Today's discussion is from the Fire Line Safety Category.

TRANSFER OF COMMAND

Risks to fireline personnel increase significantly during transfer of command periods regardless of the size or complexity of the incident. There is a high potential for fatalities, serious injuries, or incidents with potential during transfer of command periods (some have occurred in the past). Be proactive in mitigating the risks by proper implementation of LCES—Lookout, Communications, Escape Routes, and Safety Zones.

- Factors for increased risks to fireline personnel during transition periods include:
 - · No, or poor, briefing of incoming personnel
 - Lack of fire weather and behavior information, both forecast and observed
 - Communications; face-to-face briefings may not be possible and radio frequencies may be overextended and/or changing due to the increased demands on the system.
 - Initial attack resources may not have checked-in and the Incident Commander may not be aware of the number, type and location of all resources.
 - Location of safety zones and escape routes may not be known and communicated to all resources.
- Mitigation actions to take:
 - · Lookouts: Post and maintain your own lookouts.
 - Communications: Maintain existing communications with your own and adjacent resources, as well as your original supervisor, while you are developing communications with incoming adjacent resources and your new supervisor.
 - Escape routes and safety zones: Identify escape routes and assure incoming resources are aware of their locations; be aware that your original escape routes and safety zones may no longer be accessible due to changing fire behavior or your increased distance from them.

Management Objectives

Firefighter Safety:

Use the risk analysis process to manage risk and maintain safety of firefighters. Weigh firefighter exposure with the probability of success when implementing suppression actions.

Provide for the safety of the public through a risk assessment process and implementation of actions such as:

- Protect homes, valuable structures and infrastructure from damage or loss.
- Evacuation of Hyampom and surrounding areas where a threat of the fire to their well-being exists.
- Road and area closures.
- Smoke issues Consider setting up air quality monitors in the town of Hyampom to monitor smoke impacts

Pilot Ridge / South Fork Mountain Archaeological Resources:

- Minimize impacts to cultural resources.
- Assign Line Qualified Archaeologists to Divisions where dozers are working/planned.

South Fork Trinity River:

This is 1 of only 2 rivers with a Spring Run of the listed anadromous species Chinook and is the largest undamned river in the area. Minimize impacts to water quality to the best extent possible.

Public Information:

Provide timely, accurate and appropriate information to the public, partners, cooperators and internal organization. Mitigations and intent will be clear and communicated to the affected public and cooperators and assisting agencies.

Minimize the spread of invasive weeds such as spotted knapweed, diffuse knapweed, and yellow starthistle. Knapweed occurrences are not yet widespread on Six Rivers and the South Fork/Pilot Creek (east) is one of the very few areas with occurrences. Occurrence of these within the fire perimeter:

- 2N17 spotted knapweed (CEMA4), thousands of plants, extends down road.
- 2N18 diffuse knapweed (CEDI), yellow starthistle (CESO3), spotted knapweed (Route 1); various occurrences.

Per Invasive Plant Best Management Practices, when possible:

- Equipment cleaning before coming onto the fire.
- Avoid use of 2N17 and 2N18.
- If avoidance is not an option and equipment is slated to work elsewhere in the area, see Forest staff about equipment cleaning.

Conduct firing operations to minimize high severity fire and the unwanted effects to vegetation and soil.

Control Objectives

For Chance and Johnson Keep Fire:

- East of the Mad River to Board Camp Mountain to Cow Creek
- North of the Mad River and Sulphur Glade Ridge
- West of the South Fork of the Trinity River
- South of Grouse Creek

For Buck Keep Fire:

- East of Swayback Ridge
- North of Shanty Creek
- South and West of the Van Dusen River

Managing Transition

Change occurs at every moment of every day. Transitions between work shifts, personnel, line assignments, fuels, weather, topography, and other variables are prime opportunities for accidents to occur. Recognizing change and managing it appropriately is every fire fighters responsibility. Knowing and anticipating change is critical to your Safety.

- Communication Be clear and concise. Understand the communication plan. Make sure communications are established. No surprises. Be sure everyone understands the mission. Brief for change.
- Driving Pay close attention to curves, narrow roads, dust, smoke and daylight and dark and sudden changes. Drive defensively. Slow down and get there and back safely. Clean windshields. Lights on. Watch for signs. Obey speed limits.
 - Be advised, Highway 36 road closure has been lifted as of 0800, 8/15/15.
- 3. **Transition** Be sure to know command structure. Know the strategy/tactic and your area of responsibility. Be aware there is a transition and adjustments will be made.

Communication is the best tool to begin understanding and addressing change appropriately. Include all personnel and means necessary to fully identify and communicate change. What do we need right now? We all need to be mindful of hazards and how to mitigate them and reduce our risk – now.

WEATHER DISCUSSION: The weather is getting hotter and drier

A change in the weather pattern is going to allow hot conditions to develop each day. Today the hottest weather will set up over the Central Valley which will pull winds the marine layer inland by late afternoon. This will cause humidity minimums to be reached around 1500 before they begin to increase. Winds will be slope and valley driven but watch for the hotter temperatures causing slope wind gusts to 15 mph with ridgetop winds northeasterly until late afternoon. Winds may become erratic 1500-1700 as the marine layer begins to move through. Expect a much lower recovery Saturday night with hot and dry conditions all day Sunday.

WEATHER SUMMARY:

Gradual warming and drying trend will occur over the next few days. Temps: 83-87° valleys, 77-81 ridgetops RH: = around 25-30% Valleys, 20-25% ridgetops. Expect up slope up valley winds 5-10 mph, and ridge top winds Northeast 7-12 becoming west 3-5 late afternoon. *Humidity's will bottom out around 1500*

GENERAL:

The fire is burning timber fuels with some brush and grass. Manzanita, Mixed Pine, Cedar and Douglas Fir are present throughout the fire area. Persistent burning due to low fuel moistures will increase the potential snag hazards across the fire area. Live Fuel Moisture = Timber 150% Shrubs 80%. Mortality in the timber overstory and drought stressed fuels will increase the potential for single to group tree torching and short sustained crown runs where wind fuels and slope align.

The fire to date has been primarily topography driven. The predominant factor of fire spread has been consistently surface fire spread, backing and flanking fire with the fire transitioning to head fire spread where fuels and slope align. Rollout has been a significant factor in fire progression. Low dead fuel moisture are the primary driver behind continuous fuel consumption. Past significant runs were with slope and wind alignment. Expect fire activity to increase around 1100 hours for today and taper off in the late afternoon as RH's will begin to climb.

Rates of spread: head fire = 3-8ch/hr with backing 1-3 ch/hr.

With strong winds ROS of 25-40 ch/hr with head fire with crown involvement.

Spotting $\frac{1}{4} - \frac{1}{2}$ - mile...PIG = 80% day....10%...Night

DFM = $10 \text{ hr} = 5\% \dots 100 \text{hr} 7\%$ and 1000 hr = 10%

Indicators for increased fire behavior includes:

20 foot windspeed > 6 MPH, RH < 19%, Temps > 90, 1000hr < 14

SPECIFIC: All Divisions:

- Increased surface temperature of fuels will allow the fire to be more aggressive today...
- Surface fire spread with backing and flanking fire is within the threshold of control to go direct.
- Expect single to group tree where wind, slope and fuels align.
- .There is a high potential for Head Fire Runs todayas the fire continues to back into the Pilot Creek drainage in Divisions D,C, and A
- Spotting may develop downwind of any significant column development.






