Primary:

Using a full suppression strategy, minimize the size of the fires through the use of direct attack where safe to do so.

Alternate:

When not feasable or safe to go direct, use indirect attack to minimize fire size.

Contingency:

Use indirect attack tactics at major roads and natural barriers to suppress fire and minimize firefighter exposure to extreme fire behavior.

Emergency:

Withdraw fire personnel to safety zones or ICP and ensure accountability for all personnel

WEATHER DISCUSSION: Warm weather, with low afternoon relative humidity, will continue Saturday into the weekend. Isolated to scattered thunderstorms are expected over the weekend, with a chance of dry lightning in the afternoons and evenings. The possibility of dry lightning has prompted a Red Flag Warning for Saturday afternoon and evening, and also a Fire Weather Watch for Sunday afternoon and evening.

Thunderstorms imply the possibility of gusty and erratic winds

WEATHER FORECAST FOR TODAY:

WEATHER: Widespread smoke. Otherwise, partly cloudy with afternoon cumulus and a 30% chance of dry

HIGH TEMPERATURES: 84-88 in smoke shaded areas and 89-93 in full sunshine. 2 degrees lower

HUMIDITY: Afternoon minimum 12-16%...locally 20% under heavy smoke and clouds. 2% higher

20 FT WINDS:

Steele Fire - West 3-6 mph early, becoming West-Northwest 6-9 mph with gusts to 15 mph in the afternoon. Strongest winds likely in Branch II Div I/K.

Cove Fire - Light winds becoming Southwest 4-8 mph, with gusts to 10 mph in the afternoon

SLOPE/VALLEY - Light then afternoon upslope 2-5 mph gusts 7-9 mph. Lighter in shaded areas

HAINES INDEX: 4

LAL: 3

STABILITY/INVERSION: Strong morning inversion becoming unstable after 1300

SATURDAY NIGHT: Fire plumes and cumulus will dissipate by 2100. RH recovery will be poor through 11 pm then moderate recovery to 40-55% during the late night hours. Thermal belts in the timber around Adin Pass locally will have poorer RH recovery. Otherwise, partly cloudy with overnight lows of 59-65. West to Northwest winds 5-10 mph with gusts to 15 mph in the evening, becoming light and downslope after midnight.

SUNDAY THROUGH TUESDAY: Fire Weather Watch on Sunday for dry lightning. Thunderstorm chances increase Sunday and Monday, with greater chances of dry lightning Sunday. Seasonably warm through the period, with highs in the mid to upper 80s. Better overnight humidity recovery this weekend, around 60%. Westerly winds through the period, with gusts around 12 mph in the afternoons and evenings.


Situation Awareness

Observe the 30/30 rule: If you see lightning and hear the thunderclaps follow in less than 30 seconds, take the storm precautions identified below. Do not resume work in exposed areas until 30 minutes after storm activity has passed.

Hazard Control

- Take shelter in a vehicle or building if possible.
- If outdoors, find a low spot away from tall trees, wire fences, utility lines and other elevated conductive objects. Make sure the place you pick is not subject to flooding.
- If in the woods, move to an area with shorter trees.
- If only isolated trees are nearby, keep your distance twice the tree height.
- If in open country, crouch low, with feet together, minimizing contact with the ground. You can use a pack to sit on, but never lay on the ground.
- If you feel your skin tingle or your hair stand on end, immediately crouch low to the ground. Make yourself the smallest possible target and minimize your contact with the ground.
- Don't group together.
- Don't stay on ridge tops, in wide open areas, or near ledges or rock outcroppings.
- Don't operate landline telephones, machinery, or electric motors.
- Don't handle flammable materials in open containers or metal hand tools.

Lightning never strikes twice, but it only takes once!!





What is in Smoke? What can happen from short-term exposures?

Carbon Monoxide (CO) -

- Higher concentration in closer proximities to the combustion source
- Moderate exposure can lead to shortness of breath and headaches
- High levels of CO can lead to headaches, confusion, and a person collapsing on exertion
- You can recover from short-term exposures

Particulate Matter (PM₄) -

- Particles that are small and can be inhaled deep in the lungs
- Deposits into the respiratory tract
- Can carry other chemicals into the body
- irritation that can lead to shortness of breath, coughing and a sore throat Short-term exposure can suppress the immune system and cause airway distress and

Long-Term Health Impacts

Potential Heath Impacts (not studied in wildland firefighters) -

- Chronic respiratory diseases (COPD, Bronchitis, Emphysema)
- Heart disease
- Cancer

Wildland Firefighters -

Reducing Exposure to Smoke - Witigation Strategies

- Mop-up when conditions allow, mop-up only enough to secure line (50ft vs. 300 ft)
- Holding if possible rotate crews or individuals in and out of areas with higher smoke exposure
