\*\*\*Gusty South to Southwest winds from late this morning into the evening hours tonight\*\*\*

<u>WEATHER DISCUSSION:</u> A storm system moving into the Pacific Northwest will continue the cool daytime temperatures across the Hirz and Delta fires through Sunday, although the airmass will slowly dry out with lowering relative humidity values. This system will also push an upper level trough across the area, resulting in breezy winds today between mid-slope and ridgetop levels. The typical ridgetop wind flow pattern will <u>not</u> occur tonight, with south to southwest winds persisting most of the night. Terrain driven winds will occur below mid-slope locations. Warmer and drier conditions will start on Monday and continue through at least the middle of next week.

TODAY... Sky/weather.....Mostly sunny. Patchy smoke. Inversion breaks around 1000. Max temperature.....67-72 ridgetops and 77-82 lower drainages. Min humidity......21-26 percent ridges and 17-22 percent lower drainages. Wind (20 ft)..... Slope/valley.....Downslope/Downvalley 3 to 6 mph until 1000, then upslope/upvalley 3 to 7 mph. Ridgetop......Variable to South 3 to 8 mph with gusts to 15 mph until 1000, then South-Southwest winds increasing to 11 to 16 mph with gusts around 25 mph in the afternoon. Mixing height......7,000 to 9,000 ft AGL. Transport winds.....South 7 mph until 1000, increasing to 16 mph in the afternoon. CWR..... percent. LAL....1. TONIGHT... Sky/weather.....Mostly clear. Patchy smoke. Weak inversion develops after 0100. Min temperature.....48-53 ridgetops, 42-47 lower drainages. Max humidity.....50-55 percent ridges and 65-70 percent lower drainages. Wind (20 ft)..... Slope/valley......Upslope 3-7 mph becoming downslope 3-6 mph after 2100. Ridgetop......South-Southwest 10 to 15 mph with gusts to 25 mph until 2100, diminishing to 7 to 12 mph by 2400 and 5 to 10 mph overnight. Mixing height.....Lowering to less than 2000 ft AGL. Mostly sunny, Patchy smoke, Inversion breaks around 1000.

Max Temps:

67-72 ridgetops and 77-82 lower drainages.

Min RH:

21-26 percent ridges and 17-22 percent lower drainages.

20 FOOT WINDS: Ridges: Variable to South 3 to 8 mph with gusts to 15 mph until 1000, then South-Southwest winds

increasing to 11 to 16 mph with gusts around 25 mph in the afternoon.

Slope/valley: Downslope/Downvalley 3 to 6 mph until 1000, then upslope/upvalley 3 to 7 mph.

#### **FIRE BEHAVIOR**

#### **INPUTS:**

- Fuels: Fuel moistures are near averages for this time of year. The exception is 1000hr fuels that are at the 90th percentile.
- Topography: Moderate slope runs will continue to be possible on slopes with Southern exposure. Torching along the Sacramento River will have an above average chance of spotting due to swirling winds and light fuels.

FIRE BEHAVIOR: Slope will drive fire spread when coupled with wind. Fire will move through backing and flanking in timber fuels with some torching in heavier pockets. Short slope runs in brush, transitioning into timber, are possible after 1300. During the hottest part of the day, 1530-1730, Expect FL of 11ft and ROS of 30ch/hr in brush and FL of 5-7ft and ROS of 7ch/hr in timber fuels. Torching is possible in closed stands with moderate surface fuel.

Probability of Ignition: 80% in clear air.

Spotting Distance: .3 mile from ridgetop locations.

BRANCH 9 - DIV YY: Forecast winds will be in alignment with the Sacramento River. Flanking fire on West slopes could transition to more active fire behavior, especially after 1400. Torching combined with swirling winds will elevate the chance of greater fire spread and spots on the Interstate 5 side of the river. Chances of spots and group torching are greatest, in Oak/Pine woodland fuel

DIV ZZ/AA: Continued burn down of heavy fuels. Rollout from areas above the line remains possible.

DIV CC: Winds will impact the DIV today and be parallel to the control line on Sanford Road. Spots above the control line and on McKenzie Ridge will move toward Damnation Peak.

BRANCH 4 - DIV DD: Spots across the line will be pushed back into the black. Threat of rollout from ridge and underslung line locations remains

DIV GG: Few opportunities remain for aggressive spread. Fire crossing Halls Gulch Creek could make a short run up the South aspect. A spot in the East Fork of the Trinity River would have ample fuel to make a drainage run to the North with the wind alignment.

BRANCH 7 - DIV JJ/MM: Torching in unburned fuel is possible today. Ridgetop containment lines would be susceptible to moderate range spotting. A spot in the East Fork of the Trinity River would have ample fuel to make a drainage run to the North with the wind alignment.

BRANCH 8 - DIV PP/TT: Threat of slope runs to Middle Ridge and the containment line to the Southeast. These high elevation locations will experience increased winds today. Moderate range spotting is possible after 1400.

DIV WW: Threat of spotting in upper Shotgun Creek remains. Monitor activity in DIV YY for possible spots and active fire behavior. Fire across the Sacramento River and Interstate 5 would present significant fuel between your DIV and the fire front.

Hirz Fire: Threat of spread from the fires edge remains low. Remaining hot spots have very little fuel to run.

## **Mop-Up Operations**

- Provide motivation to workers to maintain situational awareness and avoid complacency.
- Evaluate mop up distances against what is safe and necessary.
- Review and follow "Look Up, Look Down, Look Around" procedures (IRPG p. 3-4).

## **Driving**

- When driving, keep speed at or below the posted speed limit.
- Drive defensively! Expect the unexpected around every curve.
- Watch out for debris and wildlife on the roads.
- Don't tail gate, keep a safe distance between vehicles on dirt roads.
- Always fasten your seat belt before the vehicle is set into motion.
- Use a "Backer" when backing your vehicle. Do a walk around if a "Backer" is not available






