Red Flag Warning for Gusty Winds and Dry Conditions through this Afternoon

WEATHER DISCUSSION: The strongest winds are expected this morning until around 1100, with winds gradually diminishing through the day. Winds could gust as high as 30 mph on ridgetops, with higher gusts possible in areas of alignment and saddles/unsheltered ridges through the morning. In addition, aligned drainages, such as the Interstate 5 Corridor, will see higher gusts surfacing. Temperatures will also be warm/hot and with very dry conditions. Single digit relative humidity is expected in the lower drainages and lower teens across ridgetops. For tonight, winds will turn out of the northeast to east-northeast, but not as strong as last night. Overnight recovery will be poor to moderate. Friday will be the hottest day for portions of the fire, before we gradually cool down into the weekend. The cool down will be short lived, as temperatures climb back toward the 80s by early next week.

Weather:

Day: Mostly sunny, a few high clouds. Inversion breaks around 1000. Night: A few high clouds.

Shallow inversion develops after 2100.

Day/Night Temps: 77-82 ridgetops and 87-92 lower drainages then 60-65 ridgetops, 51-56 lower drainages.

Day/Night RH: 10-15 percent ridges and 8-13 percent lower drainages then 35-40 percent ridges and 45-50 percent

lower drainages.

20 FOOT WINDS: Day/Night Ridges: North-Northeast 10 to 20 mph, gusts to 30 mph until 1100, decreasing to 7 to 12

mph, gusts to 25 mph in the afternoon then North-northeast 10 to 15 mph with gusts to 25 mph until

2300, then decreasing North-Northeast 4 to 9 mph, gusts to 15 mph.

Day/Night Slope/valley: Downslope/Downvalley 4 to 9 mph until 1000, then upslope/upvalley 2 to 5 mph. The wind in aligned drainages will be from the north with the highest gusts along the I5 Corridor

then Upslope 3-7 mph becoming downslope/downvalley 4-9 mph after 2200.

FIRE BEHAVIOR

INPUTS:

• Fuels: Previously underburned aerial fuels are more susceptible to torching. Fuel moistures are slightly below averages for this time of year. The exception is 1000hr fuels that are at the 90th percentile.

 Topography: Areas with Northern exposures will see the greatest impacts from forecast winds. DIV CC will see shear (swirling winds) as upslopes from Dog Creek interact with the general winds coming over Damnation Peak.

FIRE BEHAVIOR: Fire has played its hand inside containment lines. Expect moderate to high fire behavior outside lines on Southern aspects and brush fuels. Wind and drainage alignment in timber fuel could result in group torching and spotting. During the hottest part of the day, 1530-1730, Expect FL of 15ft and ROS of 64ch/hr in brush and FL of 5-9ft and ROS of 12ch/hr in timber fuels. ** Local areas susceptible to slope runs include: North aspects near Riverton and Little Dog Creek and locations along the Sacramento River between Dunsmuir and Castella.**

Probability of Ignition: 90+% in clear air. **Spotting Distance:** .4 mile from ridgetop locations.

Day: DIV PP/TT: Interior pockets continue to consume. Winds will push from the green to the black.

DIV WW/YY: North winds should prevail throughout the day increasing into the evening hours. Torching remains possible on windward slopes. Pockets of unburned fuels could produce active fire behavior.

DIV ZZ/AA/CC: Higher locations of DIV CC will see North winds today. Lunch Gulch can expect variable winds as upslope and general winds interact near Damnation Peak and burn down will result in rollout in the lower reaches of the gulch. Strong North winds should not be a factor for holding. Elsewhere, only isolated areas of heat remain.

DIV DD/GG: Except for the area near the CC/DD break, few areas of heat remain along the line. Torching just below windward ridges is possible.

DIV JJ/MM: Some small areas of fire as remaining fuel burns down.

Hirz Fire: Threat of spread from the fires edge remains low. Isolated burning of heavy fuel and stump holes is possible with increased wind.

Night: North – DIV PP/TT/WW/YY: Drier conditions will be offset by forecast north winds blowing from the green to the black. Little threat of escape or spots. Pockets of unburned fuel remain well within containment lines and will continue to consume.

South – DIV ZZ/AA/CC: Higher locations of DIV CC will see North winds tonight including Damnation Pass. Lower elevations will be protected. Modest humidity recover will reducing intensities but fire will continue to burn remaining fuel.

AIR OPERATIONS

Clear conditions with little smoke impact.

** Moderate fire behavior conditions still exist. Group torching and slope runs are possible

Fight Complacency

- · Stay mentally engaged on the task at hand
- · Give clear briefings.
- · Clearly identify the day's mission and purpose.
- Use the "Buddy System" and watch out for each other. If you see something, say something.
- Ask yourself: "Are you doing the job safely, the way you were trained?"
- Look for a "new" or "fresh" approach to repetitive assignments.
- · Address complacency in your daily AAR.

Dehydration

- "Camp Crud" may predispose a firefighter to dehydration.
- Be aware of the health status of your crew members. It is much better to assign light duty, and a day of rest in camp, than to possibly trigger a medical emergency on the line.
- Also, pay special attention to the time after the shift ends, and prior to the next shift to emphasize drinking water and electrolyte drinks.
- Encourage drinking when awake during off-shift periods.

AAR after each shift

- Have the team form a loose circle.
- Start with a single team member and ask just one of these questions:
 - o What is one thing that went well on this shift?
 - o What is one thing that didn't go well on this shift?
 - What is one thing you would do different next time?
 - o What is one thing you learned today?
- Continue around the circle until everyone has had a chance. It may be necessary to place a time limit on each individual (i.e. 30 seconds).
- Avoid unnecessary discussion (dinner is waiting).
- Note the comments for action and future discussion.

Operational Leadership

- Take Charge of assigned resources.
- Anticipate changing conditions and potential emergencies.
- Motivate firefighters with a "can do safely" attitude.
- Demonstrate Initiative by taking action in the absence of orders.
- Communicate by giving specific instructions and asking for feedback!
- · Supervise at the scene of the action.
- Follow-Up with feedback and suggestions for improvement.

INCIDENT REPLACEMENT POLICY & PROCESS

<u>Prior to release</u> from the incident, personnel may request replacement of equipment and supplies that were damaged, lost, or consumed during the incident. There is a distinct difference in the process to replace cache equipment and supplies and non-cache or specialized equipment. Damaged property **will be turned into the Supply Unit** prior to an Incident Replacement Requisition being approved.

Replacement of cache equipment is documented on a 213 General Message form and filled at the Supply Unit or approved for replacement at the home unit. Approval for replacement of non-standard cache items has been delegated to the IC, Finance Section Chief and IBA. You should initiate this process at least two days prior to demob.

Personnel who need to replace/repair damaged property will document the request and circumstances on a 213 General Message signed by your Incident Supervisor. The lost or damaged item(s) will then be taken to either, Supply, Communications or Ground Support for inspection and recommendation for replacement or repair. Bring the completed form to COMP/CLAIMS who will review the request and forward it to the FSC. The IC/FSC will make a decision as to whether or not the items can be replaced or repaired with incident funds.

Items originally purchased through use of preparedness funds which need to be replaced due to normal wear and tear should be accomplished using home unit funds, not incident funds. If government property was damaged on the incident due to a specific event, e.g. wind event destroys tent, items are burned over or caused by actions where there is no negligence, the incident could, upon receipt of required documentation and proof of damage, authorize replacement using the Incident Replacement Requisition.

In some cases, the cache replacement is not acceptable on some specialty items (e.g. sleeping bag or specialty packs). These items may be replaced with no more than "cache" quality and cost. The IBA or FSC must approve these requests.

If your request is approved, provide the approval and support documentation to Ordering or Supply for issuing an "S" number.

Effective Waterbars


When locating and building water bars, place them the right **distance** apart, at a **diagonal** to the fireline, so that they **divert**, then **discharge**, then **dissipate** the energy of the flowing water. Be sure to make them deep enough so they'll be durable, and that soil does **not block** the water bar outlet.

Recommended spacing for waterbars on firelines.

Fireline slope %		Maximum Distance Apart <u>(feet)</u>
1 – 5	*****************	200
6 – 20		125
21 – 40		60
41 – 60		40
>60	•••••	25

Waterbars should be at least 2 pulaski (4-6 inches) widths wide and 12-24 inches high for handlines.

Waterbars should be no more 2-3 feet tall on dozer lines to enable future access.



Stage 2 Suppression Repair Guidelines

(Apply to National Forest System Lands only on dozer lines with moderate to heavy suppression generated debris)

Applicable Suppression Repair Plan Objectives


- Minimize loss of soil productivity due to potential erosion in cleared areas.
- Minimize surface erosion.
- Minimize excessive side-cast fuels.

General Instructions

- Pile excessive amounts of suppression generated debris.
- Smaller concentrations of suppression generated debris can be feathered back into scraped side slope areas in order to breakdown fuel concentrations and reduce erosion.

Piling Specifications


- Piles should be located at least 10 feet away from tree boles and preferably out of the drip line of the canopy where possible.
 - If working in close or closed canopy piles should be built in a configuration that prevents excessive tree scorch (e.g. small piles, windrowed piles).
- If working in large openings on large dozer lines piles can be larger (e.g. 25x25 feet).
- Compress piles as much as possible to improve burn consumption.
- Piles should be clean (free of soil) to ensure adequate consumption during burning and reduced risk of escape in spring.


