**WEATHER DISCUSSION:** Another storm system will move into the Pacific Northwest Saturday, resulting in continued cool daytime temperatures across the Hirz and Delta fires. However, the airmass overhead will slowly dry out, resulting in gradually lowering relative humidity values. While the typical ridgetop wind flow pattern is expected with nighttime northerly winds and daytime south to southwest winds, stronger wind speeds are expected Saturday afternoon and evening. Terrain driven winds will occur below the ridgetop locations. Warmer and drier conditions will start on Sunday and continue through at least

Tuesday of next week.

Weather:

Mostly sunny. Patchy smoke. Inversion breaks around 1000.

Max Temps:

68-73 ridgetops and 78-83 lower drainages.

Min RH:

24-29 percent ridges and 20-25 percent lower drainages.

20 FOOT WINDS: Ridges: North 4 to 9 mph with gusts to 15 mph until 1000, then South-Southwest 6 to 11 mph with

gusts to 18 mph.

Slope/valley: Downslope/Downvalley 3 to 6 mph until 1000, then upslope/upvalley 3 to 7 mph.

#### **FIRE BEHAVIOR**

#### INPUTS:

- Fuels: Fine fuels have recovered from the higher humidity of previous days. Spotting from rollout and torching will be more likely today.
- Topography: Fire has few remaining slopes to run. Fire is checked on containment line and topographic features. The fire will need to spot through rollout or group torching.

FIRE BEHAVIOR: Fuel and slope will drive fire spread. Fire will move through backing and flanking in timber fuels with some torching in heavier pockets. Short slope runs in brush are possible, but late in the burn period. During the hottest part of the day, 1530-1730. Expect FL of 10ft and ROS of 30ch/hr in brush and FL of 4-6ft and ROS of 6ch/hr in timber fuels. Isolated torching is possible in closed stands with moderate surface fuel.

Probability of Ignition: 70% in clear air.

**Spotting Distance:** .2 mile from ridgetop locations.

BRANCH 9 - DIV YY: Fire will continue to consume surface fuels with torching in heavier pockets. ROS of 30-40ch/day. Best opportunity to burn will be after 1200.

**DIV ZZ:** Continued burn down of heavy fuels. Rollout from areas above the line remains possible.

DIV AA: Line remains static. Burn trough of fire weakened vegetation could send material dog to Dog Creek and Dog Creek Road.

DIV CC: Humidity will touch 25% today near the end of the burn period. Mixed fuels above the slop could transition to slope runs if a sustained fire front can organize. Any runs would transition to backing fire after crossing Damnation Ridge.

BRANCH 4 - DIV DD: Threat of rollout from ridge and underslung line locations remains. Slope runs back up to the ridge would be head fire in timber litter.

DIV GG: Few opportunities remain for aggressive spread. Fire crossing Halls Gulch Creek could make a short run up the South aspect. Expect open line locations to continue backing.

BRANCH 7 - DIV JJ/MM: Any spots across containment lines will exhibit low ROS and FL. Spotting from torching will be the most likely ignition source.

BRANCH 8 - DIV PP/TT: Firing operations will be more favorable as the burn period progresses. Spots across containment lines will exhibit low ROS and FL. Monitor downwind locations and areas of torching during the hottest part of the day as POI will be moderate with spotting distances of .2 mile from ridgetops.

**DIV WW:** Threat of spotting from torching remains high at the forks of Shotgun Creek and the confluence of Sacramento River. Swirling winds and steep slopes will make IA difficult.

Hirz Fire: Threat of spread from the fires edge remains low. Remaining hot spots have very little fuel to run.

#### **AIR OPERATIONS**

Air operations will be hampered by inversion in the morning. Most areas will experience clearing by late afternoon.

DATE: 09-14-2018

TIME: 0600 – 1800 Day Shift

BACK TO THE BASICS: Size-Up; when does it start and when does it end? On our way to this fire we were sizing-up the weather, fuels, topography and the condition of our crew. Now that we have several shifts under our belts, are we still doing this? If not, we should be! Size-up is a continual and ongoing process that should last us through the incident and safely back home.

#### RISK OF HYPOTHERMIA

- The condition of having an abnormally low core body temperature
- Occurs with core body temperature below 95 degrees
- Symptoms:
  - Shivering slow shallow breath, slow weak pulse
  - Altered level of consciousness, drowsiness and slurred speech
- Mitigations:
  - Remove wet clothing, protect against wind
  - Move to a warm dry shelter, begin gentle rewarming
  - Offer warm liquids only if conscience and alert
  - SEEK MEDICAL ATTENTION!

# HUMAN FACTOR BARRIERS TO SITUATIONAL AWARENESS

- Fatigue
  - o Carbon Monoxide
  - Dehydration
  - o Heat Stress
  - o Fitness Level
  - 24-hrs awake affects your decision making like 0.1 blood alcohol content
- Hazardous Attitude
  - Invulnerability
  - Anti-Authority
  - Impulsive
  - Over confident
  - Complacent
  - Resigned
  - Afraid to speak up, or disagree

#### THE DRIVE HOME

- Cumulative fatigue is a reality, many resources have completed a 14 day or extended 21 day assignment
- Don't be in a hurry, follow posted speed limit signs and slow down when road conditions warrant
- Take breaks as needed / manage fatigue
- All personnel in the vehicle MUST wear seatbelts
- Use safe following distances
- Ensure all headlights, brake lights, turn signals, and windshield wipers are operating correctly
- The assignment isn't concluded until you're home, safe!

## STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURES—FINANCE SECTION "How to Earn an Honest Day's Pay for an Honest Day's Work" YOU ARE ENTITLED TO ACTUAL HOURS WORKED!!

#### WORK REST CYCLE

IT IS NATIONAL DIRECTION TO MEET A 2 TO 1 WORK/REST RATIO (1 hour of sleep/rest for every 2 hours of work.. Every effort shall be made to manage work hours so you don't exceed the maximum of 16 hrs. Work hours exceeding 16 hrs shall be approved by your supervisor in advance, and a justification/mitigation form completed for review by Section Chief & approved by IC. It is each person's responsibility to comply with this direction to manage for fatigue and safety.

#### **OPERATIONAL SHIFTS**

Pay status for assigned overhead and crews on the fireline will not start prior to the posted briefing time and will terminate on arrival back in camp (except for debriefing—additional hours may be accrued by those required to attend debriefing). Supervisors will be allowed ½ hour prior to briefing and after return to camp to ready crew and equipment.

#### **DUTY STATUS**

Division/Group supervisors and Unit Leaders are responsible for establishing on and off duty status. The objective is a 2 to 1 work/rest ratio. Personnel will normally work, travel, <u>and/or</u> be placed on ORDERED standby 8 to 16 hours per day and be off duty 8 hours or more (breaks count towards 8 hrs). Off duty time will be in a non-pay status. Each federal employee is guaranteed **at least 8 hours** of pay status each 24-hour period (midnight to midnight) unless it is the first or last day of an assignment or stated otherwise in a contract or agreement.

#### PERSONNEL/EQUIPMENT TIME REPORTING

<u>Personnel time</u> will be reported to the Time Unit and daily once they are signed by the next level supervisor. OES resources will be monitored by OES Agency Rep (if assigned) for 2/1 Work Rest compliance. Situations entitling you to HAZARD PAY are to be noted in remarks (i.e HP=Uncontrolled Fireline, hovering hookups, low level flights, etc.)

<u>Private Contracted Equipment time</u> must be tracked on a Shift Ticket daily and hours on shift noted even if it is a daily rate. When swapping out operators you need to notify Finance as well as changing from single to double shift and vice versa.

Supervisor's - If you are responsible for daily tracking of equipment or personnel, please ensure you understand the agreement, and follow the rules provided in this document. Do not sign documents for resources you did not manage unless you have knowledge of their assignment hours.

#### MEAL AND OTHER WORK BREAKS

Compensable meal periods are the exception, not the rule (5 CFR 551.411 © and 29 CFR 785.19(a)). Until the fire is controlled, personnel on the fireline MAY BE compensated for meal periods if all of the following conditions are met: 1) The fire is not controlled and 2) The Operations Section Chief makes a decision that it is critical to the effort of controlling the fire that personnel remain at their post of duty and continue to work as they eat, and 3) The compensable meal break is approved by the supervisor at the next level and documented on CTR. For personnel in support positions, and fireline personnel after control of a fire, a meal period of at least 30 minutes must be ordered and taken for each work shift of eight hours or more. This statement does not mean you don't show all meal breaks if taken. In those situations where personnel cannot be relieved from work and must remain at a post of duty, a meal period may be counted as time worked, which will be compensable. If meal breaks are NOT able to be taken, CTR should have a statement in remarks explaining the situation.






