
## Fire Order of the Day – Maintain prompt communications with your forces, your supervisor, and adjoining forces

#### **Normalization of Deviance**

- The concept that over time we deviate from the way we were taught to do something. Finding shortcuts to increase efficiency or get results. These shortcuts often come at the price of ensuring safety.
- It's not until we get hurt, fail, or have extreme consequences that we realize how far we've deviated from the correct and safe way to perform the task.

Don't let what you've "gotten away with" be your guide to future decisions and actions. This incident, like all others, is constantly changing. Make sure you are too!

Special Medical Emergency Procedures for remote locations and night shift:

Identify your EMT's for each Division. In the event of a medical emergency, notify your division supervisor (DIVS) and initiate care with available resources on scene. Follow the MEDICAL INCIDENT REPORT (MIR) procedure on pages 118-119 in the 2018 IRPG or from last page of the IAP. Using the MIR, notify Hirz Communications of the type of emergency and the location over the command channel. This will initiate the Incident Within Incident (IWI) procedures to get the appropriate resources to assist in the emergency.

The DIVS, or designee, shall coordinate the incident and direct necessary actions. Take the following actions:


- 1. Determine the nature of the emergency.
- 2. If the emergency is a medical injury/illness, determine if the injury/illness is life threatening. <u>Green</u> (Non-Life Threatening), <u>Yellow</u> (Serious Injury/Illness), <u>Red</u> (Life Threatening Injury/Illness).
- 3. If the injury is life threatening, then clear designated frequency for emergency traffic.
- 4. Identify the on-scene point of contact by position.
- 5. Hirz Communications will contact the Medical Unit Leader and Safety immediately.
- 6. Identify number injured, patient assessment(s), location (geographic and/or GPS coordinates), and agency of the patient(s).
- 7. Identify on-scene medical personnel by division and position (i.e. Tango Medic, Tango EMT)
- 8. Identify preferred method of patient transport. Ground or Air.
- 9. Determine any additional resources or equipment needed.

Continually evaluate the Evacuation Plan, develop contingencies in the event the first plan is not effective.

Per Interagency Fire Business Management Handbook Chapter 10:

Agency resources assigned to an incident or engaged in initial attack fire response will adhere to the current agency work/rest policy for determining length of duty day:

#### **Driving:**

 A driver shall drive only if they have had at least 8 consecutive hours off duty before beginning a shift.

**Work/Rest Guidelines** should be met on all incidents. Plan for and ensure all personnel are provided a minimum 2:1 work/rest ratio (for every 2 hours of work or travel, provide 1 hour of sleep and/or rest).

 If you work over 16 hours this must be justified and approved by the IC. All shifts that exceed 16 hours and those that do not meet 2:1 work/ratio must be justified. Justification will be documented in the daily incident records (CTR or letter). Documentation shall include mitigation measures used to reduce fatigue.


