WEATHER DISCUSSION:

Cool temperatures and high humidity will persist over the region today with a little less wind. Periodic cloud cover will move through with an occasional light shower. Ridgetop winds will be lighter with lower elevations seeing upslope and upvalley flows. Another cold front will move into the area tonight and Wednesday bringing more frequent shower activity with a wetting rain possible. Thursday will remain cool and unsettled with drying and warming beginning on Friday and extending into the weekend.

TODAY: Partly cloudy with patches of low clouds in the morning. Occasional light rain showers.

TEMPERATURES: High temperatures from 60-65 highest elevations to 72-77 Trinity river canyon.

HUMIDITY: Starting off today with an excellent recovery 80-100%. Minimum RH 38% Trinity river canyon to 40-45% highest elevations.

20 FT WINDS:

RIDGETOPS - West northwest 8 to 12 mph with gusts to 15 mph. Gusts to 20 mph Weaver Bally lookout.

SLOPE/VALLEY - Upslope / Upvalley 3 to 6 mph except 10 to 15 mph west facing aspects and Trinity River canyon.

STABILITY/INVERSION: Weak inversions clearing around 1000 but limited smoke lift due to a stable atmosphere.

FORECAST FOR TUESDAY NIGHT SHIFT: Increasing clouds with periods of rain after midnight. Little temperature change overnight with minimum temperatures in the 50s. Excellent humidity recovery at 80-100%. Ridge winds west 15-20 mph with higher gusts by morning. Slope winds becoming down valley 3-6 mph except west 10 mph Trinity Canyon.

FORECAST FOR WEDNESDAY:

Windy, cloudy and cool. Periods of rain with a wetting rain possible. High temperatures 53-62. Minimum RH 42-56% canyon bottoms to ridgetops. Ridge winds southwest around 20 mph with gusts to 35 mph. Slope and canyon winds west southwest 10 to 15 mph with eddy effects around higher peaks.

EXTENDED OUTLOOK FOR THURSDAY:
Continued cool but not as windy or humid. Mostly cloudy with scattered rain showers. High temperatures in the 50s and 60s. Minimum humidity 35 to 45%. Ridgetop winds north 5 to 10 mph. Upslope/upvalley 5 to 10 mph lower elevations.

Discussion: Cool temperatures and high humidity will persist over the region today with a little less wind.

Weather: Partly cloudy with patches of low clouds in the morning. Occasional light rain.

Max Temp: 60 – 65° highest elevations, 72 – 77° Trinity River canyon.

Min RH: 38 - 45%

20 Foot Winds:

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL

Due to recent precipitation and high relative humidity expect minimal fire behavior over the entire fire area. Rates of spread will be slow with minimal intensity. The only spotting expected will occur through roll-out.

SPECIFIC FIRE BEHAVIOR

Div A/C (Canyon Creek Rd.)

The Helena Fire will continue spreading upslope today at slow rates and continue backing toward Canyon Creek. The Fork Fire is still backing and flanking in a few locations above Canyon Creek. Expect minimal fire behavior.

Div O/R (Conner Creek, Eagle Creek drainages)

Containment lines in Conner Creek are nearly complete and expected to hold. Anticipate burning to continue in the heavy fuels and/or under dense canopies with very low spread rates and low intensity.

Fire in Eagle Creek drainage has been checked with direct line in most areas. Some roll-out on steep slopes to the east of the drainage bottom may occur but no spread is expected.

Nighttime

Expect the fire behavior to be minimal after dark with excellent humidity recovery overnight and precipitation expected.

AIR OPERATIONS

Air operations may be limited in the morning due to reduced visibility by low clouds.


