Firing Operations

Ensure aerial/ground ignition plans have been developed and personnel are briefed.

- One qualified individual (Burn Boss) must be responsible for controlling and directing the firing operation. Identify the Firing Boss, Holding Boss and let them be known.
- Before firing operations begin, ensure that: Lookouts are in place, Communications are established; escape routes and safety zones are known to all.
- Make sure that escape routes are not compromised by the firing operations or by vehicles blocking the roadways. All vehicles will be staged in the direction of the "Escape Route".

- Fuels: Northwestern California is currently under a reinstated Fuels and Fire Behavior Advisory for a heavier than normal grass crop and low fuel moistures through the end of August. Past fire history is minimal, so timber litter accumulation is significant. Available fuels are significantly increased in private timber blocks with red slash and induced shrub/oak mortality, leading to a high resistance to control. The fire area has pockets of mature timber with Douglas fir and Ponderosa pine on north aspects with more shrub cover on the south- and west-facing slopes. All live fuel moistures are reaching critically dry levels. Live fuel moistures are modeled to be at or near 70% (lower on SW aspects) and dead/down 1000 hr. fuel moistures are < 6%.
- **Topography**: All aspects are represented in the fire, though the origin was on more of a notheast. The fire is burning on steep terrain above the McCloud Arm of Lake Shasta, and on either side of the Salt Creek drainage with slopes that vary between 35 and 75%. Elevation range is 1100 3969'.

SPECIFIC FIRE BEHAVIOR:

- Short uphill runs in brush exceeding 80 ch/hr with 12-20' flame lengths may occur. This will trigger group- and single-tree torching with flames in excess of 100' to include short-range spotting < 0.3 mile (further if plume dominated fire behavior develops). Fire could travel over a mile during the burn period, when in alignment.
- Probability of ignition 89 93%.
- The majority of the fire spread will continue to be flanking and backing aided by rollout on steep slopes (ROS <2 ch/hr and flame lengths 1-3').

Branch I DIV A/B: No control problems expected along the Gillman Road from DP1 to DP15 and on to Matquaw Flat. Watch for rollout across the road and unfavorable downslope winds lasting until upslope winds establish by late morning. Should have favorable burning conditions to bring fire from DP-27 down to the main fire edge in the Salt Creek drainage.

DIV F: Fire will continue to back off into the Middle Salt Creek drainage. Should have good conditions to continue burnout operations west from Buck Peak to DP-29

DIV T: No expected fire impacts, unless burnout of lines is initiated. Post lookouts. Unburned fuels between you and the fire

DIV Z: Fire will continue to make runs north from Nawtawaket creek up to the ridgeline on the shoulder of Nawtawaket Mountain. Sparse fuels along this ridgeline my halt fire spread and offer an opportunity to go direct. The fire will continue to flank actively on the upper slopes, moving north up the McCloud River drainage, leading to a threat of fire across the McCloud River. Rollout will continue to extend backing fire spread.

FREQUENT SPOT FIRES ACROSS THE LINE

Weather / Fire Behavior Category

There are few watchout situations that state more clearly how much potential your fire has for rapid, uncontrolled growth. Consider the following questions if you are getting spot fires across your line:

- Can you handle increased spotting? List some ways you can keep ahead of spot fires (gridding the green, lookouts, etc.)
- What is your probability of ignition doing? Is it increasing or decreasing?
- Do you have a plan for long-range spotting? In what fuel type and under what conditions will you likely have long-range spotting? What types of plans can you think of for handling long-range spotting?
- Is help available if necessary? What kinds of resources will you have in place or order to handle spot fires?
- If fire behavior increases, is your position still defensible? Discuss what type of action you might take if a spot fire takes off.
- Do you have more than one safety zone in case one gets cut off? Describe how you might have multiple safety zones.
- → Do the primary lookouts have a good view of the situation? Discuss who might be acting as a lookout (e.g., crew member, air resources, etc.) and how you will get good information from that person. (Are you relying on an air attack that is busy with air tankers?)
- Where are you in the burning period? Talk about how your tactics may vary from finding spot fires early in the day to later into the evening. Review Probability of Ignition (PIG) and what it can tell you about spotting potential.
- To reduce the risk, be ready to retreat. Keep your guard up even if spotting has not occurred for a few hours. Review fires where you have had frequent spot fires and what you learned about controlling them.




