FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL

Cooler temperatures, higher relative humidity, scattered precipitation, and cloud cover has moderated fire behavior. Most spread is occurring in the timber fuels. Anticipate minimal spread in the grass/sage fuels due to increases in moisture.

SPECIFIC FIRE BEHAVIOR

Expect the fire behavior to be minimal most of the day. Fire spread will be primarily backing and flanking early with increases in upslope movement in the timber in the afternoon.

Timber fuel types: potential worst-case surface fire spread will be 2-5 chains/hour with flame length 2-4 feet. Burning jackpots of understory fuels will result in individual and group tree torching which will increase spread distances through lofting of embers and spotting. Spotting distance will be up to 1/10 of a mile, probability of ignition 40-50%. *During any outflow wind occurrence, expect the rate of spread to increase significantly.*

Grass/sage types: potential worst-case surface fire spread will be 5-10 chains/hour with flame length 1-3 feet. Spotting should not be a common occurrence in the grass due to increased fuel moisture content. Probability of ignition at the peak of the burning period will be 40-50%. *During any outflow wind occurrence, rate of spread could increase significantly.*

Air operations may be limited intermittently during the day due to thunderstorm activity.

- Although minimal fire behavior is anticipated for today's shift keep in mind that some areas of the fire may

 - The Trainer completing an Individual Performance Evaluation (ICS 225 or 226)
 - The Trainee will complete an Exit Interview form. Forms are available at the TNSP desk.
 - The evaluator should have all work completed in the position task book at the time the training assignment close-out including a recommendation as to the outcome of the assignment, ie; recommend certification, needs more assignments.
- 4. If you reach a point that as much work has been done in the position task book as possible, on this incident, you may perform the close-out process with the TNSP saving you time and a potential wait in line at time of DEMOB.
- 5. Pay close attention to TNSP IAP messages and briefing announcements concerning time lines and issues regarding the Incident Training Program.


