WEATHER DISCUSSION: Very little change in the forecast expected today as a weak trough lingers over the state. RH values came up somewhat on Friday so expect only a very slight increase for today with high temperatures only dropping a degree or two. Morning humidity recovery will continue to improve slightly although the highest RH recovery has been occurring after sunrise. Afternoon conditions may be slightly more stable as well. Upper level winds remain light so winds on the slopes will be primarily terrain driven with a transition to upcanyon occurring around mid day. Very little change is expected on Sunday with a very gradual cooling expected during the first half of next week as a weak trough redevelops along the coast.

WEATHER FORECAST:

WEATHER: Sunny skies except smoky conditions through mid morning.

TEMPERATURES: Maximum temperatures 89 to 95. Warmest temperatures around mid afternoon.

HUMIDITY: Minimum humidity 18 to 25%. Lowest humidity in the mid afternoon.

20 FT WINDS:

RIDGETOP - East winds 1-4 mph with occasional gusts to 7 mph through about 1100 becoming southwest 2 to 5 mph with occasional gusts to 10 mph.

SLOPE/VALLEY - Downslope to downcanyon 1 to 4 gusts to 7 mph through about 1100 then upslope to upcanyon 2-6 mph with occasional gust to 10 mph. Strongest winds mid afternoon.

STABILITY/INVERSION: Slightly more Stable conditions today with inversions lifting out around 1100.

OUTLOOK FOR Saturday night shift: Fair skies except smoke filling in after about 2200. Minimum temperatures 62 to 68. Maximum humidity 45-65% by morning but generally 35-50% through the majority of the nighttime hours. Ridge winds becoming east 0-5 mph occasional gusts to 8 mph after about 2100. Slope winds becoming downslope to downcanyon 1-4 gusts to 8 mph after about 2100. Thermal belts around the 2000 foot elevation.

OUTLOOK FOR SUNDAY: Sunny skies. Max temps 87-93. Minimum RH 18-25%. Slope winds downcanyon 1-4 gusts to 8 mph becoming upcanyon 2-5 gusts to 10 mph after late morning with ridge winds becoming southwest 2-4 gusts to 10 mph by afternoon.

Discussion: Continued warm and dry weather will persist over the fire area with some minor cooling and improvement in RH today.

SPECIFIC FIRE BEHAVIOR

Branch I: The fire will continue to flank both up and down canyon in the American River and Otter Creek drainages. The fire will also continue moving upslope out of Otter Creek toward Hornblende Ridge and move to the east toward Volcanoville. There is still a potential for the fire to cross the American River and move rapidly upslope to the north in Branch II.

Branch II: The fire is being held within control lines. The only problem area remaining is the north portion of Division A which drops down to the river. Should fire cross the American River the Branch would become very active.

AIR OPERATIONS

Slightly more stable conditions with inversions lifting out around 1100. Anticipate reduced visibility in the drainages in the morning.


