/Valley..... Downvalley/Down drainage 3-7 mph until 2100, especially along the Trinity River.

Weather Forecast for Wednesday:

Weather: Smoke and haze, possibly dense at times.

High Temperature... 90-95. **Min RH.....** 17-24%

20-FOOT WINDS:

Ridgetop..... Southwest 2-5 mph.

Slope/Valley..... Upslope 2-4 mph after noon. Upvalley 4-8 mph after 1500.

EXTENDED OUTLOOK for Thursday and Friday:

A subtle change is possible Thursday and Friday as high pressure slightly relaxes its grip over Northern California. This will bring a little relief for inversions earlier in the afternoon hours. In addition relative humidities will rise 5-10% with a slight increase in west/northwest winds.

WEATHER SUMMARY:

Discussion: Hot and dry conditions will continue over the fire area. The inversion will be persistent and likely to impact the fire area most of the day. Winds will be light and terrain driven.

Weather: Smoke and haze. Dense smoke at times.

Max Temp: 89-95° Min RH: 19 - 25%

Winds (20 foot): Ridgetop: Light NE winds in the morning, becoming N-NW 3-6 mph in the afternoon.

Slope/Valley: Upslope 1-4 mph, upvalley 3-6 mph after 1400

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL

Expect the fire behavior to become more active in the afternoon. Fire spread will be primarily upslope/up valley with some flanking. Expect occasional upslope runs in the afternoon. Backing fire and roll-out will contribute to spread. Moderate fire behavior should be anticipated if the inversion lifts. Hayfork ERC for August 17 was 56.

SPECIFIC FIRE BEHAVIOR

Brush/previous burn areas: potential worst-case surface fire spread will be 10-20 chains/hour with flame length 4-6 feet. Backing fire rate of spread to 4 chains/hour. Potential for sustained crown runs in brush and live oak. Spotting could increase total spread distance significantly. Maximum spotting distance up to ¼ mile. Probability of ignition at the peak of the burning period will be 70-80%.

Timber fuel types: potential worst-case surface fire spread will be 4-6 chains/hour with flame length 3 to 5 feet. Backing fire to 2 chains/hour. Individual and group-tree torching and short-duration crown runs should be expected. Spotting distance to ¼ mile. Probability of ignition will be 70-80%.

Areas of Concern:

- Divisions L, M: fire will keep actively backing on the east side of South Fork Trinity River with occasional torching and short runs. Spotting over the river is the primary concern for these Divisions.
- Divisions Y, Z: fire movement upslope out of Corral Creek toward indirect lines will continue with occasional torching, upslope runs, and spotting until after dark. Fire has already become established at the top of Olsen Creek drainage and could move North toward Division Z or South toward the 3N05 Road if backing continues. Most fire activity late evening will become backing/flanking fire with occasional torching.

AIR OPERATIONS

Air operations may be limited due to poor visibility caused by smoke.

SAFETY

Smoky conditions during the day, especially early morning, may result in hazardous conditions: spots may not be readily observed until a considerable size due to reduced visibility; vehicle operation can be hazardous during the day, especially early morning; other hazards such as snags may not be readily visible.


