· Fuels:

- NW California is currently under a Fuels and Fire Behavior Advisory for a <u>heavier than normal grass crop</u> and low fuel moistures through the end of August. Timber/brush litter accumulation is significant
- All live fuel moistures are reaching critically dry levels

Topography:

All aspects are represented in the fire. The fire is burning on steep terrain with slopes that vary between 35 and 75%. Elevation range is 1100 – 5590'.

SPECIFIC FIRE BEHAVIOR:

- Uphill runs in brush exceeding 80 ch/hr with 12-20' flame lengths may occur. Runs in timber may exceed 3 ch/hr with 2-6' flame lengths. This may trigger group and single tree torching with flames in excess of 100' and produce short-range spotting < 0.2 mile (further if plume dominated fire behavior develops).
- Probability of ignition 73 79%.

Branch I

DIV A/B: No control problems expected continue to patrol and watch for rollout into the receptive fuels.

DIV F: Fire will continue to consume interior islands as they heat up. Watch for rollout.

DIV T: Watch for spotting outside of control lines from burnout between Green Mtn and DP-40.

DIV U: Expect the fire to continue to flank and back into the North Salt Creek and North Fork North Salt Creek drainages north of the ridge between Green Mtn and High Mtn. Fire will roll out and make uphill runs. Unburned fuel between you and the fire. Post Lookouts.

Div W: If fire crosses the Oak creek drainage expect short upslope runs toward Tater Hill. Expect the fire to continue to flank, back and have rollout that produces short duration runs uphill on Tombstone Mtn.

Branch III

DIV Y: The fire continues to move North / Northeast toward and along the McCloud river. Threat of the fire to cross the McCloud River, watch for spotting.

DIV Z: The fire continues burning out interior fuels with backing, flanking and rollout. Watch for rollout and spotting across the rd.

DIV NN/OO/RR: If fire crosses the McCloud River, upslope runs can be expected. Unburned fuel between you and the fire, Post lookouts.

XX: No expected fire impacts.

DRIVING SAFETY

Vehicles/Roads Category

Driving is one of the most hazardous things we do because we literally perform the task hundreds of times in the course of our daily lives we tend to take it for granted. Based on recent accident trends, vehicle accidents are the source of more deaths and serious injuries to wildland firefighters than any other single cause.

- To be a safe driver you have to want to be one. Take a good hard look at your driving habits. Are you training yourself to do the right things the right way, like fastening your seat belt, checking your mirrors, and maintaining safe following distances?
- Inattentiveness is a major contributing factor in motor vehicle accidents within the wildland firefighting community. Since the average adult attention span is 15-20 minutes we must develop techniques that allow us to refocus our attention on our driving.
- Many things can lure our attention away from our driving such as: fatigue, eating and drinking, reading directions and maps, writing, cell phone and radio use, conversation within the vehicle and music.
 - ✓ Drive only when you are well rested and alert and avoid driving during the hours of 10:00 PM and 6:00 AM. Take a 10 to 15 minute break after every 2 hours.
 - ✓ Practice situational awareness; be aware of what is happening in front, behind, and on both sides of your vehicle.
 - ✓ Never drive when taking medications that make you drowsy.
 - ✓ Delegate navigation and communication to a passenger or pull over.
 - ✓ By constantly moving your vision, checking mirrors and distant road conditions, you can avoid highway hypnosis and daydreaming.
 - Avoid eating or drinking while driving.
 - ✓ When talking with passengers, keep your eyes on the road and both hands on the steering wheel. Avoid serious or argumentative conversations.
 - ✓ Do not be in a hurry, be patient.
- Safe driving starts with a safe vehicle. Something as simple as under-inflated tires can have serious consequences. Before operating any vehicle, do a walk-around to look for potential problems, make sure the lights and blinkers work, and adjust your seat and mirrors. If it is the first time you have driven the vehicle, make yourself aware of where everything is.


