RED FLAG WARNING IN EFFECT FROM 1300 TUESDAY THROUGH 0800 WEDNESDAY FOR STRONG AND GUSTY WINDS AND LOW RELATIVE HUMIDITY LEVELS

WEATHER DISCUSSION... Smoke will continue to be an issue tonight along with reduced visibilities, especially in the deeper drainages as an inversion level develops around 2500 feet. Temperatures will be a couple of degrees cooler tonight, although relative humidity values will only recover into the poor to fair range. Expect south-southwest ridgetop winds to shift to a north-northeast direction after 2100 and this is also when the terrain driven winds will become downslope/downvalley. The trend of slightly cooler nighttime temperatures will continue on Tuesday night, with similar relative humidity values. Winds will increase Tuesday and Tuesday night as a storm system moves into the Pacific Northwest.

FIRE BEHAVIOR

General:

Fires are burning in grass/litter/understory, brush and mixed conifer with closed canopy of less than 20 ft. FDFM is 3%, making all fuels available to burn.

Topography is very complex, where all factors reach alignment expect increased fire behavior, as the inversion builds, fire behavior will moderate and become less active.

PIG 90% beginning of shift trending to 30% by end of shift.

Specific:

Branch VII:

DIV DD: Fire continues to hold on the Carr Fire contingency line from Damantion Peak to Fools Gulch. Fire may be active early due to clear skies but will become moderate after sunset and inversion builds in.

DIV GG: Fire will slowly back downslope towards the East Fk. of the Trinity River.

DIV JJ/MM: Fire will slowly move north towards Grouse and Highland Lakes. Fire may be active early but is in sparse fuels and higher elevation, so spread will be minimal.

Branch VIII:

DIV PP: Fire continues to burn north to Chicken Hawk Hill but has reached an area with sparse fuels and rocky outcroppings which is limiting growth, spread and intensity.

DIV TT: Fire is backing down into Shotgun Cr. Slope reversal is possible to Middle Ridge, but fire activity will moderate as the inversion builds and humidity's increase near the end of the shift.

DIV WW: SW flow will impact burn operations early in the shift as fire is brought east to the I-5, but will improve as the winds shift to the NE. Spots across the line could be an issue under the SW flow but become minimal as the winds switch to the NE and the inversion builds back in

Branch IX:

DIV AA: Fire will continue to back downslope to the Dog Creek Rd. West side of the Div. Lunch Gulch north to Damnation Peak may become active early in the shift with clear skies, but will moderate as the inversion builds in around 2100.

DIV YY: Burnout opportunities between DP 65 to DP64 will be limited under the SW flow, but will improve as the winds shift around to the NNE around 2100.

DIV ZZ: SW flow will improve burning opportunities early in the shift along Fenders Ferry Rd, but lessen as the flow shifts to out of the NE. Roll out will be an issue on the mid slope road.

Hirz Fire: Threat spread remains low. Mostly creeping and smoldering in unburned islands

Incident Management Team Transition

- Sometimes called the 19th Watch Out Situation.
- Take the time to understand the plan. Ensure all resources completely understand the assignment, the Communications Plan, and the Medical Plan.
- Briefings: Required every shift, for all personnel, for new assignments, and for changing conditions.

Hazard Trees

- All trees need to be considered hazardous until they are evaluated.
- Even large healthy looking trees can be dangerous due to forest health issues.
- Use the look up, down, and all around process when working around or under trees.
- Minimize the number of personnel exposed, and the exposure time.
- Avoid unnecessary exposure around suspect trees during windy periods.
- Mitigate or close areas around hazardous trees in work areas.

Driving

- When driving keep the speed at or below the posted speed limit and turn your headlights on. Is the posted speed limit a safe speed under the current conditions and traffic?
- Use caution on unimproved roads as some have soft shoulders. Some roads are also only one lane with pullouts!
- Road surfaces are variable with washboard conditions and thick dust that can compromise turning and braking.
- Watch for and anticipate stock and wildlife.
- Always fasten your seat belt before the vehicle is set into motion. Use backers.
- Don't tail gate, especially in dusty conditions.
- Slow down, slow down, and slow down!

Personal Safety

Make yourself visible to vehicle traffic while working on, or near roads. Use your headlamp or glow sticks.

Understand your mission, ask questions!






