Mixing height.....100 ft AGL increasing to 4200-6000 ft AGL late in the morning.  
Transport winds.....Southwest around 5 mph.

FRIDAY NIGHT...Partly cloudy. Lows 51 to 61.

SATURDAY...Partly cloudy. Highs 73 to 88.

SYNOPSIS...Dry and mild conditions will occur across the region during Friday, followed by cooler interior temperatures occurring during the weekend into early next week

DISCUSSION

Subsidence aloft and a stabilizing atmosphere will bring the shower/storm threat to an end during Thursday evening.

Shortwave ridging is forecast to occur across the region during Friday which will favor mild and dry conditions across the interior. However, a moderately deep marine boundary layer will linger along the coast during the next couple of days and aid in periods of stratus and occasional drizzle...particularly during the night and morning.

Otherwise, an upper trough is forecast to dig toward the coast on Saturday, with additional troughing occurring through early next week. A cold midlevel airmass will gradually spread across the region, resulting in interior high temperatures cooling into the 70s to mid 80s. In addition, the cool air aloft combined with embedded waves of ascent will aid in modest shower potential; particularly over Del Norte County.

# SAFETY FIRST!

## Watch Out for Overhead Hazards

- Snags
- Broken, dead, loose branches
- Water/retardant drops from aircraft

Exercise caution when driving while fatigued.

Dusty roads reduce visibility, control speed.

STEEP TERRAIN....expect and avoid loose materials rolling downhill above you. Warn anyone below you of rolling material.

Many bridges on roads. Do not cut corners when approaching or departing bridges. Old wood on decks of bridges, drive slow. Only one vehicle on bridges at a time.
