WEATHER DISCUSSION...A trough of low pressure will remain over the fire area today and tonight before a weather disturbance bringing gusty ridge winds moves across Oregon and extreme northeast California on Sunday afternoon and evening. Expect moderate inversion conditions with lingering areas of smoke through the morning and early afternoon hours today with little change in humidity and temperature trend. **Sunday, with increasing westerly winds aloft, the inversion will dissipate by mid day allowing for higher gusts over exposed ridges. ***To the east of the Hirz Incident a Fire Weather Watch for Strong Winds is in effect for Sunday afternoon and evening.*****

Discussion: A trough of low pressure will remain over the fire area today.

Weather: Sunny. Hazy and areas of smoke. Inversion breaking around 1300.

FIRE BEHAVIOR

Forecasted Indices: Sugarloaf BI (Fuel Model G) 65 Down 1; Sugarloaf ERC (Fuel Model G) 86 up 1;

GENERAL:

- **Fuels:**
 - NW California is currently under a **Fuels and Fire Behavior Advisory** for a heavier than normal grass crop and low fuel moistures through the end of August. Timber/brush litter accumulation is significant
 - **All live fuel moistures are reaching critically dry levels**
- **Topography:**
 - All aspects are represented in the fire. The fire is burning on steep terrain with slopes that vary between 35 and 75%. Elevation range is 1100 - 3969'.

SPECIFIC FIRE BEHAVIOR:

- Uphill runs in brush exceeding **63 ch/hr with 12-15' flame lengths** may occur. This may trigger group and single tree **torching with flames in excess of 100'** to include short-range spotting < 0.25 mile
- Fire could travel over a mile during the burn period, when in alignment.
- Probability of ignition 73 - 79%.

Branch I

DIV A/B: No control problems expected continue to watch for rollout into the receptive fuels outside the fire perimeter near the structures where the burnout occurred.

DIV F: Fire will consume interior islands as they heat up. Watch for rollout into receptive fuel beds. Favorable winds for any burnout operations remaining.

DIV T: Watch for potential spotting over the line when interior areas heat up and make short duration runs. Favorable winds for any burnout operations remaining.

Branch II

DIV U: Expect the Fire to continue to flank and back into the North Salt Creek drainage. Expect short runs up micro ridges. Unburned fuel between you and the fire, Post Lookouts.

DIV Z: The fire continues moving to the north with backing, flanking and rollout providing for upslope runs. When the fire crosses Chiquita creek, expect upslope runs leading to a threat of fire across the McCloud River.

DIV Y: When the fire crosses Chiquita Creek, and absorbs the Spot Fire, expect short duration upslope runs as the fire continues to move North / Northeast toward and along the McCloud river. Threat of fire to cross the McCloud River, watch for spotting.

Branch III

DIV OO/RR: If fire crosses the McCloud River, upslope runs can be expected.

XX: No expected fire impacts.

AIR OPERATIONS

Smoke inversion over the fire until mid-afternoon will limit air operations.



COMMON DENOMINATORS OF FIRE BEHAVIOR ON TRAGEDY FIRES

Five common denominators that contribute to accidents/incidents have been identified through studies of tragedy fires. It is important for firefighters to readily recognize the following common denominators so that future tragedies can be prevented:

- Most incidents happen on smaller fires or on isolated portions of larger fires.

- Most fires are innocent in appearance before unexpected shifts in wind direction and/or speed results in flare-ups or extreme fire behavior. In some cases, tragedies occur in the mopup stage.

- Flare-ups generally occur in deceptively light fuels, such as grass and light brush.

- Fires run uphill surprisingly fast in chimneys, saddles, gullies, and on steep slopes.

- Some suppression tools, such as helicopters or airtankers, can adversely affect fire behavior. The blasts of air from low-flying helicopters and airtankers have been known to cause flare-ups.

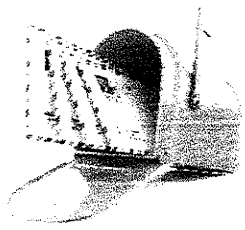

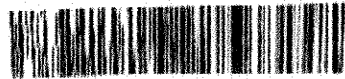

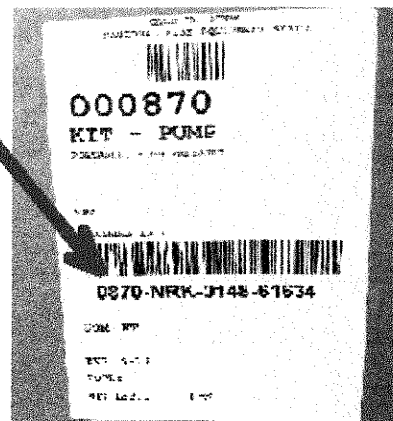
