<u>WEATHER DISCUSSION:</u> Afternoon temperatures and relative humidity values today will be nearly the same as yesterday, with wind speeds down considerably. Nighttime relative humidity levels will continue to slowly lower, especially above the inversion layer. The typical ridgetop wind flow pattern will set back up again tonight, with south to southwest winds in the evening switching around from the north overnight. Terrain driven winds will occur below ridgetop locations. Warmer and drier conditions will start on Monday and continue through the end of the week.

## FIRE BEHAVIOR

#### INPUTS:

Fuels: Fuel moistures are near averages for this time of year. The exception is 1000hr fuels that are at the 90th percentile.

Topography: Fire is running out of run to move. Movement will be localized to remain pockets of fuel inside of control lines.

FIRE BEHAVIOR: Slope runs with torching near ridges present the greatest challenge to containment today. During the hottest part of the day, 1530-1730, Expect FL of 10ft and ROS of 30ch/hr in brush and FL of 3-6ft and ROS of 6ch/hr in timber fuels. Torching is possible in closed stands with moderate surface fuel.

Probability of Ignition: 75% in clear air.

Spotting Distance: 1 mile from ridgetop locations.

BRANCH 9 - DIV YY: Torching remains a threat to containment lines. Abundant light fuel on the West side of the Sacramento River is a receptive fuel bed. Torching combined with swirling winds could throw spots across the river.

DIV ZZ/AA: Only isolated areas of heat remain. Rollout from areas above the line remains possible.

DIV CC: Reduced winds today be more favorable for firing. Winds will be parallel or slightly green to black after 1000. Slight chance of slope runs in brush later in the burn period.

BRANCH 4 - DIV DD/GG: Few areas of heat remain along the line. Rollout from areas above the line remains possible.

BRANCH 7 - DIV JJ/MM: Heat remains in the DP-57 Highland Lake area. Threat of escape is reduced as containment lines held during higher winds of Saturday.

BRANCH 8 - DIV PP/TT: Some heat along Boulder Creek Road above DP-56 remains. Threat of escape is reduced as containment lines held during higher winds of Saturday.

**DIV ww:** Shotgun Creek remains a concern for rollout. Little heat remains along containment lines.

Hirz Fire: Threat of spread from the fires edge remains low. Remaining hot spots have very little fuel to run.

## **Gaining Respect**

Know your subordinates and look out for their well-being

- Put the safety of your subordinates above all other objectives.
- Take care of your subordinates needs.
- Resolve conflicts between individuals on your team.

## **Operational Leadership**

The most essential element of successful wildland firefighting is competent and confident leadership. In confusing and uncertain situations, a good operational leader will:

- TAKE CHARGE of assignment.
- ASSESS SITUATION by gaining intel.
- MOTIVATE firefighters with a "can do safely attitude."
- DEMONSTRATE INITIATIVE by taking action in the absence of orders
- COMMUNICATE by giving specific instructions and asking for feedback.
- SUPERVISE at the scene of action.

## **Situational Awareness**

There are five major common denominators of fire behavior on fatal and near-fatal fires. Such fires often occur:

- 1. On relatively small fires or deceptively quiet areas of large fires..
- In relatively light fuels, such as grass, herbs, and light brush.
- 3. When there is an unexpected shift in wind direction or in wind speed.
- 4. When fire responds to topographic conditions and runs uphill.
- 5. Critical burn periods between 1400 and 1700. (IRPG p. 5).

Keep these factors in mind during mop-up activities.

## **Fire Behavior Predictions**

- Base all actions on current and expected fire behavior – do this first!
- An estimate must be made of the approaching fire intensity in order to determine if there is an adequate safety zone and time available before fire arrives.
- Due to the dynamic nature of fire behavior, intensity estimate are difficult to make with absolute certainty. It is imperative thoat firefighters consider the worst case and build contingency actions into their plan to compensate for the unexpected.
- Think SAFETY. Lives are depending on it.


