**WEATHER DISCUSSION:** Temperatures will become more seasonal Friday and into the weekend, but still remain hot. Highs will reach the mid-90s by the afternoon, with RH dipping into the teens. West to northwest wind gusts of 20-30 mph will develop Friday afternoon, and then diminish late in the evening. Therefore, a Red Flag Warning is in effect for gusty winds and low RH Friday afternoon and evening. Transport winds will be westerly and increasing in speed aloft, so spotting distances may be slightly longer. An isolated thunderstorm is possible Friday afternoon, with greater chances for storms Saturday and Sunday. Storms Saturday could create dry lightning, so a Fire Weather Watch has been issued for Saturday afternoon and evening. Haines index is 5 for Friday and Saturday.

\*\*\*Thunderstorms imply the possibility of gusty and erratic winds\*\*\*

## **WEATHER FORECAST FOR TODAY:**

WEATHER: Widespread smoke. Otherwise, sunny with afternoon cumulus and a 15% chance of t-storms.

HIGH TEMPERATURES: 85-90 in smoke shaded areas. 91-95 in full sunshine. 3 degrees lower.

**HUMIDITY:** Afternoon minimum 11-15%...locally 19% under heavy smoke. 2% higher.

20 FT WINDS:

Steele Fire - North 3-6 mph early, becoming West to Northwest 8-13 mph with gusts 20-30 mph in the afternoon. Strongest winds likely in Branch II Div I/K.

Cove Fire - Light winds becoming Westerly 5-10 mph, with gusts to 20 mph in the afternoon.

SLOPE/VALLEY - Light then afternoon upslope 2-5 mph gusts 7-9 mph. Lighter in shaded areas.

**HAINES INDEX:** 5

LAL: 2

STABILITY/INVERSION: Strong morning inversion becoming unstable after 1 pm.

FRIDAY NIGHT: Fire plumes and cumulus will dissipate by 2000. RH recovery will be poor through 11 pm then some recovery to around 35-50% during the late night hours. Thermal belts in the timber around Adin Pass locally poorer RH recovery. Otherwise mostly clear with overnight lows 62-68. West to Northwest winds 5-10 mph with gusts to 15-25 mph in the evening, becoming light and downslope after midnight.

<u>SATURDAY THROUGH MONDAY:</u> Fire Weather Watch on Saturday for dry lightning. Thunderstorm chances increase Saturday and Sunday, with greater chances of dry lightning Saturday. Seasonably hot through the period, with highs in the low 90s. Better overnight humidity recovery this weekend, around 55%.

**SAFETY INFORMATION**: Don't get complacent with plume dominated fire behavior. Fall back to the basics and make sure someone has eyes on the fire column. Keep an ear to the radio for weather updates, and seek shelter from lightning if a storm approaches.

## **OUTPUTS**

## **FIRE BEHAVIOR**

GENERAL: Extremely dry fuels combined with gusty erratic winds from thunderstorms = Extreme fire behavior. The humidity recovery last night helped temper the fire spread overnight. The morning hours is the best time to go direct or gain ground on interior mop-up. This afternoon the firelines will be tested today with strong erratic, gusty winds carrying embers to highly receptive fuel beds. Interior islands will burn down completely and may launch embers a mile or more downwind. All areas of the Modoc July Complex have potential to experience extreme fire behavior including Plumedominated columns.

Rate of Spread Head fire 8-200 ch/h with flames 3-15 ft Backing fire <8 ch/h with flame lengths < 4 ft

Wind speeds of 20-30 mph in grass will produce rates of spread: 150-475 ch/h = about 2-6 mph with flames 10-22 ft. Wind speeds of 20-30 mph in timber will produce rates of spread: 30-100 ch/h = about ½ to 2 mph with flames 4-15 ft.

## SPECIFIC: Expect Extreme Fire Behavior All Day, All Areas, and Plan Accordingly.

North Zone and Steele Fire: Watch for sleeper heat in the juniper and sage brush. When they flare up they send embers across the fireline. The lava rock combined with grass, brush, & juniper fuel type can hold heat for days and with a little sunshine and wind, will launch embers causing the fire to get up and run again.

South Zone and Cove Fire: Continue with the aggressive mop-up in the morning because the holding lines will be tested later today with wind gusts of 20-30mph. Should the fire make it to Hwy 299, the Narrows has a high probability for fire spotting across due to the narrow opening of the canyon and steep slope. Branch II—Div I/K will experience the highest rates of fire spread listed above due to wind forecasts for your division.

Brush, Grass, Pinyon Fuels: During the heat of the day, expect rapid rates of spread (20-200 ch/h) and flame lengths 7-15 ft. High mortality in brush, needle draped brush, and grass growing right up under the brush will increase fire behavior. When juniper torches, it launches a bunch of embers as far as the wind will carry it. High winds, farther away the spots.

Mixed Conifer Timber: During the heat of the day, expect moderate to rapid rates of spread (7-60 ch/h) and flame lengths 2-10 ft. Single tree and group tree torching are likely even with low wind speeds, and especially where ladder fuels are abundant. In areas with heavy dead and down, expect complete consumption and weakening of trees and root structures.

AIR OPERATIONS: Strong morning inversion becoming unstable after 1 pm. Inversion may hinder visibility during morning hours. Hazy air all day.

## SAFETY

Be vigilant about the safety of you and your crew. Fall back to the basics and make sure someone has eyes on the fire column and nearby thunderstorms. Monitor the winds for long range spotting. Keep an ear to the radio for weather updates, and seek shelter from lightning if a storm approaches.

# **Communication Responsibilities**

All firefighters have five communication responsibilities:

- Brief others as needed
- Debrief your actions
- Communicate hazards to others
- Acknowledge messages
- · Ask if you don't know

#### **Extreme Fire Behavior**

Fire behavior for the past several operational periods have produced intense burning conditions. All crews should anticipate and plan their strategies and tactics based on current and expected behavior of the fire. Fire spotting has the potential to spot up to two miles in distance. Additionally, expect Red Flag warning conditions for the next 48 hours. Situational awareness needs to be constantly revaluated and plan for rapid rates of spread, erratic winds, lightning and increase in flame lengths.

#### **Hazard Tree Safety**

Hazard trees, both dead snags and live green trees, are one of the most common risks encountered on the fireline. All firefighters should frequently survey their work area for potential hazard trees.

#### Situation Awareness

#### **Environment:**

- · Current and forecasted winds
- Night operations
- Steep slopes
- · Diseased or bug-kill areas
- Number and height of hazard trees
- Anticipated burn-down time
- Potential for trees to domino

#### Hazard tree indicators:

- Trees burning for any period of time
- High risk tree species (rot and shallow roots)
- Numerous downed trees
- Dead, broken, or burning tops and limbs overhead
- Accumulation of downed limbs
- · Absence of needles, bark or limbs
- · Leaning or hung-up

# If air or ground ambulance is DELAYED:

Package and transport patient to rendezvous with ambulance. Re-route EMS helicopter to rendezvous point as appropriate.

# If Declaring an "Incident within the Incident"

The closest DIVS will respond to manage the incident. They are responsible for giving an accurate size up, ensuring scene safety, setting priorities and initiating an appropriate response.

The closest Safety Officer and Line EMS will respond to the scene to assist the Branch Director or DIVS. Secure site and begin initial investigation when situation is stabilized.

# STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURES—FINANCE SECTION 16 HOURS IS NOT A GUARANTEE – IT IS HOURS WORKED!!

#### WORK REST CYCLE

IT IS NATIONAL DIRECTION TO MEET 2 TO 1 WORK/REST RATIO (1 hour of sleep/rest for every 2 hours of work). Every effort shall be made to manage work hours so you don't exceed the maximum of 16 hrs. Work hours exceeding 16 hours shall be approved by your supervisor in advance, and a justification/mitigation form completed for review by Section Chief & approved by IC. It is each person's responsibility to comply with this direction to manage for fatigue and safety.

#### **OPERATIONAL SHIFTS**

Pay status for assigned overhead and crews on the fireline will not start prior to the posted briefing time and will terminate on arrival back in camp (except for debriefing—additional hours may be accrued by those required to attend debriefing). Supervisors will be allowed ½ hour prior to briefing and after return to camp to ready crew and equipment.

#### **DUTY STATUS**

Division/Group supervisors and Unit Leaders are responsible for establishing on and off duty status. The objective is a 2 to 1 work/rest ratio. Personnel will normally work, travel, <u>and/or</u> be placed on ORDERED standby 8 to 16 hours per day and be off duty 8 hours or more (breaks count towards 8 hrs). Off duty time will be in a non-pay status. Each federal employee is guaranteed at least 8 hours of pay status each 24-hour period (midnight to midnight) unless it is the first or last day of an assignment or stated otherwise in a contract or agreement.

### PERSONNEL/EQUIPMENT TIME REPORTING

<u>Personnel time</u> will be reported to the Time Unit and daily once they are signed by the next level supervisor. OES resources will be monitored by OES Agency Rep (if assigned) for 2/1 Work Rest compliance. Situations entitling you to HAZARD PAY are to be noted in remarks (ie. HP=Uncontrolled Fireline, hovering hookups, low level flights, etc.)

<u>Private Contracted Equipment time</u> must be tracked on a Shift Ticket daily and hours on shift noted even if it is a daily rate. When swapping out operators you need to notify Finance as well as changing from single to double shift and vice versa.

Supervisor's - If you are responsible for daily tracking of equipment or personnel, please ensure you understand the agreement, and follow the rules provided in this document. Do not sign documents for resources you did not manage unless you have knowledge of their assignment hours.

# MEAL AND OTHER WORK BREAKS

Compensable meal periods are the exception, not the rule (5 CFR 551.411 © and 29 CFR 785.19(a)). Until the fire is controlled, personnel on the fireline MAY BE compensated for meal periods if all of the following conditions are met: 1) The fire is not controlled and 2) The Operations Section Chief makes a decision that it is critical to the effort of controlling the fire that personnel remain at their post of duty and continue to work as they eat, and 3) The compensable meal break is approved by the supervisor at the next level and documented on CTR. For personnel in support positions, and fireline personnel after control of a fire, a meal period of at least 30 minutes must be ordered and taken for each work shift of eight hours or more. In those situations where personnel cannot be relieved from work and must remain at a post of duty, a meal period may be counted as time worked, which will be compensable. If breaks are NOT able to be taken, CTR should have a statement in remarks explaining the situation. Kitchen closes at 2200 so show dinner break unless you went off clock by 2130.





#### Smoke Exposure for Wildland Firefighters

Inhalation of smoke is a safety concern that can potentially impair your performance and cause short and long term health impacts.

#### **Current Research on Smoke Exposure**

The US Forest Service Missoula Technology Development Center is currently conducting a smoke exposure assessment study. Data is currently being collected to determine the levels of carbon monoxide and PM4 that wildland firefighters are being exposed to on prescribed and wildfires all over the US. This information will be used to better understand the health risks associated exposure to smoke on firelines.

#### What is in Smoke? What can happen from short-term exposures?

Carbon Monoxide (CO) -

- Higher concentration in closer proximities to the combustion source
- Moderate exposure can lead to shortness of breath and headaches
- High levels of CO can lead to headaches, confusion, and a person collapsing on exertion
- You can recover from short-term exposures

Particulate Matter (PM<sub>4</sub>) –

- Particles that are small and can be inhaled deep in the lungs
- Deposits into the respiratory tract
- Can carry other chemicals into the body
- Short-term exposure can suppress the immune system and cause airway distress and irritation that can lead to shortness of breath, coughing and a sore throat

#### **Long-Term Health Impacts**

Potential Heath Impacts (not studied in wildland firefighters) –

- Chronic respiratory diseases (COPD, Bronchitis, Emphysema)
- Heart disease
- Cancer

#### Wildland Firefighters –

 Research study found significant associations between the greater number of years worked as a wildland firefighter and heart arrhythmia, hypertension and having had knee surgery

#### Reducing Exposure to Smoke - Mitigation Strategies

- Mop-up when conditions allow, mop-up only enough to secure line (50ft vs. 300 ft)
- Holding if possible rotate crews or individuals in and out of areas with higher smoke exposure
