**WEATHER DISCUSSION:** Very little change in the weather pattern is expected today as a weak trough begins to develop along the west coast. Today should see little change in temperature compared to Saturday. Humidity will likely start out a little higher in the morning hours...ending up a little drier by the late afternoon. Light pressure gradients will mean winds will remain locally terrain generated. Wind transitions will continue to occur late morning and early evening. Generally stable conditions will continue. A very gradual cooling trend is expected Monday through the middle of this week as a trough of low pressure continues to dig slowly along the west coast. No thunderstorm development or significant wind events are anticipated through the coming week.

## WEATHER FORECAST:

**WEATHER:** Sunny skies except smoky conditions through the morning hours.

**TEMPERATURES:** Max temps 87-93

**HUMIDITY:** Minimum RH 18-25%.

### 20 FT WINDS:

**RIDGETOP -** Turning from southeast 1-5 mph gusts to 8 mph becoming southwest to west 2-4 gusts to 10 mph after about 1100.

**SLOPE/VALLEY -** Downcanyon 0-4 gusts to 7 mph becoming upcanyon 2-5 gusts to 10 mph after about 1000.

**STABILITY/INVERSION:** Inversions clearing by around 1000. Remaining generally stable through the day.

**OUTLOOK FOR Sunday night day shift:** Fair skies except smoky conditions developing by late evening. Minimum temperatures 61 to 67. Maximum humidity recovery 50-65% with highest RH values after sunrise. Ridge winds becoming southeast 1-5 gusts to 8 mph after about 2100. Slope winds becoming downslope to downcanyon 1-4 gusts to 7 mph after about 2100.

**OUTLOOK FOR MONDAY:** Sunny skies. Max temps 85-92. Minimum RH 19-26. Slope winds downcanyon 1-4 gusts to 7 mph becoming upcanyon 2-5 gusts to 10 mph after late morning. Ridge winds southeast 1-5 gusts to 8 mph becoming southwest 2-4 gusts to 10 mph by afternoon.

**Discussion:** Very little change in the weather pattern is expected today as a weak trough begins to develop along the west coast. Winds will remain light and terrain driven.

**Weather:** Sunny skies except smoky conditions through morning hours. **Temp:** 87-93° **RH:** 18-25%  
**Winds (eye level):** upslope/upcanyon 2 mph gusts to 4 after 1000; SW to W 2 mph gusts to 5 on ridge tops after 1100  
**10 hr fuels:** 5% **1000 hr fuels:** 10%  
**Live Fuel Moisture:** 100% lower elevations and 127% higher elevations (above 3,500 ft)

## FIRE BEHAVIOR

### GENERAL

Expect the fire to be active today with backing, flanking, and short upslope runs through brush and timber. Occasional short duration crown runs and single/group-tree torching will occur but sustained crown runs and long-range spotting is not anticipated.

**POI:** 80-90% **Spotting Potential:** less than 2/10 mile

**Local Fire Danger:** ENF Actual 7/02 ERC = 75 BI = 57 ENF Predicted 7/03 ERC = 74 BI = 59

### SPECIFIC FIRE BEHAVIOR

**Branch I:** The fire will continue to flank both up and down canyon in the American River and Otter Creek drainages. The fire will also continue moving upslope out of Otter Creek toward Hornblende Ridge and move to the east toward Volcanoville. There is still a potential for the fire to cross the American River between Jesse Canyon and New Orleans Gulch and move upslope to the north in Branch II.

**Branch II:** The fire is being held within control lines. The only problem area remaining is the north portion of Division A which drops down to the river. Worst case scenario would be if fire were to cross the American River into the Branch.

## AIR OPERATIONS

Slightly more stable conditions with inversions lifting out around 1000. Anticipate reduced visibility in the drainages early in the morning. Sunrise: 05:43 Sunset: 22:33

## SAFETY

- Maintain good communications with adjoining Divisions and relay any change in fire behavior promptly.
- Burnout operations may result in fire running back towards control lines when rollout occurs on steeper slopes.
- Know your escape routes and time them based on current and expected fire behavior.

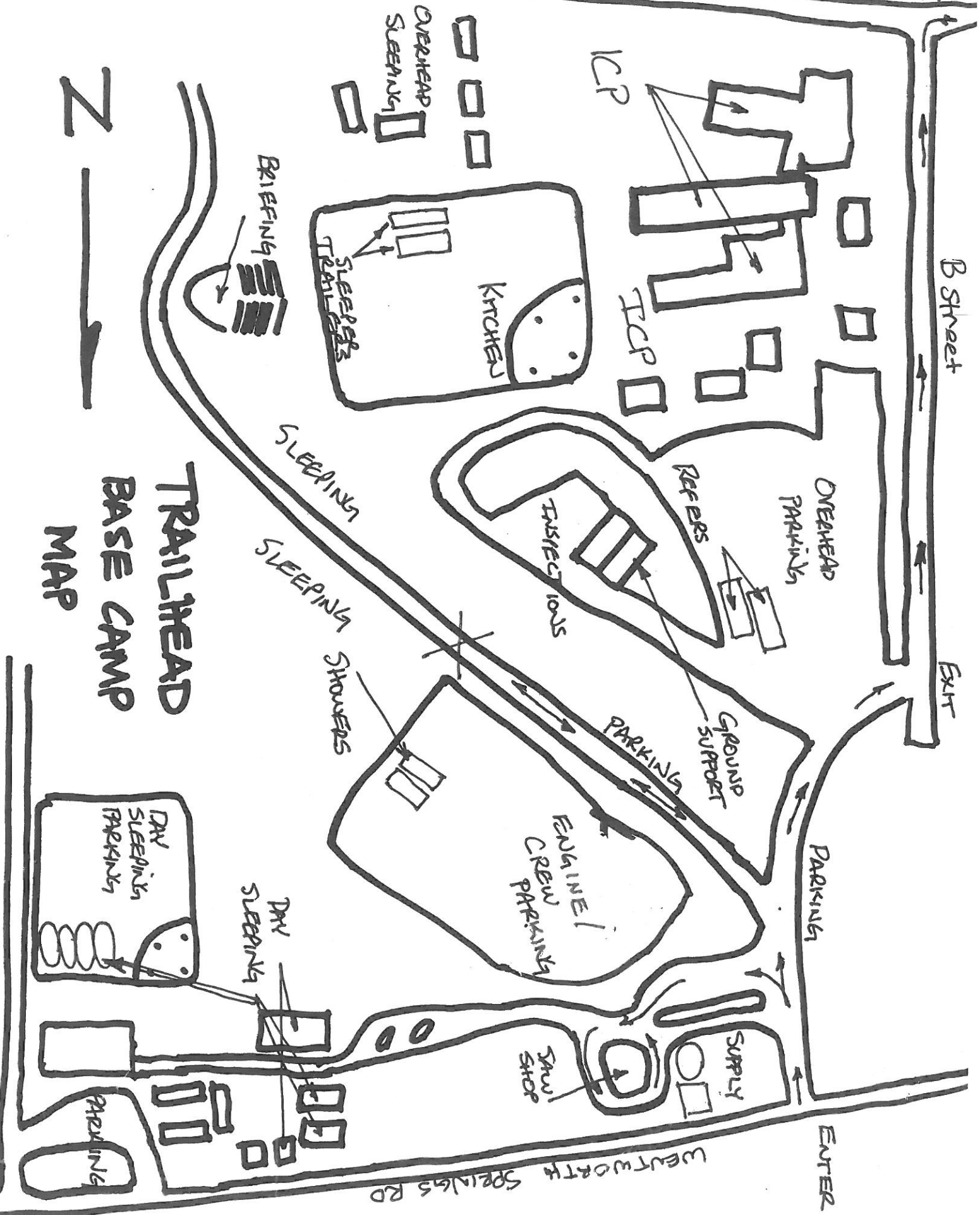
