- 3. Objective(s):**
- Provide for the safety of all responders by utilizing national Risk Management Standards and the implementation of appropriate mitigations.
  - Share critical information affecting public safety so timely decisions and actions can be implemented.
  - Reduce firefighter exposure by only engaging fire assignments with the highest probability of success.
  - Provide initial attack response within the area identified by the Delegation of Authority.
  - Engage cooperators and stakeholders to jointly provide for the defense of communities, infrastructure and economic interests.
  - Utilize local resource specialists to identify & protect sensitive sites and cultural resource values by minimizing impacts from suppression operations.
  - Maintain and enhance Community, County, State, National Forest and Stakeholder relationships through accurate and timely dissemination of information.
  - Identify, assess and implement suppression repair needs, where appropriate in coordination with the Resource Advisor following agency policy.
  - Manage incident costs effectively for the values at risk through regular and ongoing cost analysis.

**4. Operational Period Command Emphasis:**

**Primary:**  
Using a full suppression strategy, minimize the size of the fires through the use of direct attack where safe to do so.

**Alternate:**  
When not feasible or safe to go direct use indirect attack to minimize fire size.

**Contingency:**  
Use indirect attack tactics at major roads and natural barriers to suppress fire & minimize firefighter exposure to extreme fire behavior.

**Emergency:**  
Withdraw fire personnel to safety zones or ICP, ensure accountability for all personnel & reevaluate how to safely advance to suppress the fire.

- General Situational Awareness:**
- Red Flag Warning.
  - Heads up for possible dry lightning and increased fire behavior.
  - Monitor cumulus activity due to the chance of erratic winds and down drafts.
  - Keep your situational awareness current.



...*Fire Weather Watch Monday for Abundant Lightning...*

**WEATHER DISCUSSION:** Scattered thunderstorms are expected in afternoons and evenings Sunday and Monday. The possibility of abundant lightning has prompted a Red Flag Warning for Sunday afternoon and evening, and also a Fire Weather Watch for Monday. Seasonally warm weather, with low afternoon relative humidity, will continue Sunday through mid-week.

\*\*\*Thunderstorms imply the possibility of gusty and erratic winds\*\*\*

### WEATHER FORECAST FOR TODAY:

**WEATHER:** Partly cloudy in the morning, becoming mostly cloudy in the afternoon. 50% chance of thunderstorms in the afternoon and evening, with storms first developing around 1500.

**HIGH TEMPERATURES:** 85-90. 2 degrees lower.

**HUMIDITY:** Afternoon minimum 15-20%. 2% higher.

#### 20 FT WINDS:

**RIDGE TOPS** – Light, then West 4-8 mph, with gusts to 12 mph in the afternoon and evening.

**SLOPE/VALLEY** – Light, then upslope 2-5 mph with gusts to 8 mph in the afternoon and evening.

**HAINES INDEX:** 3

**LAL:** 4


**STABILITY/INVERSION:** Strong morning inversion becoming unstable after 1400.

**SUNDAY NIGHT:** Thunderstorms will dissipate by 2200, and then skies become partly cloudy overnight. RH recovery will be 40-60%, with lows 56-63. West winds 4-8 mph with gusts to 12 mph in the evening, becoming light and downslope after midnight.

**MONDAY THROUGH WEDNESDAY:** *Fire Weather Watch on Monday* for abundant lightning as scattered thunderstorms develop. Thunderstorm chances decrease Tuesday and Wednesday. Seasonably warm through the period, with highs in the mid to upper 80s and moderate overnight humidity recovery around 60%. Southwesterly winds through the period, with gusts around 12 mph in the afternoons and evenings.

**SAFETY INFORMATION:** Keep an ear to the radio for weather updates, and seek shelter from lightning if a storm approaches. If you feel the hair on your arms or head "stand up," there is a high probability of a strike in the vicinity. Crouch or sit on a pack with your legs together. Take shelter in vehicles if possible.

## OUTPUTS

### FIRE BEHAVIOR

**GENERAL:** Extremely dry fuels will be receptive to the forecasted lightning strikes that may occur today. Following an initial ignition, outflow winds could promote rapid rates of spread associated with the light fuels. Forecasted Probability of ignition (PIG) for today is **60%** Shaded and **90%** Unshaded making the fuels very receptive to any strikes.

### LOCAL THRESHOLDS - WATCH OUT

Combinations of any of these factors can greatly increase fire behavior:

Thresholds: **20' winds** over 5 mph    **RH** less than 20%    **Temp** over 90°    **ERC** over 64    **BI** over 51  
Forecasted: **20' winds**, 4-8mph    **RH** 15-20%    **Temp** 85-90°    **ERC** 70    **BI** 49

**Probability of Ignition: Today 60-90% away from any precipitation**

### SPECIFIC:

**North Zone & South Zone:** Expect any new starts or slop-overs to be wind driven fires accompanied by rapid rates of spread associated with lighter fuels. Heavier fuels have promoted spotting. Expect short range spotting distances due to light transport winds. All Divisions, Be mindful of erratic winds associated with passing thunderstorms.

### AIR OPERATIONS:

VFR conditions are expected throughout the operational period.

## THUNDERSTORM SAFETY

Observe the 30/30 rule: If you see lightning and hear the thunderclaps follow in less than 30 seconds, take the storm precautions identified on Page 21 of the IRPG. Do not resume work in exposed areas until 30 minutes after storm activity has passed.







## **Firefighter Fatigue/Driver Safety**

With continued physically demanding operational periods, expect and predict fatigue of all crew members working in and around your division. Take the following steps to limit and address fatigue and driver safety:

1. Follow work/rest guidelines.
2. Take breaks as needed.
3. Rotate qualified drivers/operators.
4. Supervisors assess the fatigue levels of your crews during operational periods.
5. Ask/tell if you are physically unable to complete a task or assignment.
6. Front seat passengers should remain awake and maintain situational awareness while driving.

## **Heat Related Illness**

**Heat Stroke-** A condition that occurs when the body becomes unable to control its temperature, and can cause death or permanent disability. Description of signs and symptoms include:

- Confusion, loss of coordination.
- Throbbing headaches.
- High body temperature.
- Seizures, coma.

**Heat Exhaustion-** The body's response to an excessive loss of water and salt, usually through sweating.

- Heavy sweating, extreme weakness or fatigue.
- Dizziness, nausea, vomiting, irritability.
- Fast, shallow breathing.
- Trouble concentrating, loss in coordination.

**Heat Cramps-** Affects workers who sweat a lot during strenuous activity. Sweating depletes the body's salt and moisture levels.

- Muscle cramps, pain, or spasms in the abdomen, arms or legs.

## **Personal Hygiene and Illness Prevention**

With shared utilities such as sleeping quarters, restrooms and the chow hall, the chance of spreading illness and infection is a concern. Take the following steps to limit your exposure to illness or infection:

- Use handwashing stations routinely.
- Stay hydrated and well nourished.
- Get your rest, use hand sanitizer.
- Avoid contact with social surfaces (handrails, doorknobs) without washing hands after.

**If Declaring an "Incident within the Incident"**

The closest DIVS will respond to manage the incident. They are responsible for giving an accurate size up, ensuring scene safety, setting priorities and initiating an appropriate response.  
 The closest Safety Officer and Line EMS will respond to the scene to assist the Branch Director or DIVS. Secure site and begin initial investigation when situation is stabilized.

## FIRE SUPPRESSION REPAIR PLAN

### **Guidelines for dozer lines, hand lines, helispots, spike camps, drop points, water sources and safety zones:**

*Note: Where there is more rock than soil on control lines with slopes 5% or greater, waterbars are not needed as long as the non burnable debris on the line will dissipate the water enough to prevent channeling.*

Stage 1) Soil and rocks will be put back on control lines and spread. Waterbarring will be completed where appropriate. No burnable material will be placed on the direct control lines.

Stage 2) In addition to stage 1 burnable material/debris will be placed on the lines and spread. Pull slash and downed trees over dozer line to reduce erosion and prevent unauthorized vehicular use.

Contingency line will be repaired as stage 2.

Obliterate any berms from the outside edge of existing fireline. Work material back onto the line. Do not sidecast berm material into or near stream channels.

Restore Forest roads to pre-fire suppression activities. Blade and grade travelway, remove berms, clean ditches and culvert inlets, chip roadside slash.

Repair fences damaged resulting from fire suppression activities.

Remove all improvised dams from drainages created for pumps and drafting. Area should be returned to pre fire suppression activities.

Water bars should be constructed at least 30 degrees perpendicular to the fireline. Make sure waterbars outlets are open.

### **Watercourses:**

All slash, soil, and debris deposited into watercourses resulting from fire suppression activities shall be removed and stabilized.

### **Concentrations of Green Timber**

Areas that have concentrations of fallen or pushed over trees (not juniper) will need to be addressed. Trees over 10" DBH should have the root wad removed at the base and the tree placed with others in an organized fashion. All of the butts of the trees even, stacked on top of each other so that there 4-6 trees in a bundle. If possible the bundles will be parallel to the road and not overlapping.

Trees less than 10" DBH and root wads should be handled as slash/debris and used for covering dozer line to prevent vehicular travel and reduce erosion.

**WORK REST CYCLE**

IT IS NATIONAL DIRECTION TO MEET 2 TO 1 WORK/REST RATIO (1 hour of sleep/rest for every 2 hours of work). Every effort shall be made to manage work hours so you don't exceed the maximum of 16 hrs. Work hours exceeding 16 hours shall be approved by your supervisor in advance, and a justification/mitigation form completed for review by Section Chief & approved by IC. It is each person's responsibility to comply with this direction to manage for fatigue and safety.

**OPERATIONAL SHIFTS**

Pay status for assigned overhead and crews on the fireline will not start prior to the posted briefing time and will terminate on arrival back in camp (except for debriefing—additional hours may be accrued by those required to attend debriefing). Supervisors will be allowed ½ hour prior to briefing and after return to camp to ready crew and equipment.

**DUTY STATUS**

Division/Group supervisors and Unit Leaders are responsible for establishing on and off duty status. The objective is a 2 to 1 work/rest ratio. Personnel will normally work, travel, and/or be placed on ORDERED standby 8 to 16 hours per day and be off duty 8 hours or more (breaks count towards 8 hrs). Off duty time will be in a non-pay status. Each federal employee is guaranteed **at least 8 hours** of pay status each 24-hour period (midnight to midnight) unless it is the first or last day of an assignment or stated otherwise in a contract or agreement.

**PERSONNEL/EQUIPMENT TIME REPORTING**

Personnel time will be reported to the Time Unit and daily once they are signed by the next level supervisor. OES resources will be monitored by OES Agency Rep (if assigned) for 2/1 Work Rest compliance. Situations entitling you to HAZARD PAY are to be noted in remarks (ie. HP=Uncontrolled Fireline, hovering hookups, low level flights, etc.)

Private Contracted Equipment time must be tracked on a Shift Ticket daily and hours on shift noted even if it is a daily rate. When swapping out operators you need to notify Finance as well as changing from single to double shift and vice versa.

Supervisor's - If you are responsible for daily tracking of equipment or personnel, please ensure you understand the agreement, and follow the rules provided in this document. Do not sign documents for resources you did not manage unless you have knowledge of their assignment hours.

**MEAL AND OTHER WORK BREAKS**

Compensable meal periods are the exception, not the rule (5 CFR 551.411 © and 29 CFR 785.19(a)). Until the fire is controlled, personnel on the fireline MAY BE compensated for meal periods if all of the following conditions are met: 1) The fire is not controlled and 2) The Operations Section Chief makes a decision that it is critical to the effort of controlling the fire that personnel remain at their post of duty and continue to work as they eat, and 3) The compensable meal break is approved by the supervisor at the next level and documented on CTR. For personnel in support positions, and fireline personnel after control of a fire, a meal period of at least 30 minutes must be ordered and taken for each work shift of eight hours or more. In those situations where personnel cannot be relieved from work and must remain at a post of duty, a meal period may be counted as time worked, which will be compensable. **If breaks are NOT able to be taken, CTR should have a statement in remarks explaining the situation.** Kitchen closes at 2200 so show dinner break unless you went off clock by 2130.
