A full suppression strategy will be implemented for the Hirz Fire through a combination of direct and indirect strategies. Efforts will be made to minimize fire spread and severity across private timberlands and structures through the application of well-planned tactical responses.

#### **Management Objectives**

- Ensure that strategies and tactics provide for firefighter and public safety through the application of sound risk management principles.
- Minimize the threat to private property, critical infrastructure, and commercial timberlands.
- Establish and strengthen cooperator, partner, and stakeholder relationships.
- Minimize the cost of the incident by employing tactics that have the highest probability of success while minimizing firefighter exposure.

#### **Control Objectives**

#### Keep the Hirz Fire:

- North of Gilman Road to protect private residences and property to the south.
- South of Tom Neal Creek Road to protect private and federal timberlands and natural resource values, including Northern Spotted Owl habitat and Inventoried Roadless Area.
- East of Middle Salt Creek to Green Mountain to North Fork Salt Creek to protect private property and infrastructure values in and around the Interstate 5 corridor.
- West of Squaw Valley Creek, McCloud River and McCloud River arm of Shasta Lake to protect
  private timberlands, natural resource values, including Northern Spotted Owl habitat and recreation
  infrastructure.
- 6. Weather Forecast for Period:

**WEATHER DISCUSSION**...We will see a continuation of the northeast winds across the fire area this morning, but then trend upslope/upvalley in the afternoon with south to southwest winds along the ridgetops. Temperatures will be 2-4 degrees warmer than Monday and relative humidity values will be

3-5 percent lower as well. Expect a strong inversion to develop over the fire area tonight after 2100 and hold until about 1300 on Wednesday. Visibilities could be as low as 1 to 3 miles in some areas Wednesday morning. Temperatures on Wednesday will be 3-5 degrees cooler than on Tuesday and minimum relative humidities will be up 4-8 percent from Tuesday.

- 7. General Safety Message:
- ~ Practice "Defensive Driving" techniques traveling on all roads in both rural and urban settings
- ~ Slowdown in limited visibility (smoky/dusty) & congested areas. Increase following distances
- ~ Roads can be slippery when wet, assess the road before driving on it.
- ~ Honk horn to alert personnel when backing. Use spotters when available
- ~ Expect two way traffic on one lane roads. Stay on your side, and approach corners with caution
- ~ Headlights ON. Manually turn on Headlights. Most vehicles have "auto" headlights
- ~ NO riding in the back of pick-ups.

#### **FIRE BEHAVIOR**

**GENERAL:** A Fuels and Fire Behavior Advisory is still effect for heavier than normal grass and low fuel moistures. The fire is burning in mixed brush and timber stands with timber litter. The fire will continue to move to the north under the expected weather conditions. The inversion layer will be lower in the morning, allowing for fire activity to pick up sooner than recent days above 2000 feet. With the winds shifting mid-day, expect the fire activity to pick up in favored drainages and over the ridgetops.

#### Branch I

DIV A/B: No control problems expected continue to patrol and watch for rollout into the receptive fuels.

DIV F: Fire will continue to consume interior islands as they heat up. Watch for rollout.

**DIV T:** Watch for increased activity along the control line by DP 67

**DIV U:** Expect the fire to continue to flank and back into drainages north of the ridge between Green Mtn and High Mtn. Fire activity will increase to the North especially as the fire experiences slope reversals

Special Medical Emergency Procedures for remote locations and night shift:

Identify your EMT's for each Division. In the event of a medical emergency, notify your division supervisor (DIVS) and initiate care with available resources on scene. Follow the MEDICAL INCIDENT REPORT (MIR) procedure on pages 118-119 in the 2018 IRPG or from last page of the IAP. Using the MIR, notify Hirz Communications of the type of emergency and the location over the command channel. This will initiate the Incident Within Incident (IWI) procedures to get the appropriate recourses to assist in the emergency.

The DIVS, or designee, shall coordinate the incident and direct necessary actions. Take the following actions:


- 1. Determine the nature of the emergency.
- If the emergency is a medical injury/illness, determine if the injury/illness is life threatening.
   <u>Green</u> (Non-Life Threatening), <u>Yellow</u> (Serious Injury/Illness), <u>Red</u> (Life Threatening Injury/Illness).
- 3. If the injury is life threatening, then clear designated frequency for emergency traffic.
- 4. Identify the on-scene point of contact by position.
- 5. Hirz Communications will contact the Medical Unit Leader immediately.
- 6. Identify number injured, patient assessment(s), location (geographic and/or GPS coordinates), and agency of the patient(s).
- 7. Identify on-scene medical personnel by position and last name (i.e. Line Medic Jones).
- 8. Identify preferred method of patient transport. Ground or Air.
- 9. Determine any additional resources or equipment needed.

Continually evaluate the Evacuation Plan, develop contingencies in the event the first plan is not effective.


